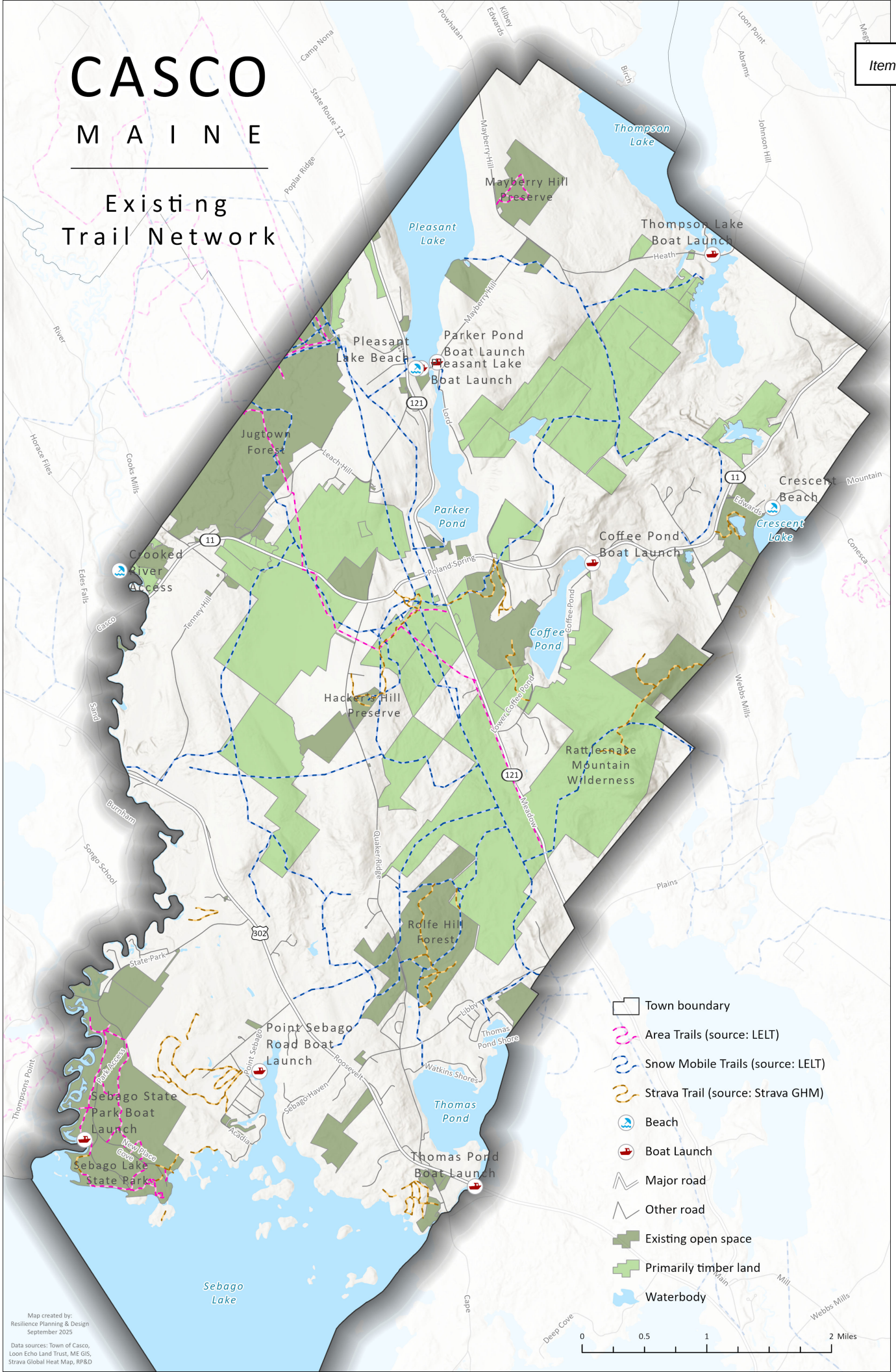

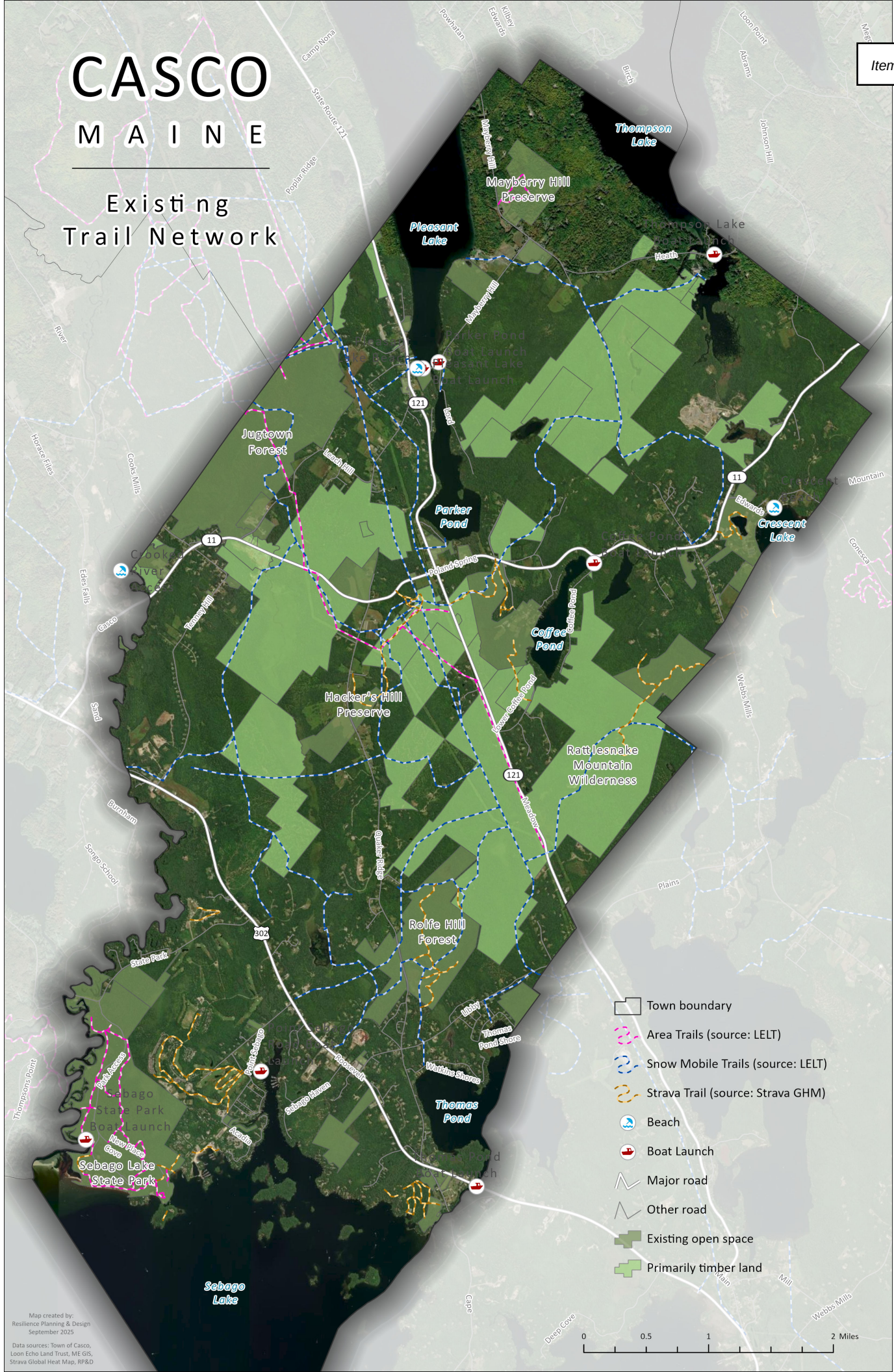

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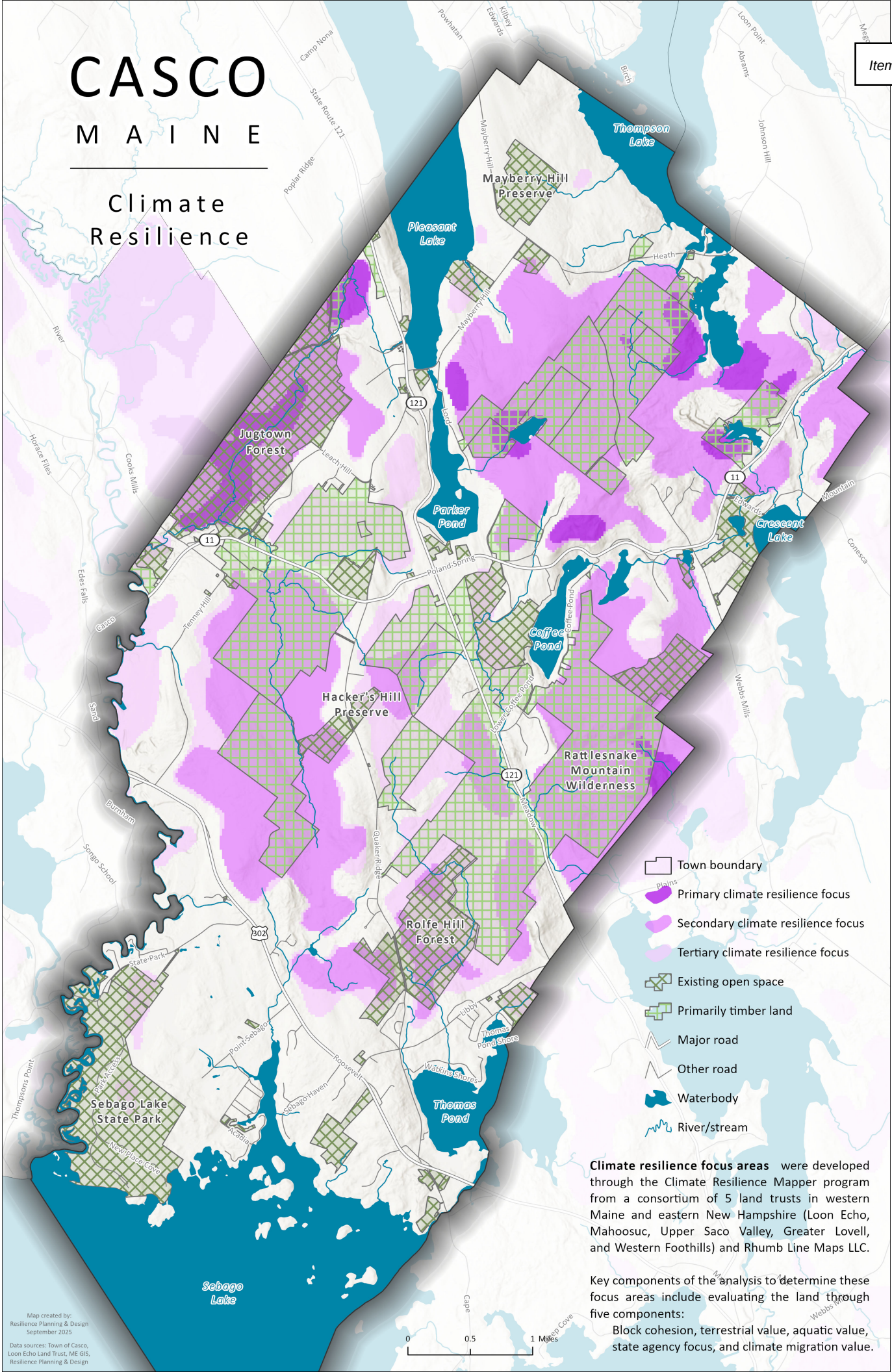

Climate Resilience



Climate resilience focus areas were developed through the Climate Resilience Mapper program from a consortium of 5 land trusts in western Maine and eastern New Hampshire (Loon Echo, Mahoosuc, Upper Saco Valley, Greater Lovell, and Western Foothills) and Rhumb Line Maps LLC.

Key components of the analysis to determine these focus areas include evaluating the land through five components:

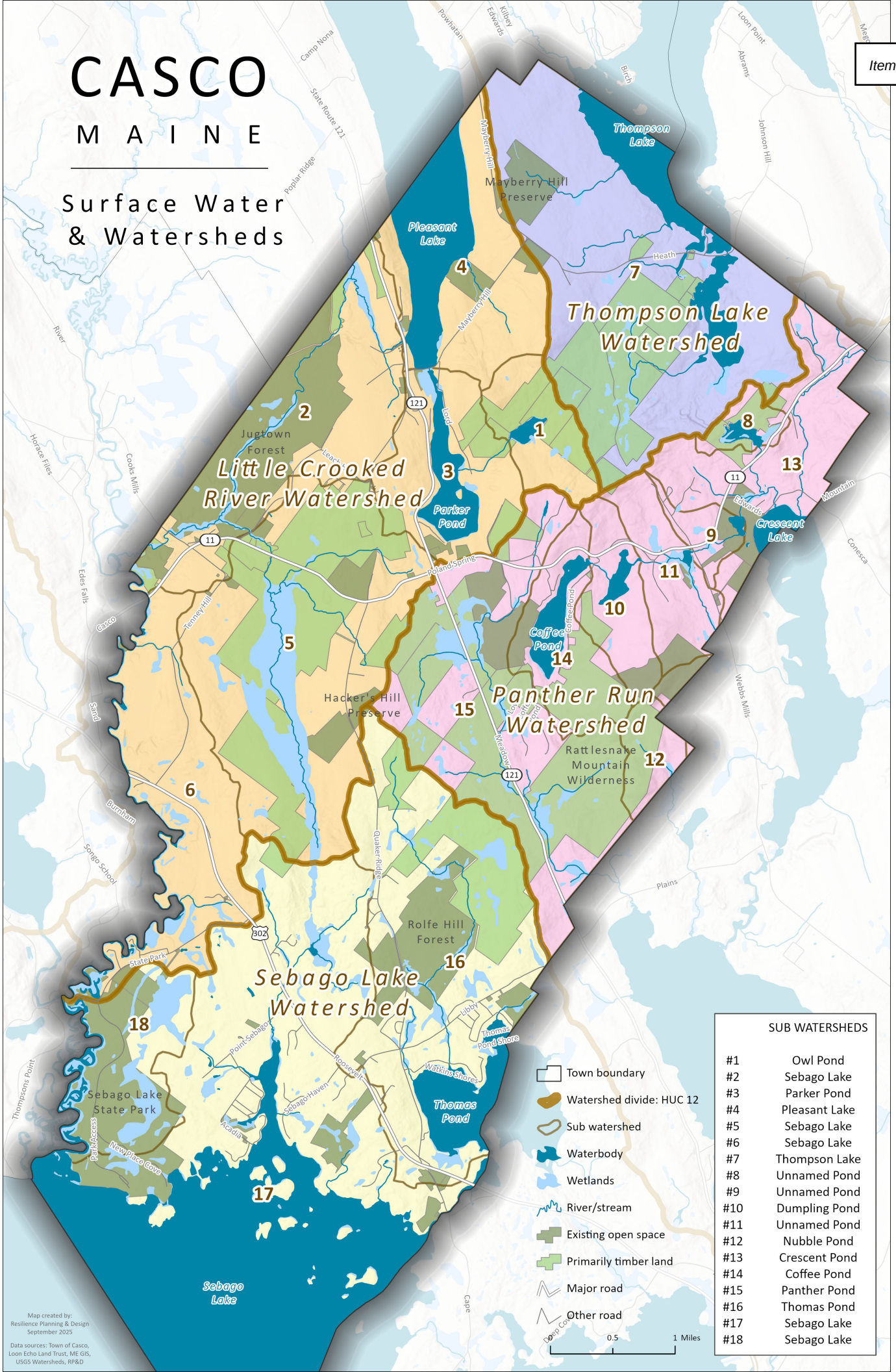
Block cohesion, terrestrial value, aquatic value, state agency focus, and climate migration value.
