

MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 25th DAY OF MARCH 2024 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 6:00 P.M.

THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: IANTHIA FISHER, DENNIS IVEY, ERNEST JACKSON, MARQUITA BEASLEY & MIKE MARSH. CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: CITY ADMINISTRATOR JOHN ANGERSTEIN, CITY SECRETARY MITZI STEFKA, AND FIRE MARSHAL/BUILDING OFFICIAL LEE STANDLEY. DARRELL JONES WAS ABSENT.

Mayor Pro Tem Marsh made a motion to approve the consulting agreement with Nancy Windham for CEIDC Project Coordinator. Council member Ivey seconded the motion. Motion passes 4-0.
