Asma Nadeem, applicant, came forward to answer any questions from the Board.

Board Member Brown stated that she would like to change her vote.

With a revote, the vote was 4-0 to approve the application.

Chairman Napps called the applicant to the podium.

Shams Jooma, 496 E Main St., came forward to represent the application.

Mrs. Drake stated if the board chose to approve this application, that the approval would be pending results from the background check. The Cartersville Police Department's fingerprint background check machine is currently down.

Board Member Kollhoff joined the meeting.

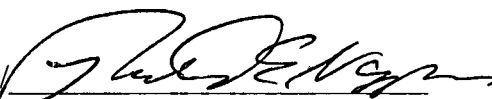
**OTHER**
