

MINUTES OF THE CROCKETT CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 23rd DAY OF OCTOBER 2023 IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 200 NORTH FIFTH IN THE CITY OF CROCKETT, HOUSTON COUNTY TEXAS AT 6:00 P.M.
