- Rae will update us on mtg with Grant and Tony
 - Updates on projects are below
 - Additionally-Grant and Tony were agreeable to outlining a seasonal maintenance list and reviewing with Public works.
 - The team identified the following tasks and we will send to Tony for review with Public Works. We are requesting a timeline/calendar of the tasks and plan to provide feedback if there are time-sensitive items (speed reduction at the beach, for example). Tasks: Speed reduction measures at the beach and any other locations, road striping, trimming trees around signs, trimming back sight lines, replacing or repairing damaged signs, painting crosswalks, stop bars, trail crossing, etc., mowing public ways.
 - Grant also identified the need to update the crosswalk in Casco Village and has been in discussion with Kevin Hancock about funding opportunities for the project.

- Updates on ongoing road projects
 - Quaker Ridge- Tony to: contact MDOT about a speed study, begin work on sign costs. Team to review if there is grant money available for any of this
 - Pine Hill - Rae discussed the need for additional safety measures on the road; it will be on the next selectboard meeting.
 - GPCOG 3 intersections- Draft document has been reviewed by Rae and Tony, once it is finalized it will be released to the public and the town can determine next steps.
 - P&K - NNTR
 - North + South of 121- Tony will: find out the schedules, let MDOT know we want to be in on the conversations. Team will want to work with Dakota to determine what grant funding is available.
 - Rt 302 (near brewery/end of Quaker Ridge) - This should become a priority for Safe Streets and we should discuss with CPIC.
