## **STATE OF THE PARKS**

### **King Vale Park -**

Still waiting for the signage to arrive.  
There is spray paint on the play structure.

John Chaney, property owner behind King Vale Park brought to attention that the fence between the park and his property needs to be replaced.

### **Leland L. Taylor Park -**

The park is beautiful and in great condition.  
The park is a well site.

### **C.D. Semle Park -**

The park is in great condition.  
Addition of basketball lines on the court was recommended.

### **A.B. Davison Park**

The park is in very good condition.  
May 1st is the pool expected opening date.

Adult swim will be available to register on the rec desk.

### **Will S. Green Park**

Replacement light is needed on the light pole. The prior light has been missing for over two years.

Basketball nets have been added to the court and have been very well used.

May Surprise will be hosted at the park May 6th. Mowing the lawn was suggested for that Thursday, and watered on Friday the day before the event.

### **Sankey Elmwood Park**

The park looks great and is very well maintained.

BBQ's were replaced at the park. Water fountains were also suggested to be replaced.

### **Veterans Memorial Park**

In good condition. Wood chips need to be replaced.

### **Colusa Levee Park**

The Colusa Levee Park is in good condition. The boaters are happy to see work getting done.

The homeless have moved to the other side of the levee, behind the Refuge.

Possible clean up of Levee Park Day, volunteers are encouraged. A boat is needed to access and remove some debris.

No further plan for the homeless.
