Board Member Bass stated that all CRA information needs to be reviewed before the next meeting.

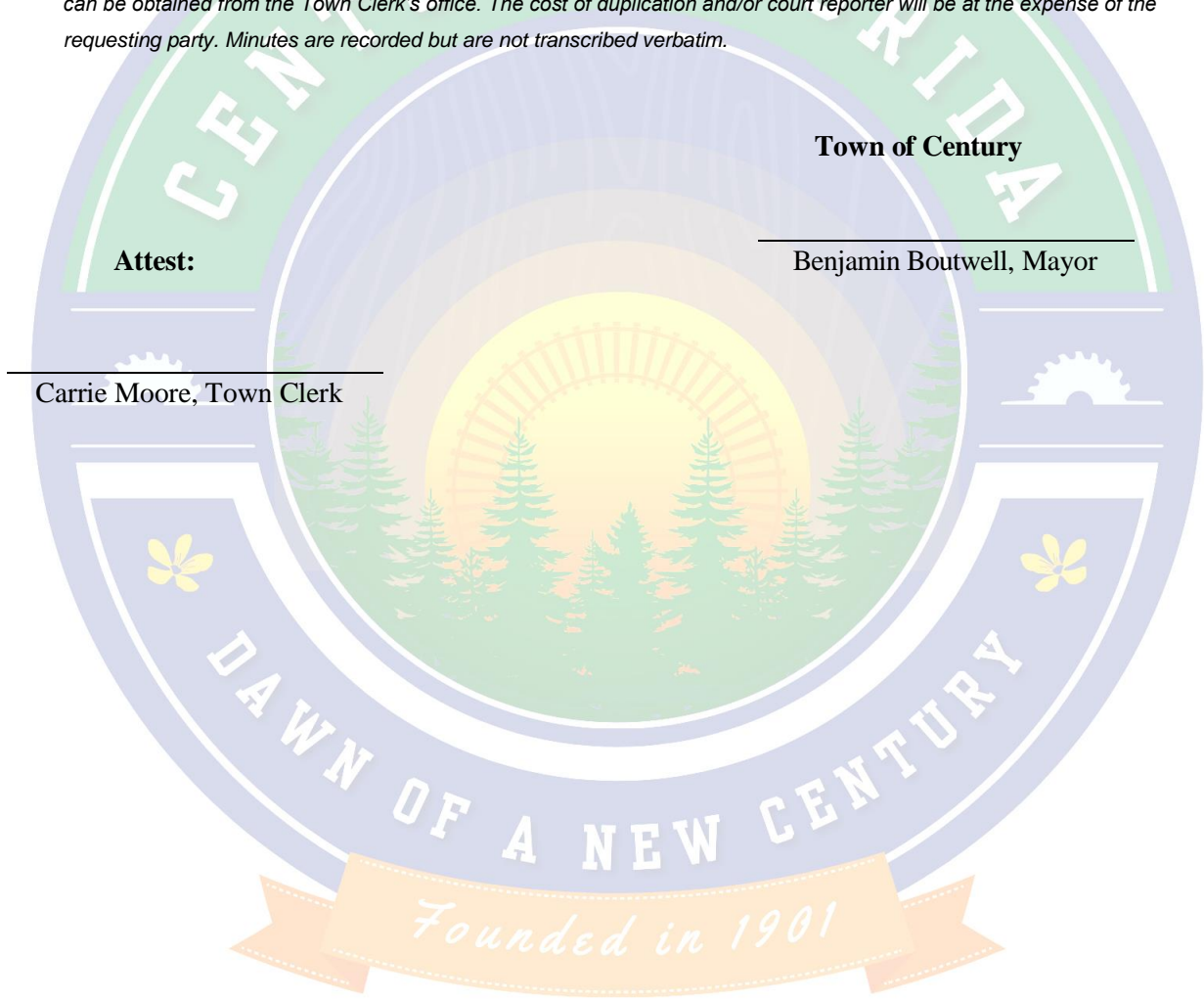
