2. Ambulance Branding – ACTION ITEM

It is recommended that the EMS Subcommittee review and discuss the proposed branding and livery option as presented and make recommendations for consideration by the CONFIRE Administrative Committee.

This proposal has no direct cost to CONFIRE EMS and Mobile Health or CONFIRE. All expenses related to painting, wrapping, and labeling the fleet are part and parcel of agreements with those entities providing public-based ambulances.

3. Consultant Agreement – Viewpoint Advocacy – ADVISEMENT

The contract with Viewpoint Advocacy will enable CONFIRE to navigate complex public relation scenarios, disseminate timely and accurate information, and ensure alignment with regulatory requirements and community expectations. Viewpoint Advocacy will support CONFIRE's operational objectives and uphold its commitment to transparency and accountability. The fiscal impact will not exceed \$72,000 for the next 12 months and is offset by reduced legal expenses. The funding will be allocated from the EMS Fund (5020)

The EMS Subcommittee receives this report as advisement of action taken by the CONFIRE Board of Directors.

4. Dispatcher Positions – ACTION ITEM

CONFIRE EMS is scheduled to start ground ambulance transportation services on October 1, 2024.

Recognizing the crucial need for efficient coordination within our ambulance system, staff proposes adding five Full-Time Employee (FTE) Dispatcher positions to fulfill the Ambulance System Status Coordinators role. These coordinators will play a pivotal role in ensuring seamless communication and coordination among emergency response units, hospitals, and other healthcare facilities. The current dispatching staff cannot handle the increased workload.

The fiscal impact is estimated to be \$543,300 for five (5) FTE dispatcher positions. The funding will be allocated from the EMS Fund (5020)

SUBJECT: \$2,000,000 loan to Fund 5020 (EMS) from Fund 5010 (Reserve)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the CONFIRE EMS Division Subsidiary Committee authorize a loan from Fund 5010 (Reserve) to Fund 5020 (EMS) in the amount of \$2,000,000.

The loan will be used by the EMS Division to fund the startup cost related to hiring support staff and the respective personnel salaries, as well as the cost associated with the first 90-days of operations for the County of San Bernardino Ground Ambulance contract.

Background Information

The County of San Bernadino has awarded CONFIRE the Advanced Life Support and Basic Life Support Ground Ambulance Services, Interfacility and Critical Care Transport Services for Exclusive Operating Areas contract. To begin providing ambulance services effective October 1, 2024, as required per the agreement with the County, CONFIRE's EMS division will need funding to incur start-up costs for salaries and benefits for support staff. Fund 5010 (Reserve) will provide Fund 5020 (EMS) a loan not to exceed \$2,000,000.

It is recommended that CONFIRE utilizes the reserve in Fund 5010 by loaning it to Fund 5020 (EMS) to fund the above startup costs with no interest. This action will delay or potentially eliminate the need to utilize the loan provided by the City of Ontario at 4% interest.

The terms of the loan are as follows:

Fiscal Impact

The funds will be transferred from Fund 5010 to Fund 5020 once it is approved by the Administrative Committee. There will be zero interest charged to Fund 5020 for this loan and the loan must be repaid within two years from the date of the transfer of funds.

SUBJECT: Implementation Fund

Background Information

On December 5, 2023, the Board of Supervisors awarded CONFIRE EMS and Mobile Health the contract for ground ambulance services for eleven exclusive operating areas in the county, known as the comprehensive service area. CONFIRE EMS is scheduled to start ground ambulance transportation services on October 1, 2024.

Implementing our ambulance service entails initial investments in equipment procurement, staff recruitment, and training, among other essential aspects. CONFIRE staff recognizes the need to establish an implementation fund to facilitate the smooth launch of our ambulance services in collaboration with our partner, Priority Ambulance. Given Priority Ambulance's pivotal role as our partner, their strategic investment in the fund will allow us to pool our resources, leveraging contributions to ensure the timely and efficient collaborative support of system development.

Staff recommends CONFIRE utilize our legal counsel, Kingsley Bogard, to develop an agreement with Priority Ambulance to establish an implementation fund, which will provide supplemental funding for costs associated with implementing the ambulance services.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of this recommendation is estimated to be \$200,000 in revenue for the EMS Fund (5020).

Recommendation

The EMS Subcommittee recommends that the Administrative Committee approve CONFIRE's legal counsel to develop an agreement with Priority Ambulance for an implementation fund.



INLAND COUNTIES EMERGENCY MEDICAL AGENCY POLICY AND PROTOCOL MANUAL

MEDICAL PRIORITY DISPATCH MINIMUM RESPONSE ASSIGNMENTS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCH (EMD) CATEGORIES

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish approved Medical Priority Dispatch System (MPDS) response and mode assignments for use by authorized Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) Centers.

II. POLICY

- EMD Centers shall dispatch EMS resources to medical emergencies and manage their response in accordance with the response level established by this policy.
- First responder and ambulance resources shall comply with instructions from an authorized EMD Center to upgrade, cancel, or reduce their response mode.




