**A. CALL TO ORDER**

Chairmen Terkelsen called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.

**B. CITIZENS COMMENTS**

Katherine Clark stated that the City of Corinth would benefit by adding Pickleball courts. It would provide revenue for restaurants, and be a good adult activity for Corinth residents.

The board thought the Meadowview Park community build was a good experience. The board stated the grills need to be mounted.

5. Hold a discussion on adding Pickleball Courts in Corinth.

The item was presented, and discussion followed.

The board discussed possible locations: Woods Park basketball court, Community Park basketball court. Public Works Director Glenn Barker is going to contact City of Denton.


6. Board Member Updates
