RESOLUTION NO. R-06-23

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CITY OF CROCKETT'S APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S 2023 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE (TA) CALL FOR PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation issued a call for projects in December 2022 for communities to apply for funding assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TA) Program; and

WHEREAS, the TA funds may be used for development of preliminary engineering (plans, specifications, and estimates and environmental documentation) and construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure. The TA funds require a local match, comprised of cash or Transportation Development Credits (TDCs), if eligible. The City of Crockett would be responsible for all non reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for TA funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROCKETT THAT:

The City of Crockett supports funding this project as described in the 2023 TA Detailed Application (including the preliminary engineering budget, if any, construction budget, the department's direct state cost for oversight, and the required local match, if any) and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. The City of Crockett is willing and able to enter into an agreement with the department by resolution or ordinance, should the project be selected for funding.

Local Park Grant Program Resolution Authorizing Application

A resolution of the <u>City of Crockett</u> as hereinafter referred to as "Applicant," designating certain officials as being responsible for, acting for, and on behalf of the Applicant in dealing with the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department, hereinafter referred to as "Department," for the purpose of participating in the <u>Local Park Grant Program</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "Program"; certifying that the Applicant is eligible to receive program assistance; certifying that the Applicant matching share is readily available; and dedicating the proposed site for permanent (or for the term of the lease for leased property) public park and recreational uses.

WHEREAS, the Applicant is fully eligible to receive assistance under the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is desirous of authorizing an official to represent and act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department concerning the Program;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE APPLICANT:

- **SECTION 1:** That the Applicant hereby certifies that they are eligible to receive assistance under the Program, and that notice of the application has been posted according to local public hearing requirements.
- **SECTION 2:** That the Applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.
- **SECTION 3:** That the Applicant hereby authorizes and directs the <u>Mayor</u> to act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department for the purposes of the Program, and that <u>Dr. lanthia Fisher</u> is hereby officially designated as the representative in this regard.
- SECTION 4: The Applicant hereby specifically authorizes the official to make application to the Department concerning the site to be known as <u>Davy Crockett Memorial Park</u> in the <u>City of Crockett</u> or use as a park site and is hereby dedicated (or will be dedicated upon completion of the proposed acquisition) for public park and recreation purposes in perpetuity (or for the lease term, if legal control is through a lease). Projects with federal monies may have differing requirements.
