Budget items for 2026

- Money for existing flower baskets and 10 new baskets for retrofitted brackets (fertilizer) – total of 20 baskets and flowers
 - \$1200 flowers, 20 baskets
 - \$450 10 metal baskets
 - \$150 fertilizer
- Flowers for existing metal planters by the benches downtown \$150
- Purchase of at least 4 planters to be placed on each corner downtown by the street lights - \$1000 (planters and flowers)
- Possible Funds for another mural \$10,000 15,000 ?
- Possible fountain or perennial flower bed for space right outside City Hall on Dickason - \$1500
- Replacement of some bushes/plantings outside City Hall \$500
