

Item/Caption

Item Summary/Background/Prior Action

On October 3, 2019 the City Council approved a five year contract with an option for three one-year renewals with Community Waste Disposal for solid waste collections. The current solid waste contract with Community Waste Disposal expires in December 2024. Services provided by Community Waste Disposal includes garbage collection, recycling, household hazardous waste pickup and yard waste services.

City staff published a survey, designed to be accessible for both business and residential customers, to get a better grasp of the community’s preferences on trash and recycling services. The survey was open to residents from February 16 - March 16, 2023. Staff distributed the survey through social media platforms, sent a notice in the utility bills, sent a news release to individuals registered with a utility account, and sent a text alert through the city’s notification system.

Staff will provide an overview of the survey results.

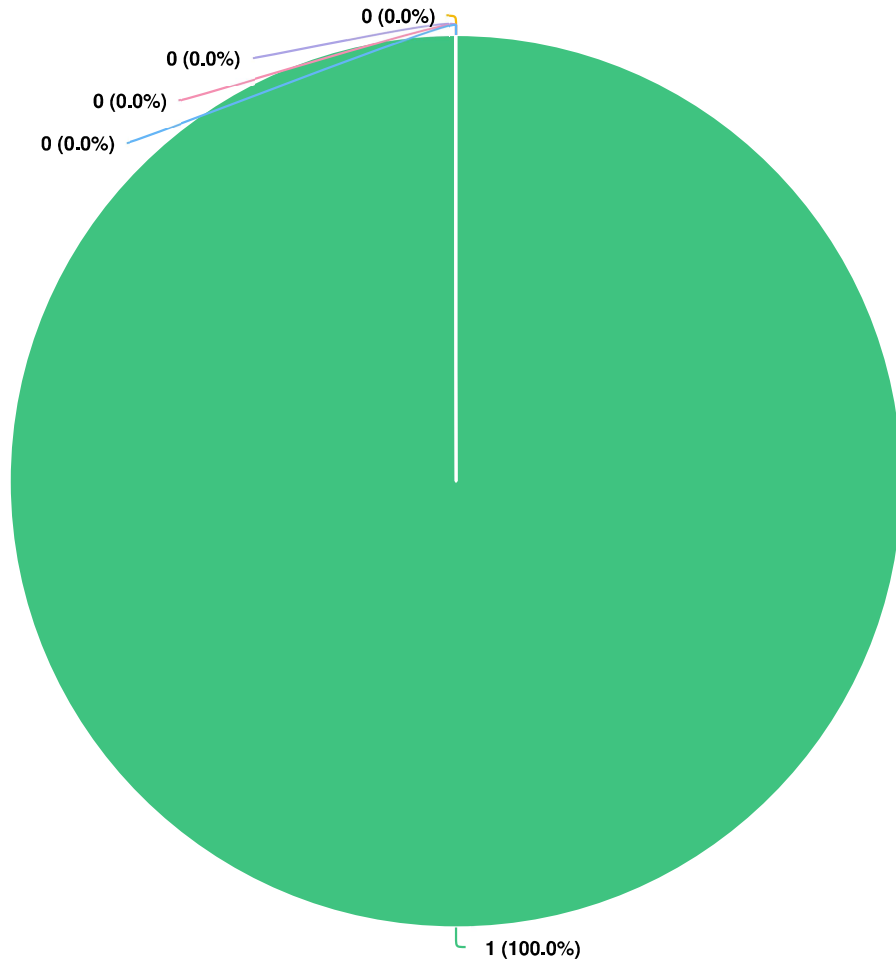

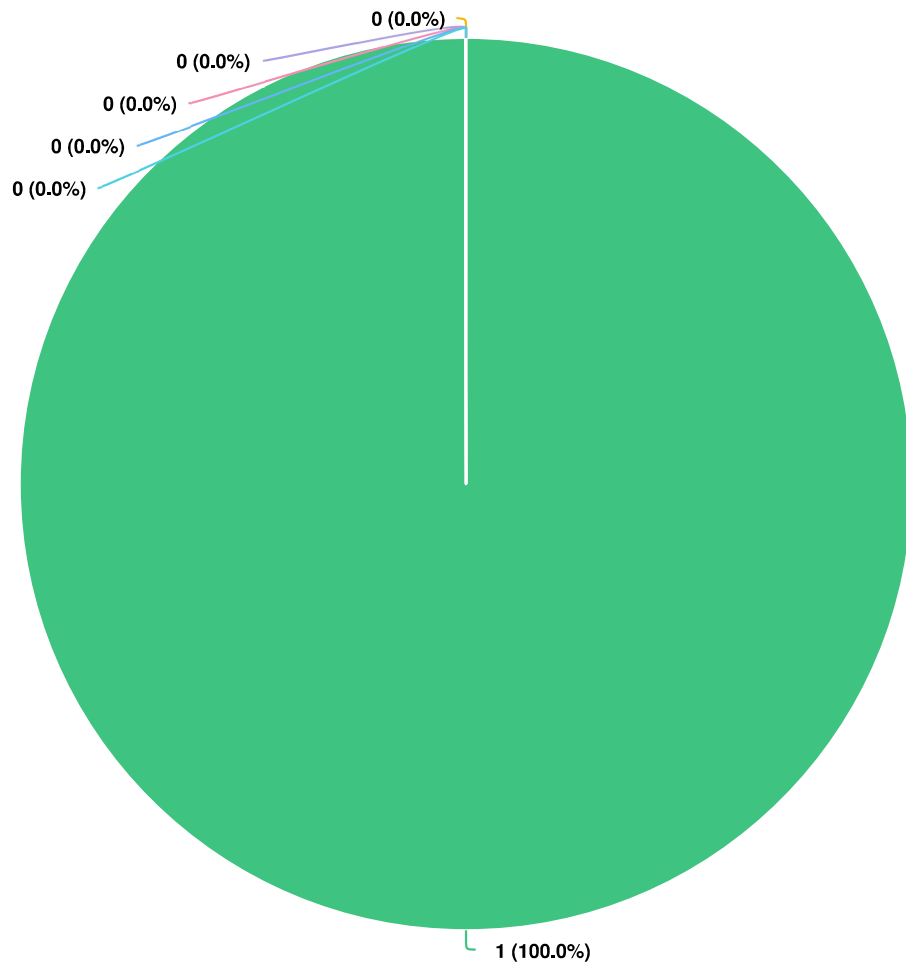

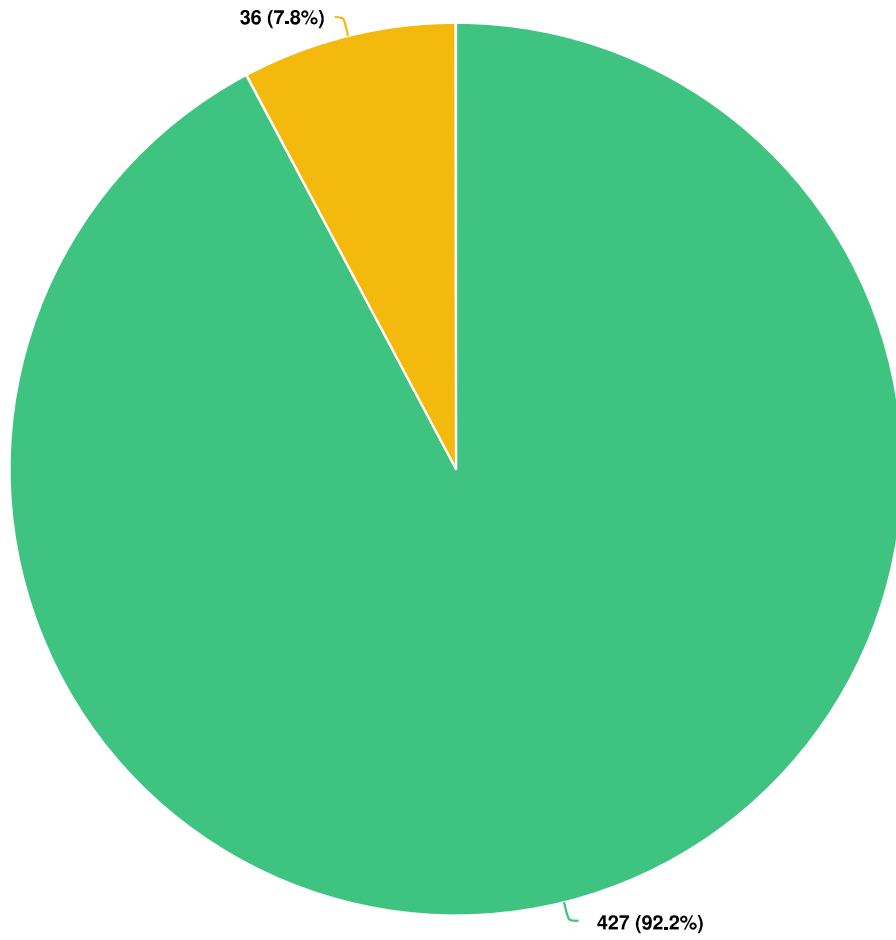

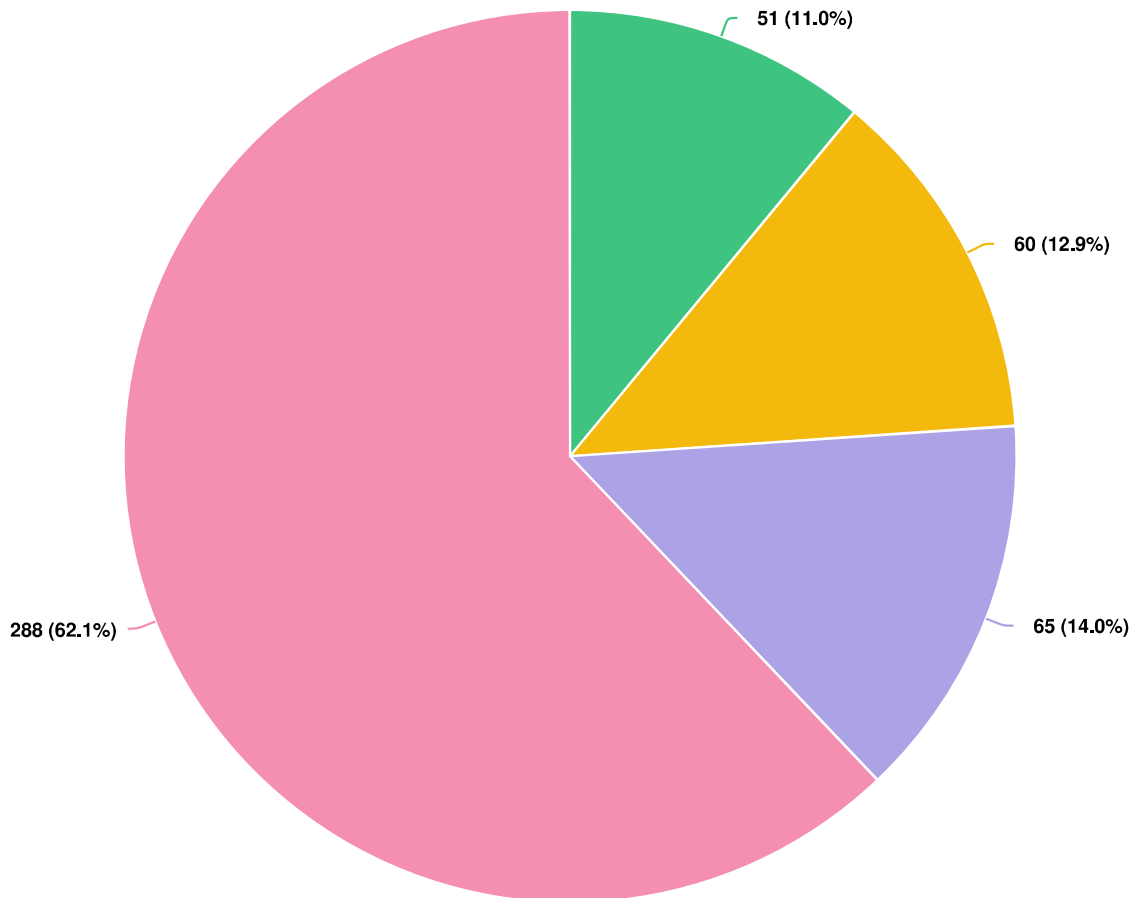

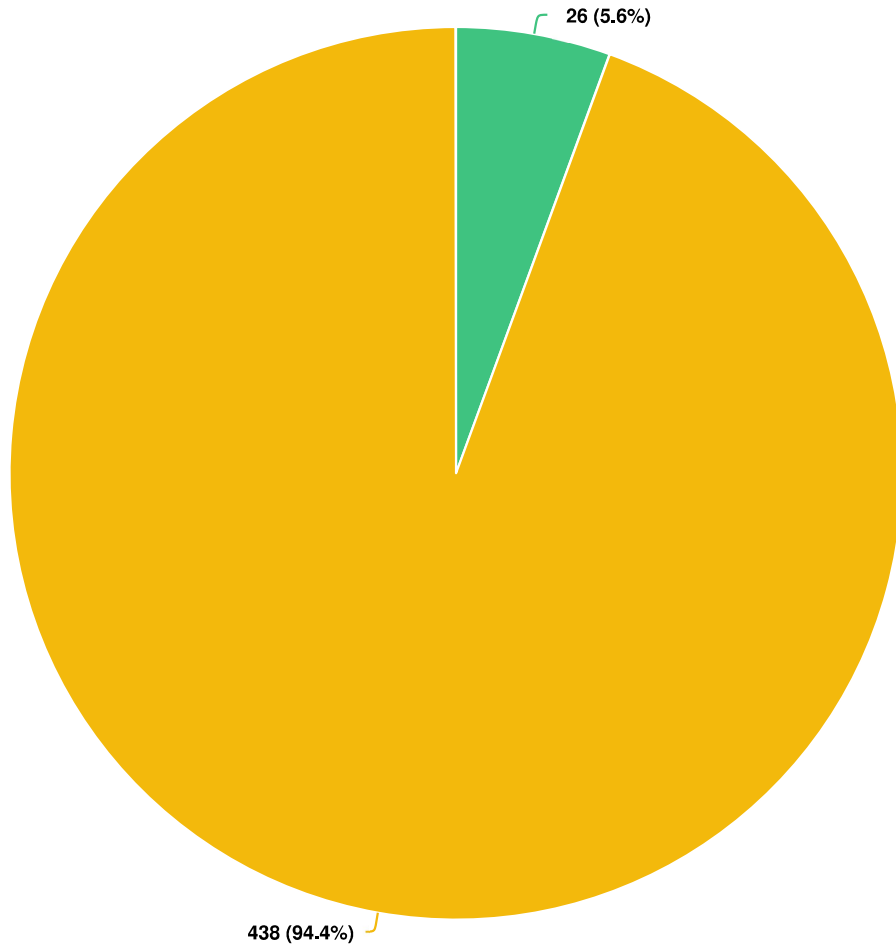

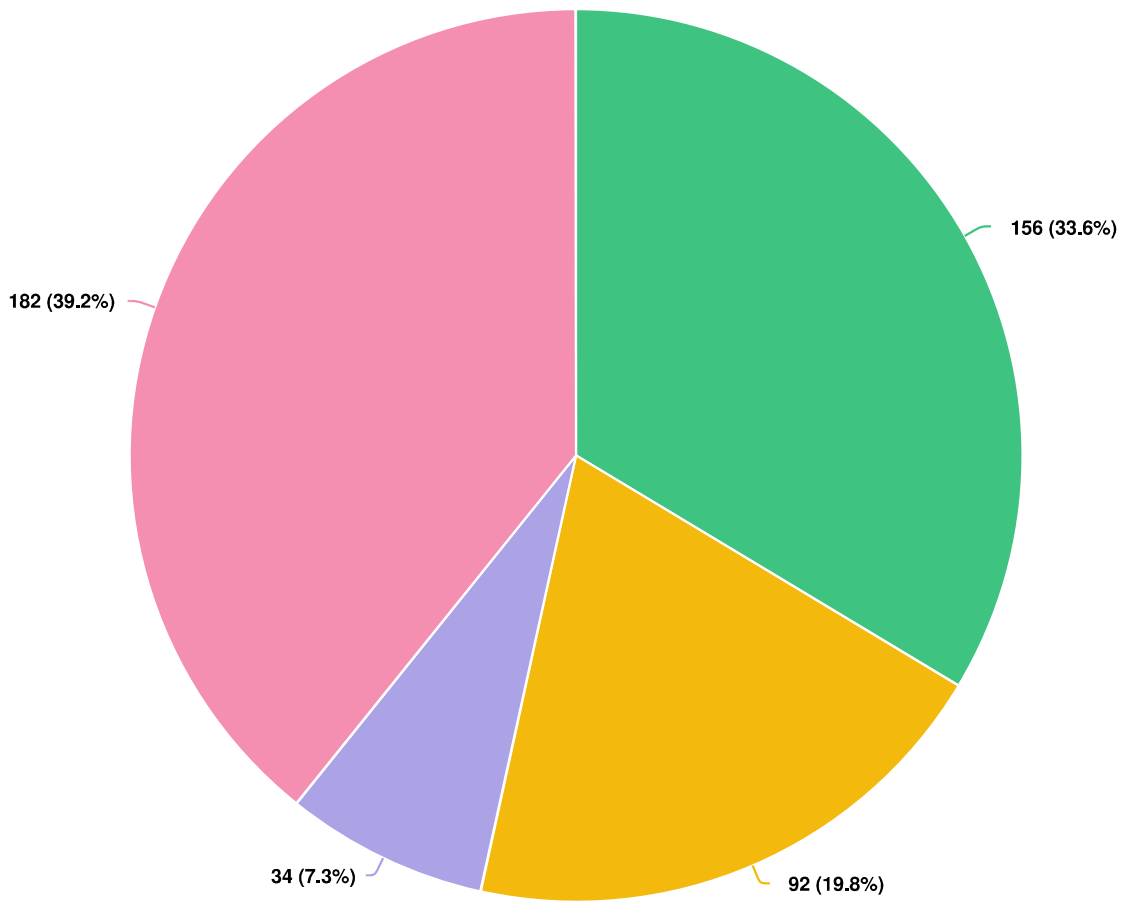

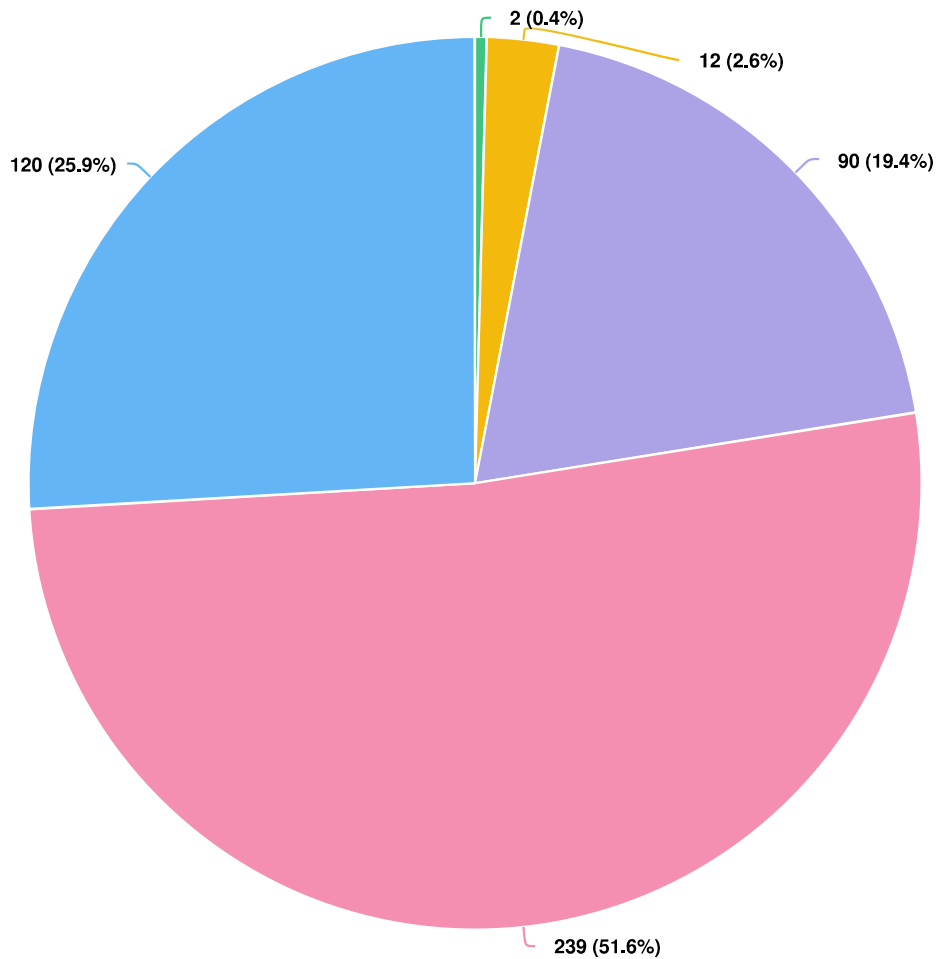

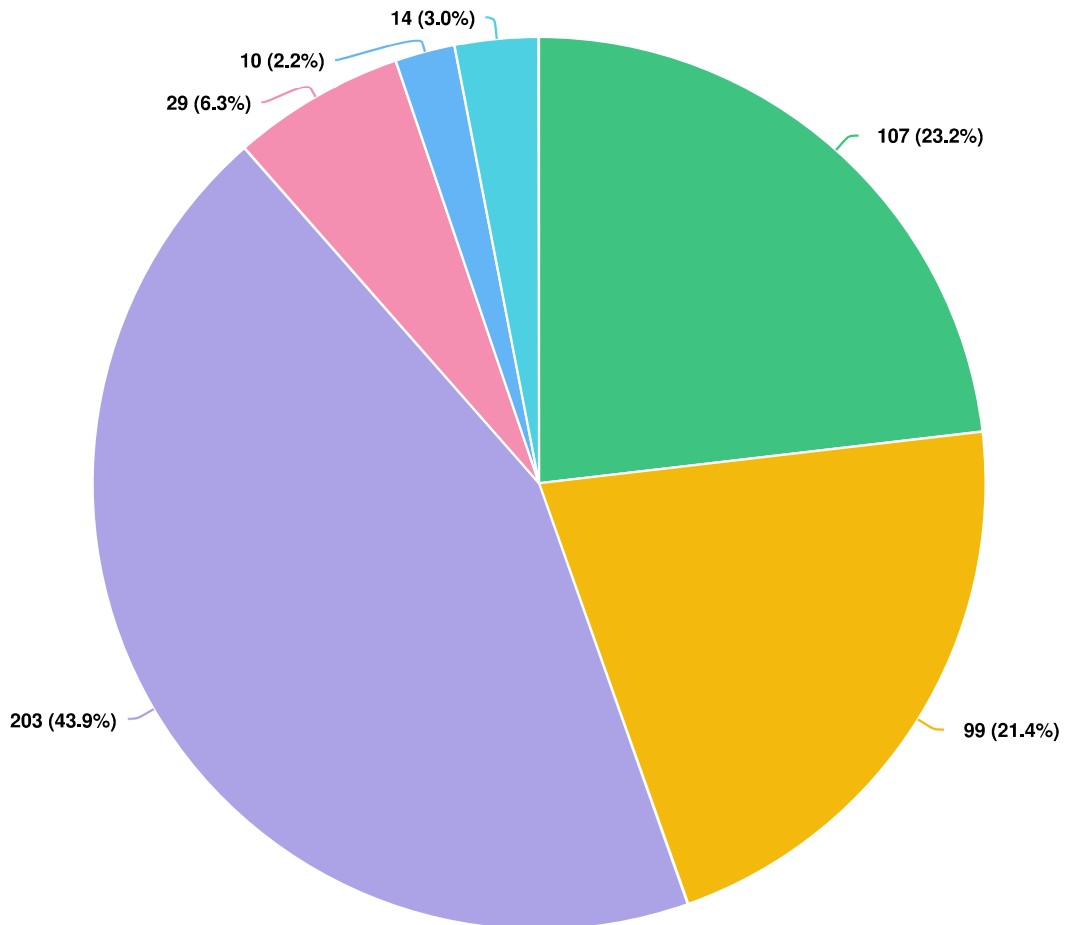

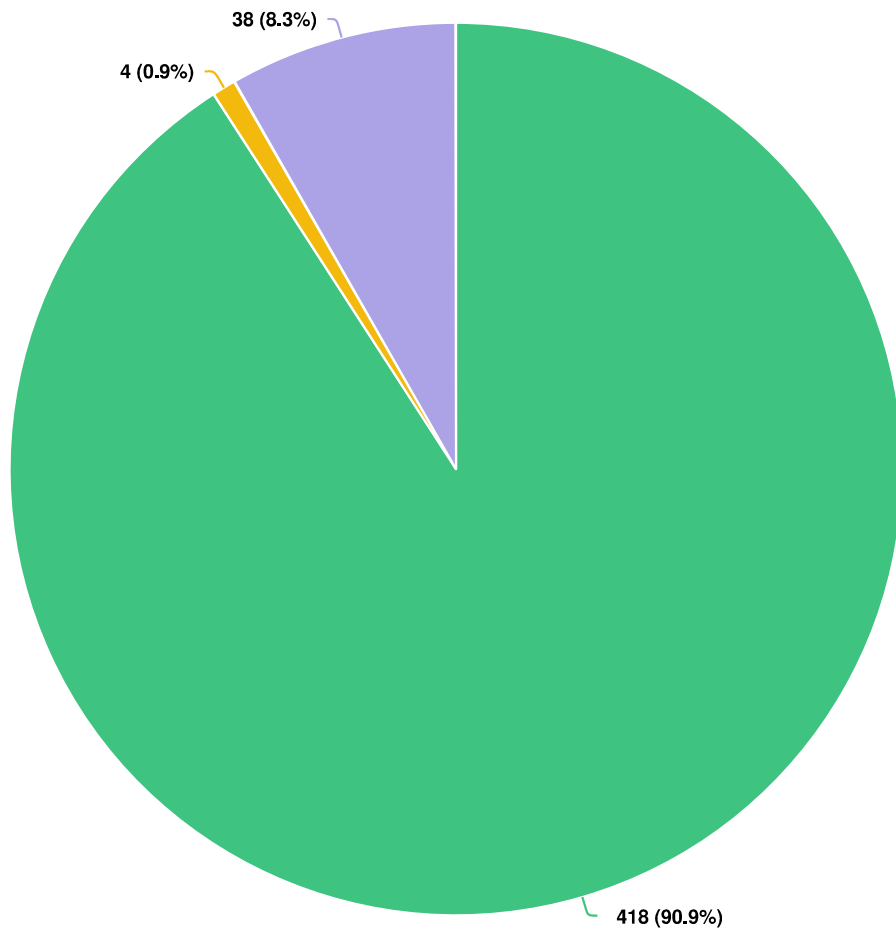

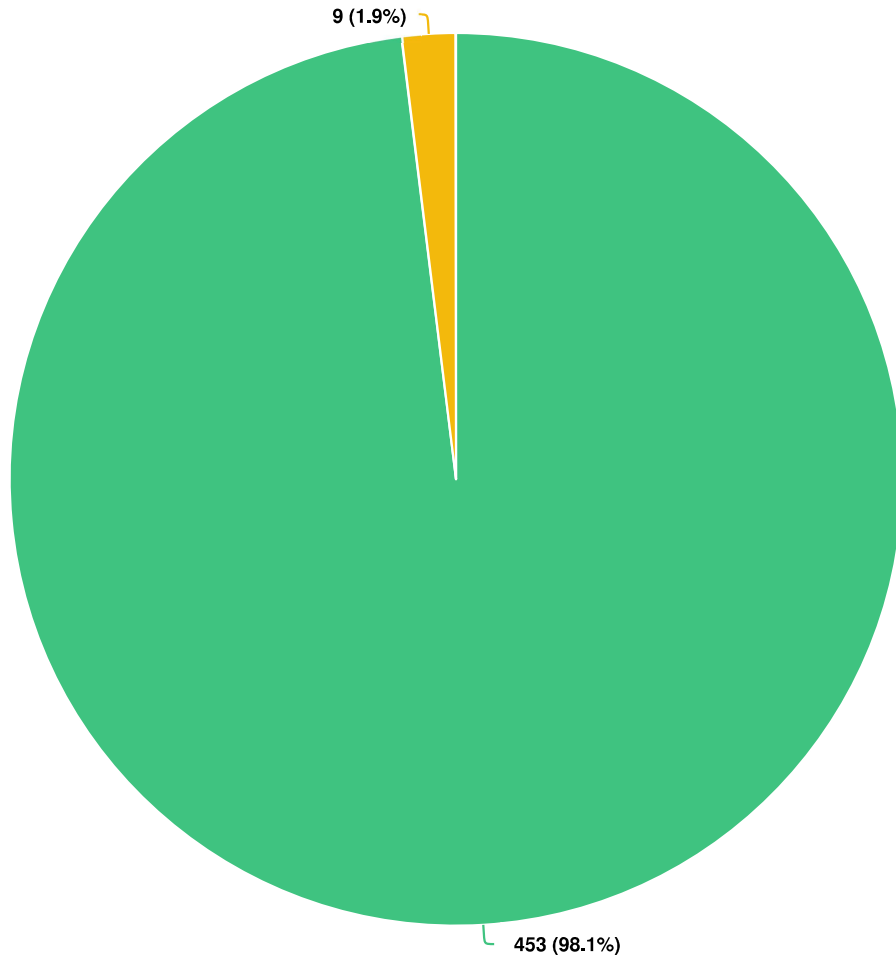

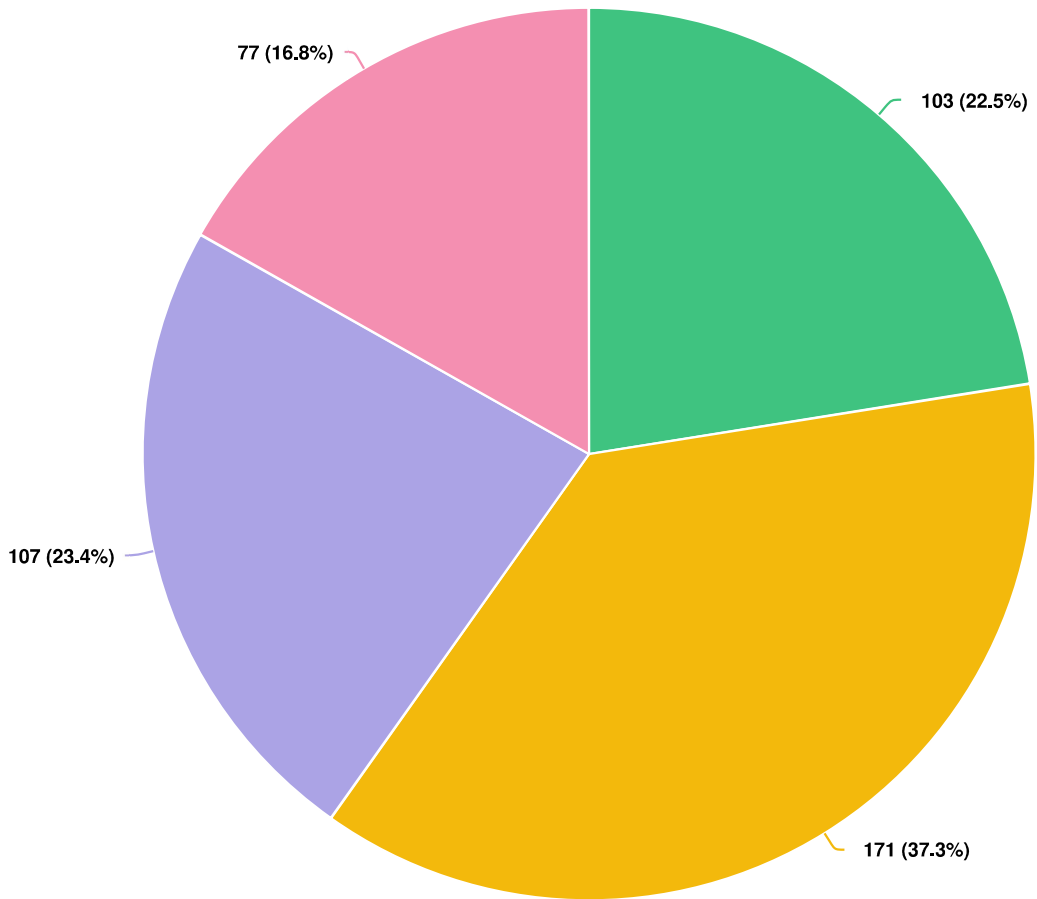

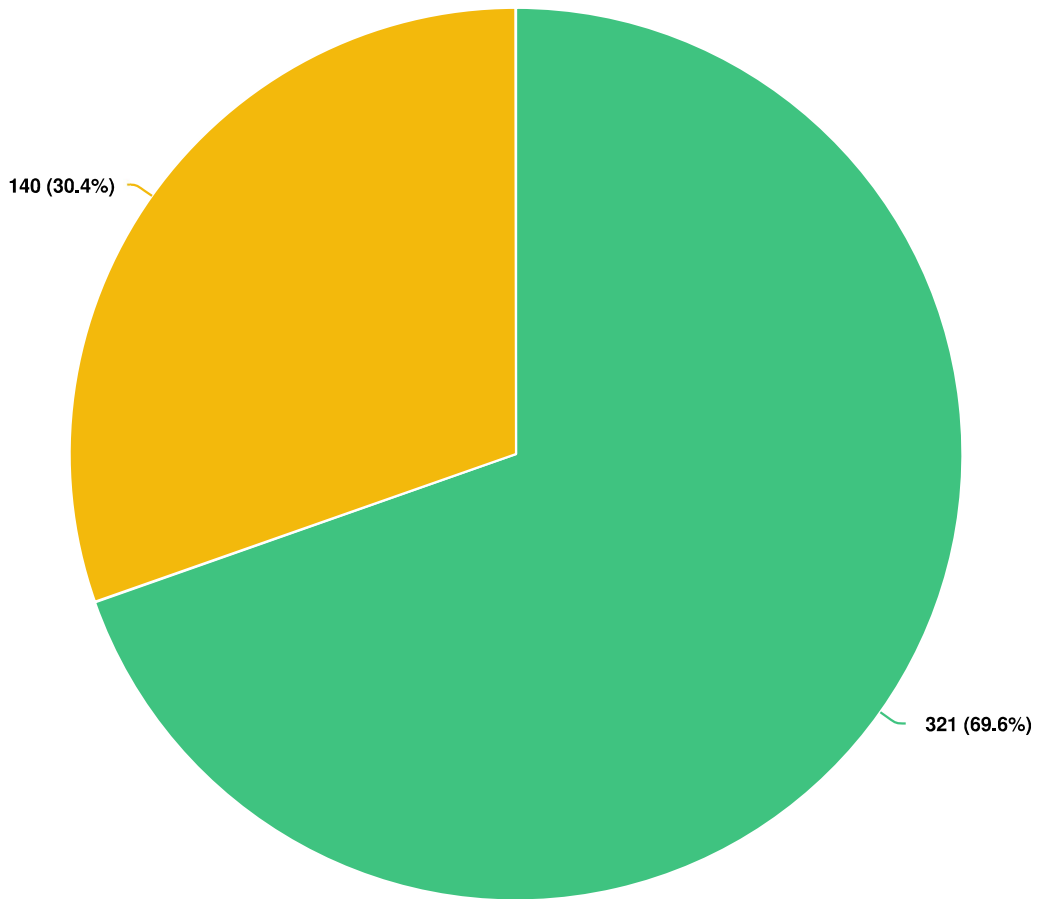

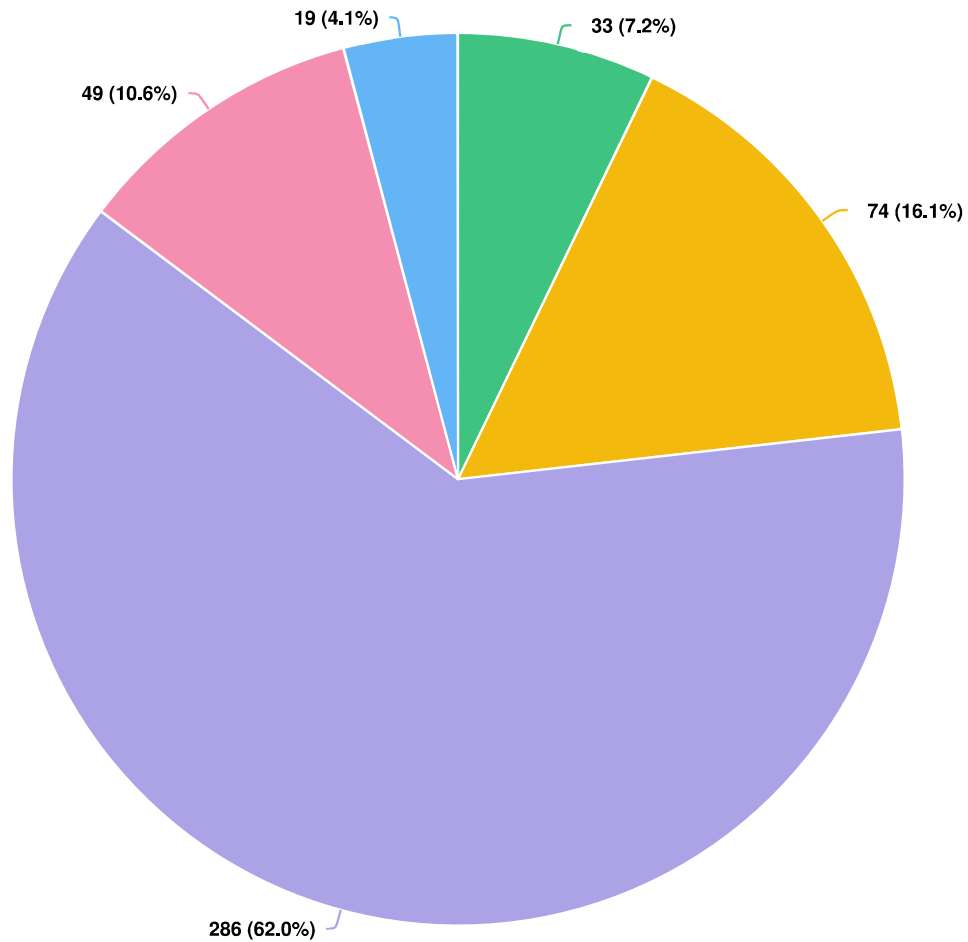

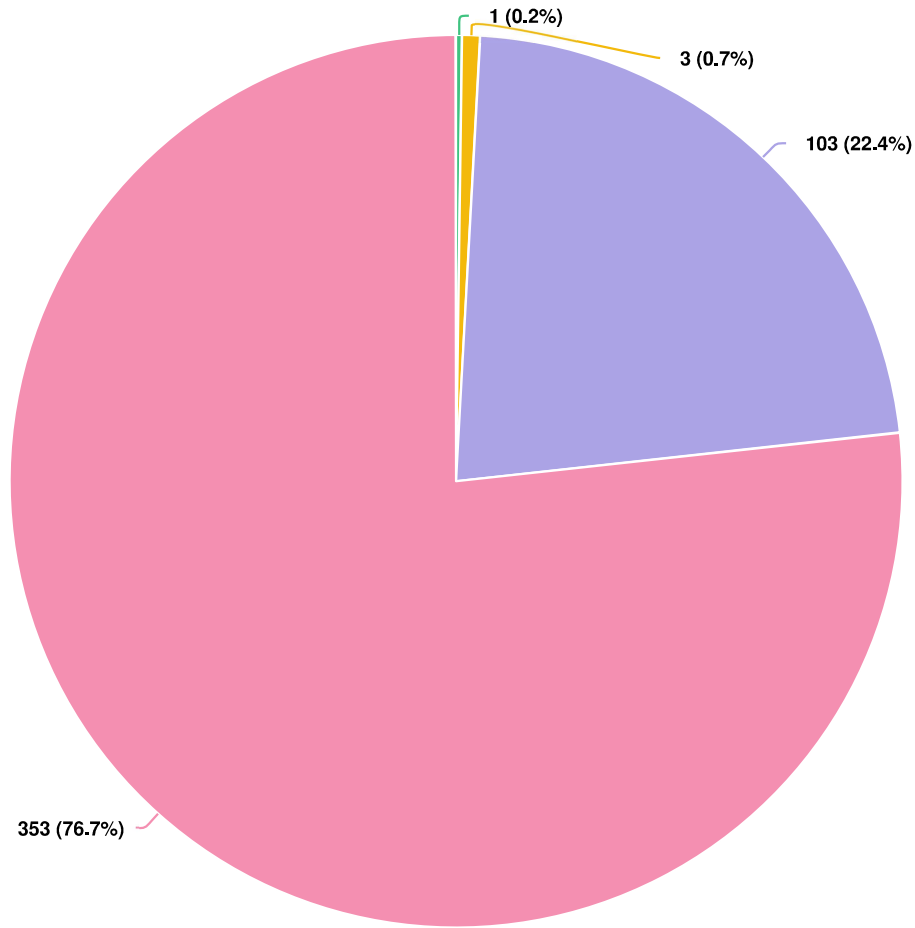

Q23 How often do you contact either city staff or the current solid waste provider regarding a missed collection or other service issue?

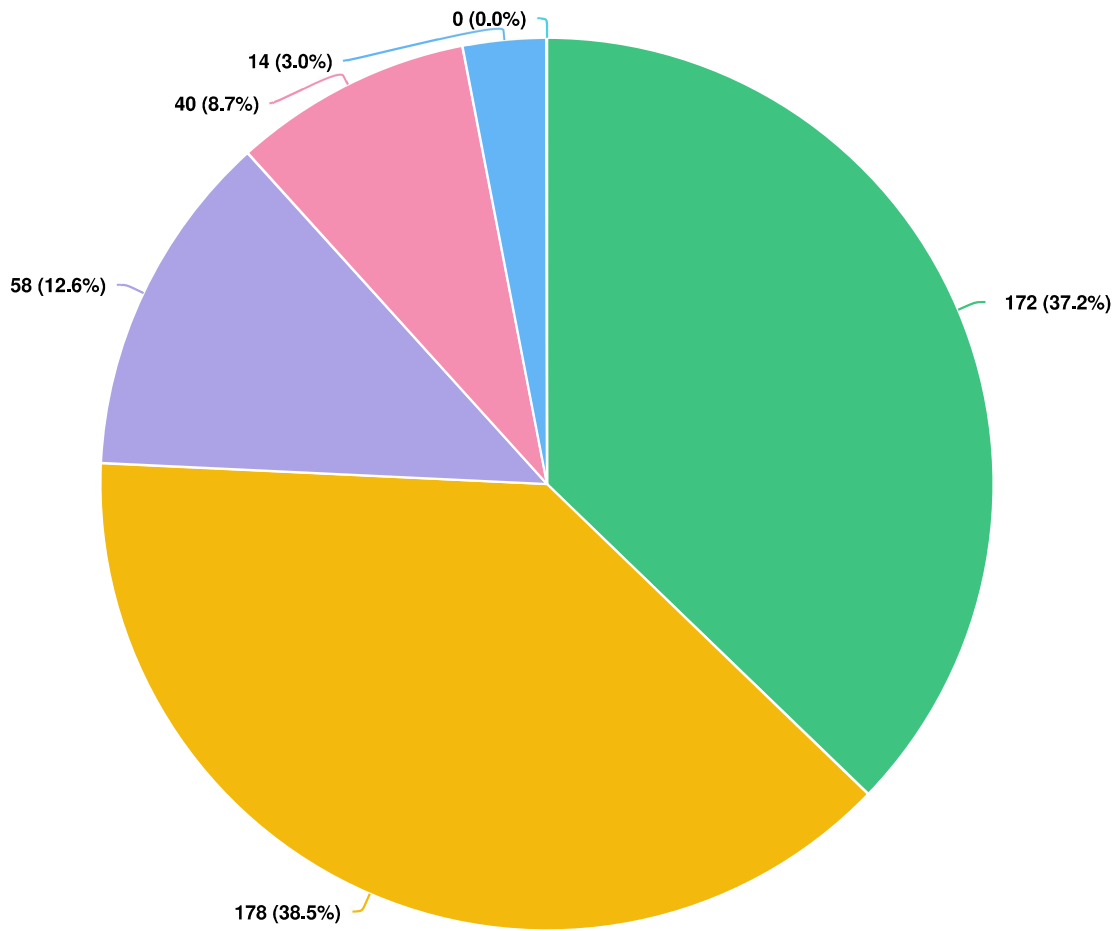

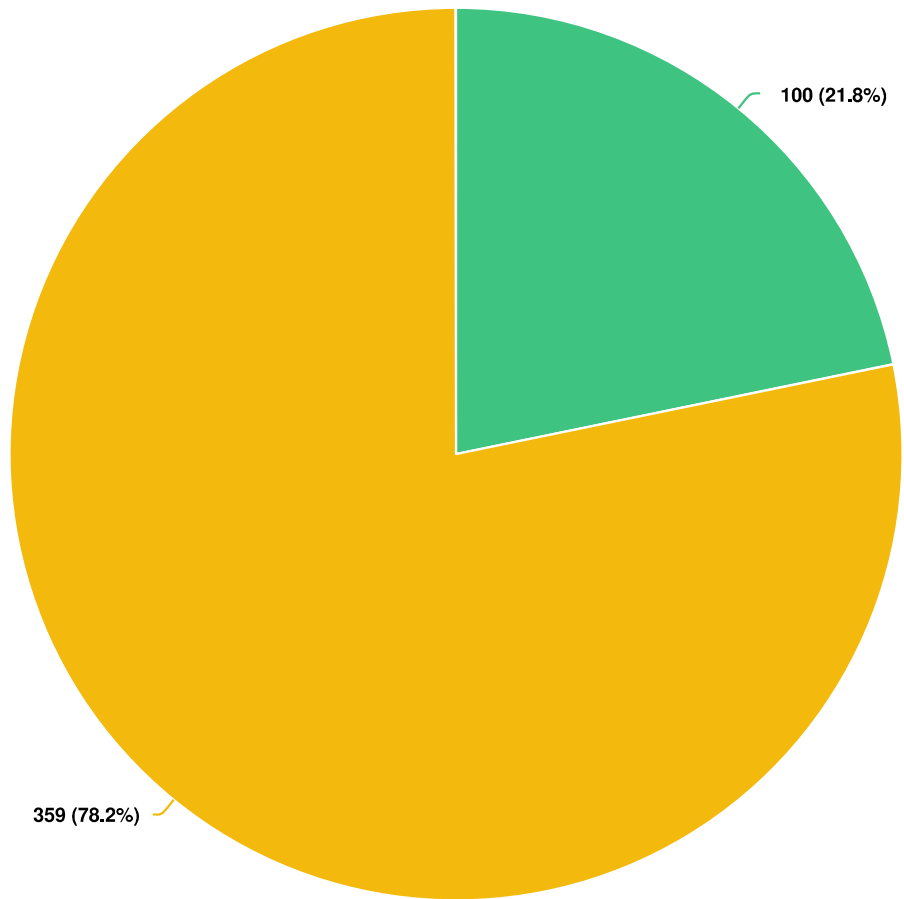

There are a lot or questions here that would seem to imply increased cost of service, either for the waste collection service to provide containers or for increased services. Without more information, it is difficult to answer given the choices to pick from. I moved to Corinth from Carrollton four years ago and my water/garbage bill is nearly double what I was paying in Carrollton where 65 gallon containers were provided. My first week in my house, the collection service picked up everything left on the curb by the previous owner, including the containers which were not WM containers. When I called, I was told to go buy two new containers and provide the receipts for reimbursement. After several weeks, I called back to follow up on my reimbursement, and was then told that I would NOT be reimbursed. So, I got off to a bad start. Over the last 4 years, there have been a number of days for which I have paid for service via my monthly bill, but have not received service either because of holidays or bad weather. When this occurs, we should see a CREDIT on our bill, just as I get a CREDIT on my cable bill when there is an outage. But, instead, we receive no service and no credit. I believe some of my neighbors may be receiving some sort of notification, as I see garbage containers being set out on different days occasionally, but there again, the communication is not reaching everyone thereby leading to missed services that are still being billed. As for hazardous waste disposal, again I have been here for 4 years and was unaware that this service was available. So, information about it does not appear to be widely dispersed, much less dates of service. Again, something that was provided in Carrollton. I apologize for seeming to rant, but the survey could have designed better with more complete answer selections and additional information to be considered

regarding impact to cost of services tied to various answer choices.

Item/Caption

Consider and act on an Ordinance of the City of Corinth approving an amendment to the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget and annual program of services to provide for the expenditure of funds to pay for facilities; and providing an effective date.

Item Summary/Background/Prior Action

The Annual Program of Services was adopted on September 22, 2022, by the City Council. During the fiscal year it was determined that it was in the best interest to do repairs and improvements to city facilities to 1) protect the public health or safety of the community and 2) because of unforeseen damage to public equipment and property. The proposed budget amendment in the amount of \$208,000 is for the following expenditures:

- Asbestos survey/removal and demolition of property owned by the city located on Lake Sharon Drive - \$110,000
- Construction of a server room and replacement of a fire suppression alarm system in City Hall - \$98,000

Financial Impact

The budget amendment proposes the use of fund balance from the General Fund.

Applicable Owner/Stakeholder Policy

Section 9.05 Supplemental Appropriations of the City Charter allows that “if during the fiscal year the City Manager certifies that there are revenues available in excess of those estimated in the budget or funds otherwise available in unencumbered reserves, the Council by ordinance may make supplemental appropriations for the year up to the amount of these available funds.”

Staff Recommendation/Motion

Staff recommends approval of the Ordinance amending the fiscal year 2022-23 Annual Program of services for the expenditure of funds to pay for facilities.

ORDINANCE NO. 23-05-04-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORINTH, TEXAS APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 22-09-22-33 REGARDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 CITY OF CORINTH BUDGET AND ANNUAL PROGRAM OF SERVICES TO PROVIDE FOR EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS TO PAY FOR FACILITY NEEDS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Corinth is a home-rule municipality acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a budget and appropriated resources for the budget year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023 by Ordinance No. 22-09-22-33; and

WHEREAS, the current adopted budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 does not have adequate funding to pay \$208,000 for an asbestos survey/removal, demolition of city property, and reconstruction of a server and fire suppression/alarm system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate and necessary to amend the budget to reflect expenditures from the General Fund Balance of \$208,000 for an asbestos survey/removal, demolition of city property, and reconstruction of a server and fire suppression/alarm system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this budget amendment is consistent with § 9.05 of the City Charter and the proposed change in the budget is for a municipal purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORINTH HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I

The findings set forth in the above preamble to this Ordinance are true and correct.

SECTION II

Ordinance No. 22-09-22-33 the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023, shall be amended as follows:

Two Hundred Eight Thousand Dollars (\$208,000) shall be appropriated into the Expenditures Line Items for the City Hall General Services Budget.

The City of Corinth Budget and Annual Program of Services is hereby amended to increase the City Hall General Services budget by **\$208,000** for the an asbestos survey/removal, demolition of city property, and reconstruction of a server and fire suppression/alarm system. Further, the City Council affirms its approval of the expenditure of funds for the aforementioned purposes.

SECTION IV

The City Secretary is hereby directed to attach a copy of this Ordinance to Ordinance No. 22-09-22-33.

SECTION V

Pursuant to Section 102.009(d) of the Texas Local Government Code, the municipal budget officer is directed to file a true copy of this amendment with the Denton County Clerk. If the mayor objects to this ordinance, it shall be adopted by a majority of the entire City Council.

SECTION VI

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, and it is so ordained.
