Director's Report

- State Aid Grant Statistical Review should be looked at and be ready for discussion.
- SWFLN is fully funded. The director position is being offered to Brian Chase. Natasha will step down from director position and possibly also step down from the board.

Old Business

- Userful payment is covered by SWFLN for 2 years. Total was \$14,000.
- Long Range Plan is good until 2024. No one had any corrections but Director Hayes will update the current Long Range Plan to incorporate the new census data.

New Business

- TLC Server will be expensive to upgrade with a cost of approximately \$10,000.00.
 - It was discussed that TLC has a Cloud based system that would provide additional accessibility for staff, less maintenance by our personnel, as well as transition Hendry County Cooperative in to a more up to date, current technology service. This new service will cost approximately an additional \$4,000.00 per year which will be split amongst the three branches.
- Library Policies will be voted on at the August meeting. Natasha brought up a couple issues to look at and policies which need to be added.
- Summer Program will start on 5/31. This year's theme is Oceans of Possibilities. Clewiston will be holding their summer programs on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10 am-11 am.
