3. Consider and take action on the 2027 proposed aquatic center fees.

Amundson presented the proposed 2027 aquatic center fees. Commission discussion to have 1 & Under Free, replace the Couple Pass with a 2 Person Pass, have a Family Pass and increase the Viewer admission to \$2.

There was discussion regarding the swim lesson schedule to maximize revenue opportunities and discussion regarding closing at 7 pm on the weekends with Recreation Staff to bring back recommendations and to clarify the policy on evening admission if you paid for the afternoon.

Motion by Rostad, seconded by Hart to approve the discussion notes on the proposed 2027 aquatic center rates. Motion passed unanimously.

4. Consider and take action on proposed Fund 215 (Aquatic Center) budget.

Amundson presented the proposed Fund 215 Budget.

Motion by Rostad, seconded by Lawson to approve the proposed Fund 215 Budget. Motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.

5. Consider and take action on proposed Fund 216 (Recreation) budget.

Motion by Rostad, seconded by Hart to approve the proposed Fund 216 Budget. Motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.

6. Recreation Department Report

Amundson provided an update on youth volleyball, youth soccer, girls basketball and provided an update on the recruitment efforts for the Recreation Director position.
