The board voted and approved to purchase of the following components.

-Fence Material and Design - 5' tall powder-coated fence with smaller gaps at the bottom. Chairmen Terkelsen motioned to approve, Board member Johnson seconded the motion.

-Water fountain designs - 3 green 2 tier fountains inside dog area. Chairmen Terkelsen motioned to approve, Board member Guyette seconded the motion.

-Bench material and design - on post, powder-coated green, as many as donated with footers, cut engraving. Board member Guyette motioned to approve, Chairmen Terkelsen seconded the motion.

Waste stations - 3 green waste stations with trash cans. Board member Guyette motioned to approve, Board member Johnson seconded the motion.

2. Consider and act on minutes from the February 8, 2022, meeting.

Chairmen Terkelsen motioned to approve February 8th, 2022 meeting minutes. Board member Guyette seconded the motion.

3. Discuss the Meadowview Park project.

The City will continue to post the volunteer sign-up page on the Corinth Facebook page. The board discussed sharing the volunteer page on Nixel, City Website, local Highschools, and NextDoor App to get more volunteers for the community build.

4. Receive a presentation on Fairview Park and Community Park Interactive Trail, and vote on each to begin development of the FY2023 budget.

Chairmen Terkelsen voted to begin development for Fairview Park in 2023. Board member Guyette seconded the motion. Chairmen Terkelsen voted to move the community trail to future development. Board member Guyette seconded the motion.

5. Hold a discussion and vote on adding Pickleball Courts in Corinth.

The board held a discussion on adding pickleball courts in corinth. They would like more information on cost.


