INFORMATION

1. Mayor Taylor - Topics of Discussion:

Mayor Taylor expressed her gratitude to the Historic Preservation Commission for addressing some of her concerns in the Historic District.

Mayor Taylor requested advice from the commission on zoning in the Historic District, specifically manufacturing, which is currently not part of the zoning ordinance in the Historic District, as there are tentative zoning changes in the future.

Mayor Taylor requested input from the commission as possible changes to the alcoholic ordinance may result in new types of licenses that would not require purchasing from a distributor.

Code enforcement in the Historic District was discussed due to the frustration in ensuring issues are addressed and repaired, not just the fine paid. The commission feels concerned with the maintenance of buildings under their purview.

The current structure of the HPC Board and the ability of its members to act on issues brought to it were discussed. The HPC understands that its members' opinions are valuable, but at this point, they are only suggestions.
