This is the cost for us to pressure wash the pavilion deck in preparation for stain application. This will include pressure washing the deck boards, stairs, and outside lip/edge surfaces to remove dirt, debris, and loose surface contaminants prior to staining. A working water source will be required for this work. We were unable to locate an exterior spigot, so if there is an interior location where a garden hose can be connected, we will need access to that area during the pressure washing day. Vivid Painting will use a Graco 4500 PSI pressure washer and appropriate pressure washing techniques to thoroughly clean the decking surfaces. Pressure will be adjusted as needed to clean the wood while helping minimize unnecessary damage to the surface. The parking lot will need to be closed off during the pressure washing process to help prevent debris, water, or overspray from getting on nearby vehicles. (we can provide signs and cones to close it off for 1 day) Pressure washing is intended to clean and prepare the surface for stain, but it may not remove all discoloration, previous coatings, embedded dirt, stains, or deep contamination. Any loose or failing coating that remains after pressure washing may require additional scraping or prep before stain application.			
Labor	\$3.00	3,500	\$10,500.00
This is the labor to apply two coats of stain to the pavilion deck surfaces after pressure washing and prep are completed. This will include applying stain to the deck boards, stair treads, stair risers/side boards, stair spindles, and the outside lip/edge of the deck. Stain will be applied using appropriate methods for the surface, including brushing and/or rolling as needed to work the product into the wood and provide even coverage. We will apply two coats of stain for improved durability, appearance, and protection. Areas			

below or around the work area will be protected as needed to help prevent stain drips, splatter, or tracking onto surrounding surfaces.

Stain application is dependent on proper weather conditions, surface dryness, and manufacturer-recommended

application temperatures. If weather, moisture, or surface conditions are not suitable, the staining portion may need to be rescheduled.

This line item does not include major scraping, sanding, wood repairs, board replacement, or removal of remaining failed coatings unless specifically listed elsewhere in the estimate.

*We can add shark grip into the stain to make the deck boards slip resistant at no extra cost.

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Notes:

After staining is complete, the deck and stairs should remain completely dry and free from foot traffic until the stain has had proper time to dry. Dry times can vary depending on temperature, humidity, sunlight, airflow, and product used.

Please avoid walking on the stained surfaces, placing furniture, dragging items, or allowing pets on the deck until the coating has dried enough for normal use. Heavy use should be avoided for several days after completion when possible.

Do not pressure wash, scrub, or use harsh cleaners on the stained surfaces during the initial cure period. Once fully cured, routine cleaning should be done with mild soap and water or a cleaner approved for stained wood surfaces.

Exterior stained surfaces require regular maintenance due to weather, sunlight, moisture, foot traffic, snow, salt, and normal wear. Horizontal surfaces such as deck boards and stair treads will wear faster than vertical surfaces and may require maintenance coats sooner.

Vivid Painting LLC is not responsible for damage caused by foot traffic before the stain has dried, weather exposure after completion, standing water, snow/ice removal, salt, furniture dragging, pets, pressure washing, harsh cleaning products, or normal wear and tear.

1.Payment Schedule

5.Termination

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This will be the labor to properly prep and refinish the cabinet doors, drawer fronts, and cabinet bases.

All cabinet doors and drawer fronts will be removed, labeled, and transported/prepped as needed for refinishing. All hardware will be removed and stored safely. Cabinet doors, drawer fronts,

and base frames will be thoroughly cleaned and degreased to remove oils, dirt, and surface contaminants.

All surfaces will then be scuff sanded to dull the existing laminate finish and promote proper adhesion.

After sanding, all surfaces will be vacuumed and wiped clean to remove dust and residue. We will apply one coat of Sherwin-Williams Extreme Bond Primer to promote adhesion to the laminate surfaces. Once dry, the primer will be lightly sanded smooth and cleaned again prior to finish coating.

Cabinet doors, drawer fronts, and bases will then receive two coats of Sherwin-Williams Gallery Series Waterborne Topcoat, per Sherwin-Williams representative recommendation. Doors and drawer fronts will be sprayed for a smooth, professional finish. Cabinet bases will be properly masked off to protect surrounding walls, floors, countertops, appliances, and other nearby surfaces during the refinishing process.

Once the finish has dried enough for handling, doors and drawer fronts will be reinstalled, and hardware will be reattached. Painted cabinet surfaces should be treated with care while the coating continues to cure. Full cure time may take several weeks, and aggressive cleaning or heavy use should be avoided during that period.

We would also install new drawer and cabinet pulls as long as they are the same size and require no drilling. This also includes us installing clear bumpers on all the doors and drawers. Attached is a rendering of what the cabinets will look like once painted in Gunmetal Gray (Rendering is approx.)

-Small imperfections, previous damage, dents, chips, seams, swelling, laminate edges, and existing cabinet defects may still be visible after painting. We will prep the cabinets to improve the overall appearance, but this work does not include rebuilding, replacing, or making old cabinet surfaces look new.

-Cabinet doors and drawers may need minor adjustment after reinstallation. Existing hinges, hardware, and cabinet boxes may not operate perfectly due to age, wear, or existing alignment issues.

-Cabinet interiors are not included unless specifically listed. Interiors will be masked off and protected during spraying.

All items must be removed from the walls prior to painting. If you would like any wall-hung items to go back in the same locations, please leave the existing nails or hangers in place. Any unwanted nail holes or small wall holes will be patched prior to painting.

All furniture and personal items must be moved away from the walls to provide us with at least 5 feet of working space. Kitchen items, countertop items, and any loose items near the cabinets must be removed prior to cabinet spraying. Items inside the cabinets may remain in place, as the cabinet interiors will be masked off and protected.

Failure to have items properly moved or cleared prior to our arrival may result in a change order for additional labor.

We estimate the wall painting portion of the project will take approximately 2–3 days to complete. The cabinet refinishing portion is estimated to take approximately 3 days to complete. Once the cabinet doors and drawers are reinstalled, the coating may take up to 3 weeks to fully cure. During this cure period, the cabinets must be handled with care. Please avoid heavy use, scratching, harsh cleaners, aggressive wiping, or cleaning the cabinet surfaces until the finish has had adequate time to cure.

1.Payment Schedule

-Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of 50% is due upon signing this contract.

Final Payment: The remaining balance is due upon completion of the project and Client's final inspection.

Payments are due within seven (7) days of receiving an invoice. Late payments will incur a fee of 1.5% per month.

2.Change Orders

-Any changes or additions to the scope of work must be approved in writing and may result in additional charges and an adjusted timeline. Change orders will be documented with the revised estimate and require Client's signature before proceeding.

3.Warranties

Vivid Painting LLC provides a warranty on labor for 2 years (wall painting only). This warranty covers issues arising from workmanship but excludes normal wear and tear, or damage caused by the Client or third parties.

Vivid Painting LLC will provide a 1-year limited workmanship warranty on the cabinet refinishing work. This warranty covers peeling or adhesion failure caused by improper application of the coating system.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by impact, scratching, chipping from normal use, water exposure, grease or chemical contamination, harsh cleaning products, tape/adhesive products, excessive moisture, heat damage, or failure of the existing cabinet/laminate surface beneath the coating.

Due to the slick nature of laminate cabinets, long-term adhesion is dependent on proper prep, existing surface condition, and customer care after completion. Painted cabinet surfaces should be treated carefully while curing and should not be aggressively cleaned or heavily used during the cure period.

Cabinets may be dry to the touch before they are fully cured. Please allow the finish to fully cure before heavy use or cleaning. Clean only with mild soap and water. Do not use magic erasers, harsh cleaners, degreasers, ammonia, alcohol-based cleaners, or abrasive pads.

4.Liability and Insurance

Vivid Painting LLC confirms that it holds liability insurance covering damages or injuries that may arise during the project. All subcontractors are either covered under this policy or hold their own insurance.

5.Termination

Termination requests must be made in writing, and any unpaid balances or outstanding fees become immediately due.

6. Dispute Resolution

-In case of a dispute regarding the quality of work or any unresolved issues, both parties agree to attempt informal resolution before seeking legal remedies. If an agreement cannot be reached within 14 days, either party may request mediation or arbitration.

-Final payment may not be withheld if the Contractor has completed the work to the industry standard and per the project specifications.

7. Entire Agreement

-This document constitutes the entire agreement between the Contractor and the Client, and no other terms outside this contract are valid unless provided in writing and signed by both parties.

8. Quality

-While the Vivid Painting strives for high-quality work, perfect uniformity is not achievable due to factors such as lighting, surface imperfections, and material properties. This contract does not imply or guarantee flawless results.

-Vivid Painting agrees to complete work to industry standards, as defined by the Painting and Decorating Contractors of America (PDCA). Minor variations in color or texture are inherent to painted surfaces and are not considered defects.
