

The agenda discussion posted for this meeting is a preliminary discussion regarding projected revenues and expenses necessary to begin and proceed with the preparation of a budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 as required by law. In accordance with State law, information necessary for the City to provide a proposed 2026 tax rate will be available from Denton County Appraisal District (DCAD) on or after July 25, 2026; however, when a proposed budget has been prepared and the City has received the DCAD information necessary to provide a proposed 2026 tax year rate, the table above will be updated with information regarding the 2026 tax year proposed rate, and a proposed budget will be posted online and accessible from the City of Corinth homepage at www.corinthtx.gov.
