14. DISCUSSION AND APPROPRIATE ACTION REGARDING CINCO DE MAYO FESTIVAL

Councilor David Balderas states that there are two bands that are available to perform at the Cinco de Mayo Festival, and that the city ought to collaborate with the Cinco de Mayo committee to host the event. Mayor Oscar E. Puente states that the cost for the two bands will cost roughly \$5,000.00.

Councilor David Balderas recommends having the Cinco de Mayo event at Veterans Park. Mayor Pro Tem Sofia states that the committee has been planning the event since January 2023 and agrees to partnership with the city to help sponsor the event at Johnny Gloria Plazita. Councilor Ashley Moreno states that the Cinco de Mayo committee and the city should host the event on May 5, 2023 instead of having two different festivals on the same day.

Councilor David Balderas states that HOT Funds will be used to pay for the entertainment for the Cinco de Mayo event. Finance Director Edgar Castillo states that the Cinco de Mayo event is not budgeted for and does not recommend utilizing HOT Funds for the event. Utilizing Hot Funds for a festival requires bringing heads to beds and other criteria for auditing purposes. Mayor Oscar E. Puente states that the Deiz y Seis de Septiembre last year was not budgeted and was funded with HOT Funds and would like to move forward with the Cinco de Mayo event. Finance Director Edgar Castillo suggests funding the entertainment for the Cinco de Mayo with the City Council's contingency fund.

Mayor Pro Tem Sofia Morones states that she would like for the city to host the Cinco de Mayo event the following year.

Motion made by Mayor Pro Tem Sofia Morones, seconded by Councilor Ashley Moreno to approve funding the entertainment for the Cinco de Mayo event with the City Council contingency fund and not to exceed \$3,500 and hold the event at the Johnny Gloria Plazita.

Senior Citizens Discount Rate

City Manager Chris A. Castaneda suggests Council review the ordinance regarding the senior citizen discount for utilities. The ordinance states that you must live within the city limits to get the senior citizen discount, but the city does provide utility services for senior citizens that live outside of the city limits and the intent of the ordinance is designed to benefit all senior citizens.

Ivv Well #1

The city has been having issues with the Ivy Water Well # 1. The well needs to be flushed out every four hours because of bad reading and have been getting complaints from landowners about causing flooding and fence damage on their property. We have been collaborating with the landowners to find a solution.

Flow Meter:

The city is waiting for approval from TxDOT to move forward to install the water meter for Carrizo Hill water consumption.

Monumental Signs

Two of the monumental signs have arrived and are waiting for an installation date from the company.

Sewer Line for South 13th Street & Clark

The customer who is planning on building a new house at this location is requesting to connect to the city's sewer line. A proposal has been submitted from Alvin Stock for the amount of \$68,046.00 to connect to the nearest manhole.
