



- There were 436 calls for service for patrol officers with 33 agency assists. This is an increase from September which was 416. The call volume for 2021 began with a significant increase in comparison to 2020. In October 2020, there were 339 calls for service. The calls for service continues to average a 20% increase from 2020. While the increase continues, there aren't any specific trends that can be attributed to the increase; isn't one particular type of crime 'on the rise'. With the recent bail reform, there has been a noticeable amount of individuals arrested in a short period of time; re-offending continues to occur.
- During October 2021, there were 17 in-custody arrests. This continues to be below the
 monthly average. There were 8 citations issued in lieu of subjects being booked in jail. A vast
 majority of those citations issued were drug related offenses and driving with a suspended
 license. There was 1 domestic violence related arrest made in October. There was 1 DUI
 related arrest made. There were 58 reports initiated with 57 being investigations.
- During the month of October, officers initiated 226 traffic enforcement stops. There were 73 citations issued for various vehicle violations. There were 2 reportable traffic collisions with injuries.

• Beginning in October 2020, the Colusa Police Department began tracking the number of service requests for the police services technician. (These calls for service don't include telephone calls fielded by the Police Services Technician.) During the month of August, the Police Services Technician handled 75 calls for service. Additionally, she continues to handle a significant number of CCW applications. DOJ clearances for CCW applicants continues to experience delays. Note: The Police Services Technician's calls for service are separate from patrol officers' calls for service.

Items of Interest

• The Colusa Police Department and Colusa County District Attorney's Office continue to investigate the murder of Giovanny Alcaraz. The integrity of Alcaraz's murder investigation is paramount. It is for this reason that specific details surrounding the events that led up to and the murder itself aren't made public. The Colusa Police Department will not engage nor comment on speculation put forth on social media. The United States Marshal Service is attempting to locate the suspect, Christian Suarez. Suarez is 5-09 in height, 120 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes. An arrest warrant has been issued for Suarez who is pictured below. If anyone has any information related to the location of Suarez and/or the murder of Giovanny Alcaraz, please contact the Colusa Police Department.



• During the month of October there were two traffic collisions, one involving a pedestrian. It is important to remember that vehicles do not automatically have to yield to a pedestrian. Section 21950(b) of the California Vehicle Code states, "This section does not relieve a pedestrian from the duty of using due care for his/her safety. No pedestrian may suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle that is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard. No pedestrian may unnecessarily stop or delay traffic while in a marked or unmarked crosswalk." It is important to teach children how to safely cross the street. Additionally, it is important that parents not drop their children off at school, specifically Egling Middle School, while stopped in traffic rather than pulling along the curb or into the parking lot. Not only is this is not a safe way to drop off children but it also creates unnecessary traffic congestion on the surrounding streets.



struggling with domestic violence including Karen's House.



• Beginning in January 2022, law enforcement throughout Colusa County is required by the California Department of Justice to compile 'stop data'. The data collected is pursuant to Assembly Bill 953, commonly referred to as Racial and Identity Profiling Act (RIPA). The data includes the age, ethnicity, gender identification, location, and reason for contact. The names of the individuals contacted nor their addresses noted in this data. The most frequent law enforcement contact that this data would be collected is during traffic enforcement stop. The Colusa Police Department has partnered with the company RIPALog to assist with compiling, processing, and submitting the data to California DOJ. During November and December, officers have been utilizing an application on their department issued cell phone to enter this data. In excess of 300 entries have been compiled. While it takes an officer approximately 1 to 2 minutes to enter data into the cell phone application, the processing and review of this data is somewhat time consuming for the supervisors and adds an additional 1 to 2 hours of work.

on December 21, 2021 at approximately 1430 hours, Colusa Police Department was dispatched to the 900 block of Jay Street regarding an altercation. CCSO Dispatch advised while law enforcement was in route that an individual had shot another, possibly armed with a bat. Law enforcement from Colusa Police Department and Colusa County Sheriff's Officer arrived on scene and located a male victim with a single gunshot wound to the upper chest area. The individual identified as the shooter, identified as Melvish Sharma of Colusa, was located at the scene and detained without further incident. Subsequently later that evening, he was booked into the Colusa County Jail on the charge of 664/187 PC (Attempted Homicide) and 245(A)(2) PC (Assault with a Deadly Weapon).

After speaking with individuals involved in the altercation and witnesses in the area at the time of the incident along with evidence gathered, it was later determined that Sharma acted in defense of himself and another. The investigation was completed and submitted to the Colusa County District Attorney's Office for review.

A brief press release was submitted to the Pioneer Review the morning following the incident. The information contained a brief synopsis of what occurred and information related to the arrest of Sharma. As with some incidents, social media contributed to speculation of what occurred. This included speculation that this was a 'gang shooting' which is false. While most people want to know what occurred for a variety of reasons including the incident happening near their residence or an overall safety issue, it is crucial in the infancy of an investigation to not release information unique to the investigation that would only be known to the involved parties. It assists in eliminating false information and isolating those who may try to involve themselves in the investigation with dishonest motivations. A victim has a right to keep their identifying information confidential. The victim's 'bill of rights' more commonly known as 'Marcy's Rights' are very specific as to the release of information to the public. The integrity of an investigation is paramount. It ensures a successful prosecution which the victim's of crime are entitled to.

REQUESTED ACTION:

1.) Authorize the City Engineer to Sign the Subdivision Map and the City Clerk to Record the Final Map for the Sunrise Landing Phase II Subdivision (43 lots). See Attached

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

Colusa Industrial Properties (CIP) submitted an application for a tentative map to subdivide approximately 57.42 acres of property into 180 single family lots on lands owned by Colusa Industrial Properties lying west of Highway 20 and extending westerly of Sunrise Avenue. The tentative map was then modified in 2018 to eliminate the Agricultural Buffer located along western property boundary previously identified on the tentative map as "remainder". With the original tentative map there were Conditions of Approval and Development Agreement that was adopted via City Ordinance. An amended development agreement was adopted in 2018 which outlined various terms of the development phasing of the project, and when certain infrastructure items would be installed and the extent of installation etc..

CIP has teamed with a developer, named Blazona Concrete Inc. whom undertook the physical development of the first Phase of the project (40 lots). Blazona and CIP have continued their relationship, and as such Blazona has completed all construction of infrastructure for Phase II of the project which involves the development of 43 additional lots. Upon recordation of the map, the public improvements, i.e. Roads, water, sewer, etc.. constructed within the prescribed right of way becomes the property of the City of Colusa, and the City will take over the operations and maintenance. Additionally, based on previous work to form a regional Community Facilities District, this next phase will automatically be joined into the City CFD 02-2020.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Staff does not anticipate any budgetary impacts to the General Fund to the City.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

By the following resolution authorize the execution, signature and recording of the Final Subdivision Map for Phase II.

Subject: City of Colusa's Donation policy

Recommendation: Council to direct staff on whether to adopt or make modifications to the draft Donation policies, and consider adoption of a Resolution

BACKGROUND ANALYSIS: The City of Colusa has always accepted donations from people and business here in Colusa and all around the City. The City for years now have sent out letters asking for the people's support for concerts in the parks and the adult cantina and our recreation programs. A few years ago the City received a donation of a piece of property that the City turned around and made over \$100,000 on. The City of Colusa has always accepted donations since its incorporation this is how we have our City parks. We have done this with no policy in place. The City of Colusa cannot be affective at trying to create a better quality of life for our citizens if we do not accept donations.

Times now have changed and public perspective can been seen in many different ways, this is why it's time that the City of Colusa created a donation policy to ensure the public that we are conducting business in the best interest on our citizens.

The policy is written in a manner that limits the elected officials on who and how much money is donated so that they cannot be accused of doing favors for future projects that may be brought to them at a later date. The City Manager has no vote on items that come before the City Council.

At the January 4th Council meeting there was public input and council discussion on the new donation policy. Attached are two draft policies for your consideration. Option A is a draft that I felt best represented the comments at the last meeting from the majority of the city council. Also included is a draft from Council Member Ponciano and City Attorney Jones.

CITY OF COLUSA DONATION AND GIFT POLICY

DRAFT A

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish a formal process for acceptance and documentation of donations, sponsorships, or gifts made to the City. This policy provides guidance when individuals, community groups, and businesses wish to make donations to the City. This policy also establishes the standards for City employees and City officials regarding the acceptance of gifts during the performance

Whenever possible and practical, donors are encouraged to make donations to a non-profit organization that partners with the City in support of its operations and programs.

Section 2. Types of Donations

Donations may be offered in the form of cash, sponsorship, real or personal property. Designated donations mean those donations or sponsorships that the donor specifies for a particular City department, location, or purpose. Undesignated donations mean those donations that are given to the City for an unspecified use.

Section 3. Consistency with City Interests

Designated donations may only be accepted when they have a purpose consistent with the City's goals and objectives and are in the best interest of Colusa. The City must always consider the public trust and comply with all applicable laws when accepting donations.

Section 4. Acceptance of Undesignated Donations of Cash or Tangible Items

All donations to the City, including offers to employees related to the City, shall immediately be submitted for consideration for acceptance. Based on the value of the donation offered as outlined below, appropriate City staff shall review every donation and determine if the benefits to be derived warrant acceptance of the donation. The following points list the threshold amounts for donation acceptance from an individual or business in a calendar year.

- A. Offers of donations of cash or items valued less than \$5,000 may be accepted by the City Manager.
- B. Offers of donations of cash or items valued more than \$5,000 must be accepted by the City Council. Donations valued at more than \$5,000 shall be accepted through a written agreement consistent with these guidelines and approved by the City Council.
- C. Offers of donations for gratuitous purposes (e.g., holiday gift baskets, etc.) to any employee, department or the City shall be made available to benefit all employees.
- D. All donations received will be documented by City Staff and made available for review by the City Council

Section 5. Acceptance of Designated Donations of Cash or Tangible Items

Based on the value of the donation offer as outlined in Section 3 above, appropriate City staff will review the conditions of any designated donation and determine if the benefits to be derived warrant acceptance of the donation. Criteria for the evaluation include but are not limited to:

- A. Consideration of an immediate or initial expenditure is required in order to accept the donation.
- B. The potential and extent of the City's obligation to maintain, match, or supplement the donation.

Section 6. Acknowledgement of Donations

- A. A Donation Acceptance Form is required to be completed by the City Manager's Office for all donations provided to the City (form attached).
- B. Acknowledgement of the donation should be in writing and be the responsibility of the City Manager. Undesignated donations shall be acknowledged by the City Manager. A copy of the acknowledgement agreement should be forwarded to donors.
- C. The Donor Acceptance Form including the donor names and donation amounts are public information subject to disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act.

Section 7. Declined Donations

The City of Colusa reserves the right to decline any donation if, upon review, acceptance of the donation offer is determined in the sole discretion of the City to be not in the best interests of the City.

Section 8. Distribution of Donation

- A. Tangible items will be distributed to appropriate City departments for use or, at the discretion of the City Manager, disposed of in an appropriate manner according to this policy.
- B. All Donations of cash for designated or undesignated donations will be deposited into a separate accounting fund and reported to the City Council.
- C. All Undesignated donations will be distributed at the direction of City Council by resolution or during the annual Budget process.
- D. Designated donations or sponsorships under \$1,000 can be distributed by the City Manager.

Section 9. Dissemination of Information

- A. A copy of each Donation Acceptance Form for accepted donations shall be forwarded for information to the City Council by the City Manager's Office.
- B. A copy of each Donation Acceptance Form for accepted donations shall be forwarded for information to the Finance Department and the designated department for which the donation was assigned.
- C. Each original Donation Acceptance Form shall be maintained by the City Clerk's Office.

- A. All solicitation campaigns by the City shall be approved by City Council.
- B. All solicitations will be made in writing or via the City's Website and made available to all residents or businesses within the City's jurisdiction.
- C. At no time may employees directly solicit any individual, business, or business type.

Section 11. Acceptance of Gifts to Employees and/or Elected Officials of the City

- A. Employees and or elected officials of the city shall follow provisions listed in Article VII of the Municipal Code, Conflict of Interest Code, and state law as they relate to the receipt of gifts
- B. Employees and officials of the City are required to be objective and fair in dealing with the public and persons or firms doing business with the City. Employees shall not solicit or accept gifts or gratuities for the performance of their City job responsibilities.
- C. No City official or employee shall directly or indirectly solicit, accept, or attempt to accept any money, fee, credit, gift, gratuity, object of value, or compensation of any kind which the official or employee knows, or has reason to know is being offered:
 - 1) For the purpose of improperly obtaining or rewarding favorable treatment.
 - 2) With interest to influence the official or employee in the discharge of official duties.
 - 3) In consideration of having exercised official powers or performed official duties
- D. Anonymous gifts shall be delivered to the City Manager for appropriate disposition.
- E. This policy does not prohibit a City official from accepting anything of value by way of a gift when such a gift is made to and accepted on behalf of, the City of Colusa. All such gifts to the City shall be forwarded to the City Manager for compliance with this policy whenever possible; the City Manager will ensure that all such gifts are shared by all City staff. An example of such gifts would be those received during holiday periods.
- F. Under the Political Reform Act, public officials and employees are required to disclose certain personal financial holdings as outlined in California Government Code sections 81000-91014. The Fair Political Practices Commission requires all public officials and employees to file a 'conflict-of-interest statement,' known as Form 700. In Schedule D of Form 700, details requirements in reporting gifts of a dollar value and shall be used.
- G. If required, the city will report a donation made to the City to the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) in accordance with the timelines and directives described in title 2, section 18944 of the California Code of regulations.
- H. If a donation to the City is made at an elected officials' behest from a single source in a calendar year, and the donation meets or exceeds the amount established by the FPPC, the elected City official must file a FPPC form 803 with the City Clerk disclosing this information.

Designated donations may only be accepted when they have a purpose consistent with the City's goals and objectives and are in the best interest of Colusa. The City must always consider the public trust and comply with all applicable laws when accepting donations.

Section 4. Acceptance of Undesignated Donations of Cash or Tangible Items

All donations to the City, including offers to employees related to the City, shall immediately be submitted for consideration for acceptance. Based on the value of the donation offered as outlined below, appropriate City staff shall review every donation and determine if the benefits to be derived warrant acceptance of the donation. The following points list the threshold amounts for donation acceptance.

- A. Offers of donations of cash or items valued at \$10,000 or below may be accepted by a Department Head.
- B. Offers of donations of cash or items valued more than \$10,000 and up to \$30,000 may be accepted by the City Manager.
- C. Offers of donations of cash or items valued more than \$30,000 must be reviewed by and may be accepted by the City Council. Donations valued at more than \$30,000 shall be accepted through a written agreement consistent with these guidelines and approved by the City Council.

D. Offers of donations for gratuitous purposes (e.g. holiday gift baskets, etc.) to any employee, department or the City shall be made available to benefit all employees.

Section 5. Acceptance of Designated Donations of Cash or Tangible Items

Based on the value of the donation offer as outlined in Section 3 above, appropriate City staff will review the conditions of any designated donation and determine if the benefits to be derived warrant acceptance of the donation. Criteria for the evaluation include but are not limited to:

- A. Consideration of an immediate or initial expenditure is required in order to accept the donation.
- B. The potential and extent of the City's obligation to maintain, match, or supplement the donation.

Section 6. Acknowledgement of Donations

- A. A Donation Acceptance Form is required to be completed by the receiving Department Head or the City Manager's Office for all donations provided to the City (form attached).
- B. Acknowledgement of the donation should be in writing and be the responsibility of the Department Head who is the beneficiary of the donation. Undesignated donations shall be acknowledged by the City Manager. A copy of the acknowledgement agreement should be forwarded to donors.
- C. The Donor Acceptance Form including the donor names and donation amounts are public information subject to disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act.

Section 7. Declined Donations

A. The City of Colusa reserves the right to decline any donation if, upon review, acceptance of the donation offer is determined in the sole discretion of the City to be not in the best interests of the City.

Section 8. Distribution of Donation

- A. Tangible items will be distributed to appropriate City departments for use or, at the discretion of the Department Head or City Manager, disposed of in an appropriate manner according to this policy.
- B. Donations of cash for designated donations will be deposited into the appropriate revenue account for the designated City department.
- C. Donations of cash for undesignated donations under \$1000 will be deposited into the City's General Fund donation account. Undesignated donations in the amount of \$10,000-\$25,000 will be designated to the Community projects funds Undesignated donations in an amount over \$25,000 will be distributed at the direction of City Council.

Section 9. Dissemination of Information And Solicitation of Donations

- A. A copy of each Donation Acceptance Form for accepted donations shall be forwarded for information to the City Manager's Office.
- B. A copy of each Donation Acceptance Form for accepted donations shall be forwarded for information to the Finance Department and the designated department for which the donation was assigned.
- C. Each original Donation Acceptance Form shall be maintained by the City Clerk's Office.
- D. All solicitation may be made in writing or via City's Website, made available to all residents or business and may advertise in the local papers.

Section 10. Acceptance of Gifts to Employees and/or Elected Officials of the City

- A. Employees and or elected officials of the City shall follow the provisions listed in Article VII of the Municipal Code, Conflict of Interest Code as they relate to the receipt of gifts.
- B. Employees and officials of the City are required to be objective and fair in dealing with the public and persons or firms doing business with the City. Employees shall not solicit or accept gifts or gratuities for the performance of their City job responsibilities.
