2. Policy and Procedures – ACTION ITEM

CONFIRE EMS is scheduled to start ground ambulance transportation services on October 1, 2024.

Priority Ambulance was chosen by CONFIRE as the sole subcontractor for ambulance services as authorized by County contract 23-1282. The County contract identifies several areas where policies and procedures must be developed to meet the contractual obligations.

Priority and CONFIRE will operate a joint policy and procedures manual to cover all employees in the operation. Policies for Priority-only employees will have the policy number followed by a "P". Policies for CONFIRE-only employees will have the policy number followed by a "C". This system will allow for easy identification and application of the developed policy and procedures.

The ambulance implementation team has developed a nearly complete manual covering the contractual obligations, best practices, and policies required to implement the Commission on Accreditation of Ambulance Services (CAAS) accreditation. Finalizing all policies to completion is a heavy lift that will take several months. The proposed policies are considered working drafts that, upon your approval, will serve as operational policies that will continue to receive minor revisions until they are finalized.

There is no fiscal impact to the EMS Fund (5020).

The Administrative Committee voted to authorize the Interim Director to pre-approve and sign any and all agreements related to the County Ground Ambulance Contract 23-1282 between September 10, 2024, and December 31, 2024. All agreements executed and approved under this action will be brought forward to the Administrative Committee at the following regularly scheduled meeting, for acceptance and filing.

SUBJECT: \$2,000,000 loan to Fund 5020 (EMS) from Fund 5010 (Reserve)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the CONFIRE EMS Subcommittee recommend to the CONFIRE Admin Committee a loan from Fund 5010 (Reserve) to Fund 5020 (EMS) in the amount of \$2,000,000.

The EMS Division will use the loan to fund ongoing costs and legal fees related to the County of San Bernardino Ground Ambulance contract.

Background Information

On December 5, 2023, the County of San Bernardino awarded CONFIRE the Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support Ground Ambulance Services, Interfacility, and Critical Care Transport Services for Exclusive Operating Areas contract. On September 12, 2024, the courts ordered a preliminary injunction that stopped implementation of the contract. While costs have been reduced since the injunction, ongoing costs and legal fees related to the EMS Division remain, which requires funding.

It is recommended that CONFIRE utilize Fund 5010 (Reserve) to provide a loan, not to exceed \$2,000,000, to Fund 5020 (EMS) for the above costs with no interest. This action will delay or potentially eliminate the need to utilize the loan provided by the City of Ontario at 4% interest.

The terms of the loan are as follows:

Maximum Loan Amount:	\$2,000,000.00
Minimum Amount Per Draw:	\$250,000.00
Draw Effective Date:	October 23, 2024
Loan Agreement:	The agreement expires two (2) years from the effective date of the loan agreement. Draws request must be completed within two (2) years.
Interest Rate:	0%
Repayment:	Borrower will pay scheduled principal within two (2) years.

Fiscal Impact

Once the Administrative Committee approves, the funds will be transferred from Fund 5010 to Fund 5020. There will be zero interest charged to Fund 5020 for this loan, and the loan must be repaid within two years from the funds transfer date.

SUBJECT: Contract Amendment for Temporary Employment

Recommendation

Direct staff to develop an amendment to the contract with Priority Ambulance for the temporary employment of Priority personnel for presentation to the CONFIRE Administrative Committee for approval.

Background Information:

On February 22, 2022, the Administrative Committee approved a contract with Priority Ambulance to provide emergency medical services in partnership with its member agencies. To further enhance operational flexibility, CONFIRE seeks to amend its contract with Priority Ambulance. This amendment would permit CONFIRE, and by extension, its Joint Powers Authority (JPA) member agencies, to temporarily employ Priority Ambulance personnel. These personnel will fill critical short-term staffing needs across CONFIRE and its member agencies.

If the Administrative Committee approves, staff shall develop an Administrative Policy illustrating the details and processes related to an overall temporary employment program. This amendment and policy will provide additional workforce flexibility and ensure that CONFIRE and its member agencies can maintain operations continuity during increased staffing needs.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no net fiscal impact to CONFIRE. CONFIRE will pay Priority an agreed-upon amount to reimburse them for the work performed by their employees for member agencies. The temporary Priority employees' costs will be reimbursed directly to CONFIRE by the member agency through direct invoicing or an increase to their respective agency fees, offsetting the amount paid out to Priority.
