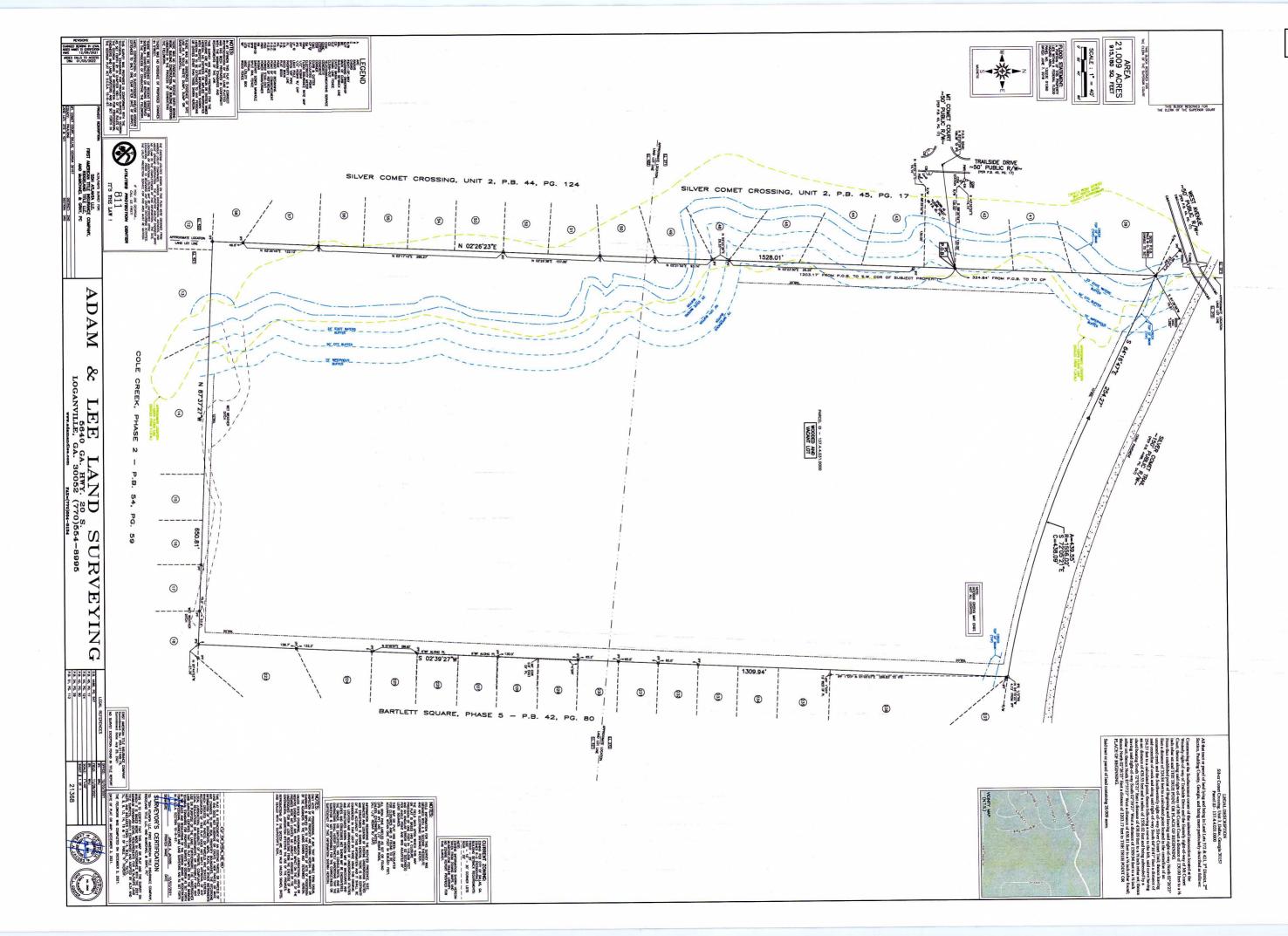

DEED UNDER POWER OF SALE

THIS INDENTURE, made as of the 6th day of April, 2021, by KENNETH M. HARDY, a resident of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as "Borrower"), acting by and through WILLIAM R. COBB, a resident of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as "Lender"), the duly appointed agent and attorney-in-fact of Borrower, as party of the first part, and WILLIAM R. COBB, as party of the second part (hereinafter referred to as "Buyer").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Borrower made and delivered to Lender that certain Promissory Note from Borrower to Lender, dated March 7, 2018, in the original principal amount of One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Seventy and 50/100 Dollars (\$106,670.50), with principal, attorneys' fees and other costs of collection payable as set forth therein (hereinafter referred to as the "Note"); and,

WHEREAS, as security for the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, Borrower executed and delivered to Lender that certain Deed to Secure Debt dated March 7, 2018, and recorded on March 19, 2018, in the Office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Paulding County, Georgia, in Deed Book 3844, Page 3 (hereinafter referred to as the "Security Deed"), which Security Deed conveyed the property herein described as security for the Note; and,

WHEREAS, the Security Deed contained a power of sale authorizing the sale of the property conveyed by the Security Deed in the event the indebtedness secured thereby was not paid when due or upon other specified defaults and constituted Lender as attorney-in-fact of Borrower to make said sale and deliver a conveyance of said property to the purchaser; and.

WHEREAS, a default occurred, and by reason of said default Lender elected, pursuant to the terms of the Note and Security Deed, to declare the entire principal and interest immediately due and payable; and,

WHEREAS, Lender as attorney-in-fact of Borrower and according to the terms of the Security Deeds, did give notice of default to the Borrower and upon the Borrower's failure to cure said default in accordance with law and the provisions contained in the Security Deed did advertise said property for sale once a week for four (4) weeks in the newspaper in Paulding County, Georgia, wherein the Sheriff carries his advertisements, namely the Dallas New Era, said dates of publication being March 12, 19 and 26 and April 2, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, notice was provided to Borrower in the manner and to the extent required by law; and.

WHEREAS, Lender, as attorney-in-fact of Borrower, did expose said property for sale to the highest bidder for each on the first Tuesday in April, 2021, within the legal hours of sale at the usual place for conducting Sheriff's sales in Paulding County, Georgia, and offered said property for sale at public outcry to the highest hidder for cash, when and where Buyer bid ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NINE AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$145,009.00); and,

WHEREAS, the said property was knocked off to Buyer for the aforesaid sum;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and said sum of money and by virtue of and in the exercise of the power of sale contained in the Security Deeds, Borrower, acting by and through Lender as attorney-in-fact, has bargained, sold, granted and conveyed, and by these presents does hereby bargain, sell, grant and convey to Buyer, Seller's one half interest in that certain tract or parcel of real property which is more particularly described as follows:

LETTER OF INTENT: Variance Request for 21.00 acres

Honorable Zoning Board of Appeals Members.

On behalf of, HRV DEVCO, LLC and Bryan Ponder (the "Applicant"), please accept this Letter of Intent to request a variance to remove the requirement of a swimming pool as a mandatory 1st amenity for 21.00-acres of land, being Tax Parcel 137.4.4.031.000 (the "Subject Property") for the development of a +/- (47) lot single-family residential community. The Subject Property is currently undeveloped and zoned R-2.

The Applicant is requesting a variance to code section 7.16.2.a to remove the requirement of a swimming pool as a mandatory 1st amenity. The project, which is adjacent to a phase of the Silver Comet Crossing subdivision, is uniquely situated adjacent to existing homeowners who would not be part of the new homeowners' association (HOA). The inclusion of a pool would create a significant and undeniable point of contention. The pool, a highly visible and desirable amenity, would exist in close proximity to residents who would not have the legal right to use it, but would likely attempt to do so. This situation creates a foreseeable practical difficulty for the HOA, requiring it to enforce access restrictions and manage conflicts, thereby diverting resources and creating a stressful, adversarial environment that undermines the peace and general welfare of the entire community.

Furthermore, requiring a pool for this phase creates an undue financial hardship on the future residents. The annual cost for the pool amenity is around \$513 per resident, where-as the expected annual dues for the proposed community without a pool are expected to be in the \$400 range. A community of this size would struggle to meet the significant annual costs of adding the additional \$513 in maintaining a swimming pool plus any additional special assessments. This financial burden potentially make the homes less attractive and affordable. Without the financial viability to consistently maintain the pool, it potentially could fall into disrepair, transforming a supposed asset into a significant public safety and liability risk for all residents.

In lieu of the swimming pool requirement, the applicant proposes to install three alternative amenities: two tot lots (playgrounds) and two picnic areas, including picnic tables and a BBQ grill/pit area, from the list of Allowable and Mandatory Recreational Amenities. Additionally, walking trails will be installed throughout providing a connection to the adjacent Silver Comet Trail.

Granting this variance would not change the essential character of the neighborhood. The surrounding developments, including the existing Silver Comet Crossing community, do not have a pool amenity, and this project is a natural extension of that existing neighborhood. By installing these alternative amenities, a granted variance would be consistent with the intent of section 7.16 by still including sufficient amenities for the community's enjoyment without unnecessary burdens. The variance would serve the greater good by fostering a cohesive community and preventing future conflicts.

If approved, a tentative schedule for the project would be as follows:

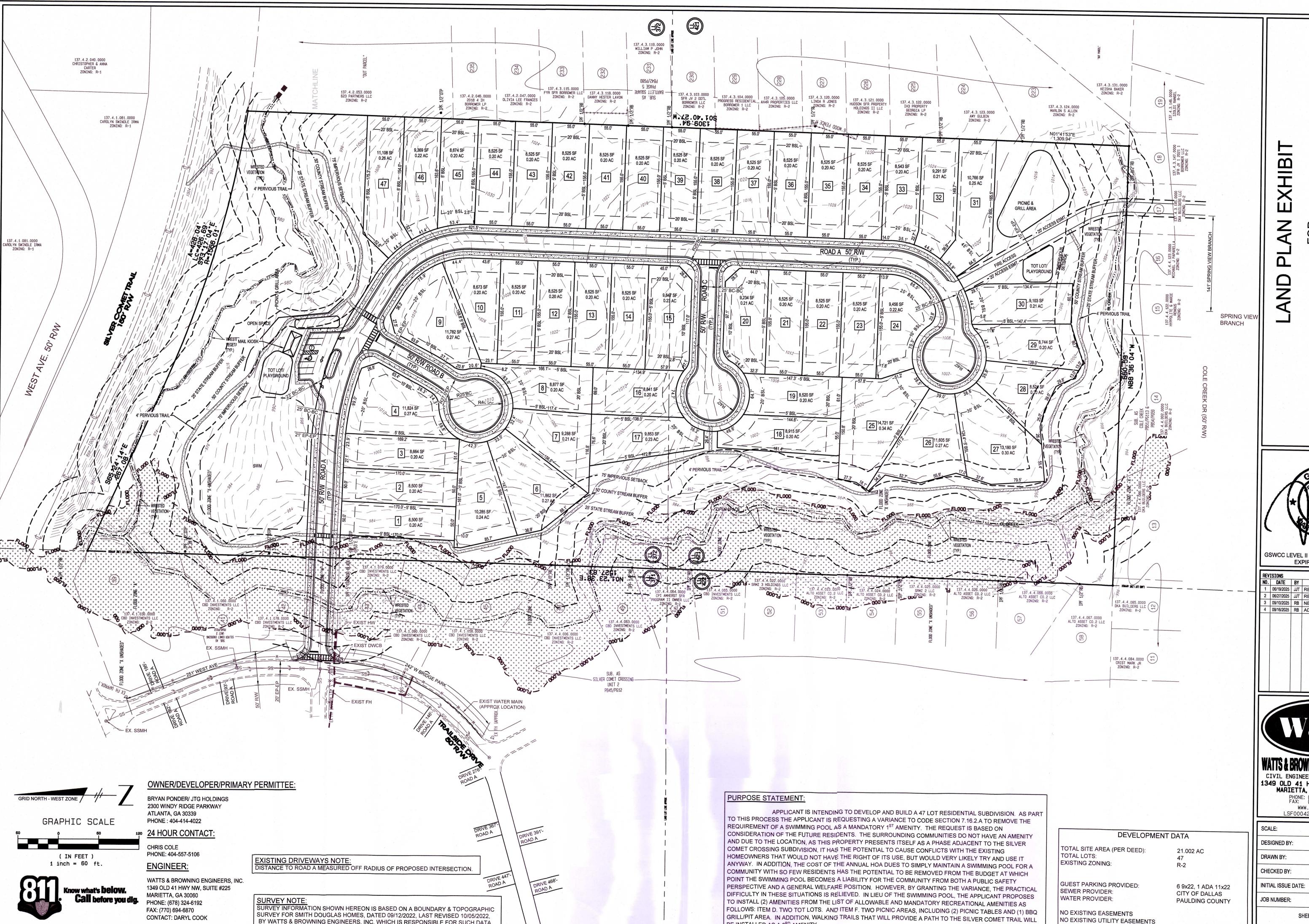

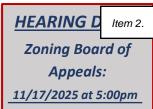
CHAPTER VII – DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

City of Dallas, Georgia

Sec. 7.16 - SINGLE-FAMILY DEVELOPMENT AMENITIES REQUIRED (R-1, R-2, R-3, TH, AND PUD)

- 1) Minimum Number of Amenities Required. Single-family residential subdivisions, either attached or detached, shall incorporate recreational amenities from the list in Subsection 2. Below in the following amounts:
 - a) Developments with fewer than twenty-five (25) dwelling units shall be exempt from this requirement; except that the Director may require an amenity not listed in this section to provide enhanced resident enjoyment and engagement.
 - b) Developments with twenty-five (25) to one hundred (100) dwelling units shall provide at least one amenity;
 - c) Developments with one-hundred one (101) to one-hundred seventy-five (175) dwelling units shall provide at least two (2) amenities; and
 - d) Developments with one-hundred seventy-six (176) or more dwelling units shall provide at least three (3) amenities and the City Council shall determine the ratio of additional recreational amenities based on National Recreation and Park Association (www.nrpa.org) standards.
- 2) Allowable and Mandatory Recreational Amenities:
 - a) Swimming pool sized to comply with NRPA standards (mandatory first amenity).
 - b) Golf course.
 - c) Resident clubhouse (second amenity option 1).
 - d) Two tot lots with a minimum size of five-hundred (500) square feet per lot.
 - e) Basketball, volleyball, or other sport court meeting the standards of Section 7.14(3)(c) (second amenity option 2).
 - f) Two picnic areas, with a minimum size of five-hundred (500) square feet per area, and including a minimum of two picnic tables and one (1) barbeque grill/pit per area.
 - g) Other amenity approved by the City Council
 - 3) Density Bonuses for Single-Family Development:
 - a) City may approve a five (5%) percent density bonus for every amenity provided in excess of the required amenities indicated in subsection 7.16(2) above, not to exceed a maximum of density bonus of twenty (20%) percent.

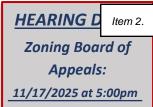

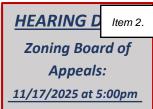

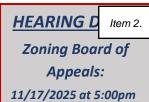


STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Based on the preceding analysis, if the Zoning Board of Appeals votes to recommend approval, staff recommends the following stipulations be applied:

- 1- Developer shall construct and have available for public use the following amenities at time if final plat approval by the city:
 - i. Two (2) tot lots.
 - ii. Two (2) picnic areas, including tables, fire pits, and BBQ areas.
 - iii. Hard surface walking trail of 8' in width around perimeter of development property within a common area easement, including a connection to the Silver Comet Trail, Silver Comet Crossing subdivision, and Bartlett Square subdivision.
- 2- On-site and Off-site sanitary sewer infrastructure is required to service subject development. Development shall be connected via gravity sewer connection. Installation of a sanitary sewer pump/lift station will not be acceptable. Owner/developer is responsible for connection and extension of the city's sanitary sewer system to service the proposed development.
- 3- Developer shall enter into a development agreement with the City of Dallas for the connection and extension of the city's sanitary sewer system to service the subject development. The final cost, approved contractor, and construction plan for the connection and extension of the city's sanitary sewer system improvements will be subject to the approval of the City of Dallas. The sanitary sewer system extension shall adhere to Chapter 40-UTILITIES; ARTICLE II Water and Sewer Service; DIVISION 2. Sewer Use; Sec. 40-61. Sewer extension, sewer system upgrade, and planned sewer requirements.
- 4- Subject development is within the West Dallas Special Utility District: Chapter 40-UTILITIES; ARTICLE II Water and Sewer Service; DIVISION 2. Sewer Use; Sec. 40-60. Special utility districts. ;(g) (1): West Dallas Sewer Collector Special Utility District.; e. The per lot fee, therefore, shall be \$1,843.00 per lot.
- 5- Development shall be constructed in substantial conformity to the site plan provided in development standard variance application.
- 6- Owner/developer is responsible for providing and installing Flock camera at development entrance compatible with the City of Dallas Police Department system.
- 7- Owner/developer shall provide written notice of concurrence from all entities noted in the Fiscal Impact Analysis.





- 8- Owner/developer shall agree rental properties shall not exceed 21% (Five (10) units) of the overall 47-unit lot count.
- 9- Proposed single-family development shall conform with all remaining standards found in the city's unified development code and code of ordinances.
