



 - All connector roads and all driveways shall be tied in to make a smooth transition as agreed upon by the Owner and the Contractor.
 - All GDOT paving specifications shall be met upon completion of the project.
 - Contractor pricing will include adjusting all mailboxes 2' from edge of pavement prior to the placement of the first course of asphalt. All mailboxes moved shall meet the USPS guidelines.
 - Contractor pricing shall include all signage where required.
 - All traffic control shall be the responsibility of the contractor. The plan for traffic control must be approved by Dawson County prior to start of construction.
 - Contractor shall provide a five (5) year warranty on all work completed, and all rework and warranty areas shall be repaired within forty-five (45) days of notification by Dawson County. This warranty timeframe is for both the FDR and the asphalt, to include base failure, rutting, raveling and settlement.


