

Consider and act on an Ordinance of the City Council canvassing and declaring the results of the General and Special Election held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing persons to serve as Mayor, Council Member for an unexpired term ending May, 2026 for Place 2 and Place 5 for a term of three (3) years; providing confirmation of voting tabulation; and providing an effective date.

Item Summary/Background/Prior Action

On May 2, 2026, the City’s Joint General and Special Election was held under the provisions of the City Charter and the Election Code to elect a Mayor, an unexpired term for Council Member to Place 2, and Council Member Place 5, to the City Council of the City of Corinth, Texas. State law requires that the governing body of the City of Corinth canvass all elections. The return of the General Election, including the returns of the early voting ballots, duly and legally made.

We anticipate Denton County Elections will provide the final election results on Monday, May 11, 2026. The Ordinance will reflect the final election results.
