CITY OF DALTON PUBLIC SAFETY COMMISSION MINUTES NOVEMBER 18, 2025

The regular meeting for the Public Safety Commission was held today in Dalton City Hall's Council Chambers. Present were Chairman Truman Whitfield, Commissioners Alex Jones, Terry Mathis, Lane Jackson, Mayor Annalee Sams, Fire Chief Matt Daniel, Police Chief Cliff Cason, City Attorney Jonathan Bledsoe, City Administrator Andrew Parker and Assistant City Administrator Todd Pangle.

AGENDA APPROVAL

On the motion of Commissioner Brown, second Mayor Sams, the Commission approved the agenda as presented. The vote was unanimous in favor.

PUBLIC COMMENTARY

There were no public comments.

MINUTES

The Commissioners were presented written copies of the regular meeting minutes of October 21, 2025. On the motion of Mayor Sams, second Commissioner Jackson, the minutes were approved as presented. The vote was unanimous in favor.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Crime and Crash Statistics for October 2025

Police Chief Cliff Cason gave a written and oral summary of the Crime and Crash Statistical Reports for the month of October 2025. As noted in the written summary, Chief Cason reported there were 64 Part 1 crimes in October compared to 62 in October 2024, an increase of approximately 3.2%. There were 61 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 57 in October 2024, an increase of 7.02%. Chief Cason further stated Property crimes have decreased by 22.75% when compared to 2024.

Chief Cason also reported there were 135 non-private property crashes reported for the month an increase of 28.6% when compared to August 2025.

On the motion of Commissioner Brown, second Mayor Sams, the October Crime and Crash statistic report was approved. The complete report in its entirety is a part of these minutes. The vote was unanimous in favor.

Financial Statistics for October 2025

Police Chief Cliff Cason presented the Financial Report for all divisions within the Dalton Police Department for the month of October 2025. Chief Cason reported the department has expended 76.5% of the budget and is on track for the remainder of FY 2025.

On the motion of Commissioner Brown, second Commissioner Jackson, the financial report was approved. The complete report in its entirety is a part of these minutes. The vote was unanimous in favor.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Monthly Statistical Report – October 2025

Fire Chief Matt Daniel presented the October 2025 Statistical Report to the Commission. Chief Daniel outlined details of the complete report, which included the Incident Report with 300 Total Responses, a decrease from the previous month. Chief Daniel also outlined the details of Incidents by Staff hours, Incidents by Months and Stations, Average Response Time, Average Turnout Time, Average Travel Time, Injury and Property Loss, Training Division Monthly Report, and the Inspection Summary.

On the motion of Commissioner Brown, second Commissioner Jackson, the Commissioners approved the Statistical Report for the Fire Department. A copy of the report is a part of these minutes. The vote was unanimous in favor.

FIRE DEPARTMENTContinued

Monthly Financial Report – October 2025

Fire Chief Matt Daniel presented the Financial Report for the month of October 2025 to the Commission. Chief Daniel stated the department has expended 80.9% of the budget, and is on track for the remainder of FY 2025.

On the motion of Mayor Sams, second Commissioner Jackson, the Commissioners approved the Financial Report for the Fire Department. A copy of the report is a part of these minutes. The vote was unanimous in favor.

ALCOHOL VIOLATION HEARING

The Public Safety Commission held an alcohol violation hearing to discuss the 1st offense violation of:

After all evidence was presented by the City Attorney and the Owner of Big Time Billiards, the Public Safety Commission recommended to the Mayor and Council that the standard penalty of \$1,000.00 for a first (1st) offense along with court reporter costs be imposed upon a guilty conviction. 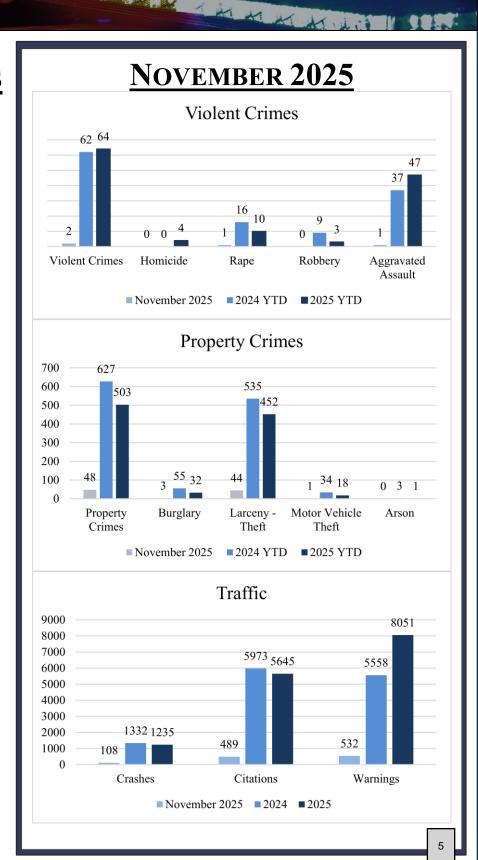

There were 50 Part 1 crimes in November 2025. That is an increase of approximately 13.6% compared to 44 in November 2024. Total Part 1 crimes YTD have decreased by approximately 17.7% when compared to 2024. Total Part 1 crimes for 2025 are approximately 30.3% lower than the 5-year average.

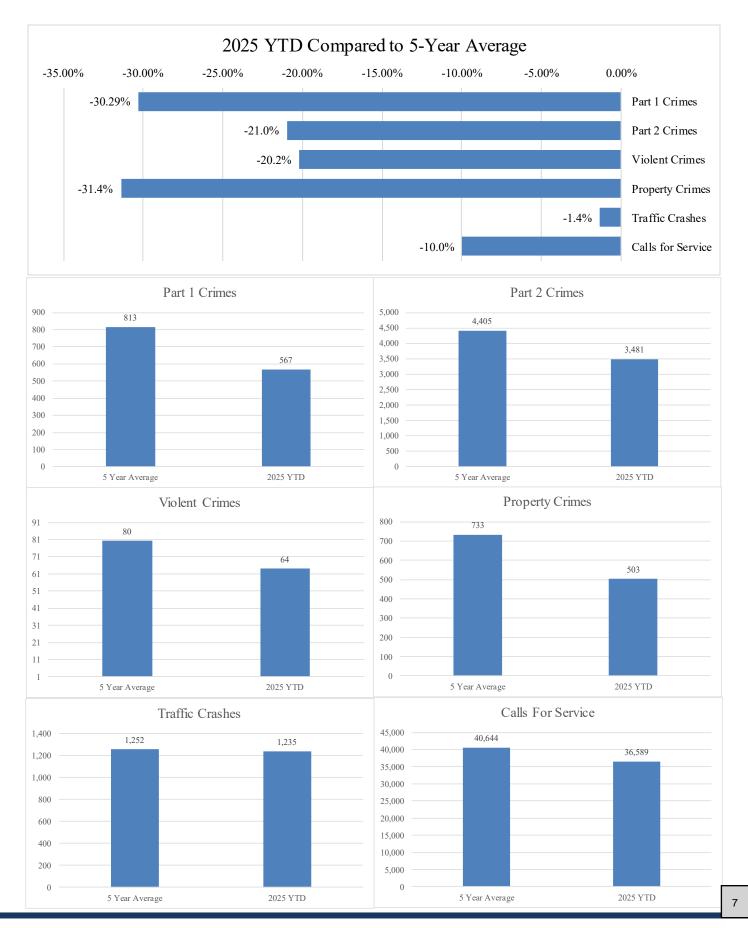
Violent crimes have increased by approximately 3.3% when compared to 2024. There have been 64 violent crimes YTD 2025 compared to 62 violent crimes in 2024. Homicides and aggravated assaults have increased since last year. The 5-year average for violent crimes is 80.2 crimes. Current violent crime number are higher than 2024, but are approximately 20.2% lower than the 5-year average.

Property crimes have decreased by 19.8% when compared to 2024. All categories of property crimes have shown a decrease YTD compared to 2024. Current property crime numbers are approximately 31.4% lower than the 5-year average.

Traffic crashes decreased by approximately 20% when compared to October 2025. Year to date crashes have decreased by approximately 7.3%. Angle collisions were the most frequent crash types. Following too closely was the most frequent contributing factor. Chattanooga Rd had the highest number of crashes and injuries during November.

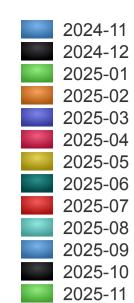

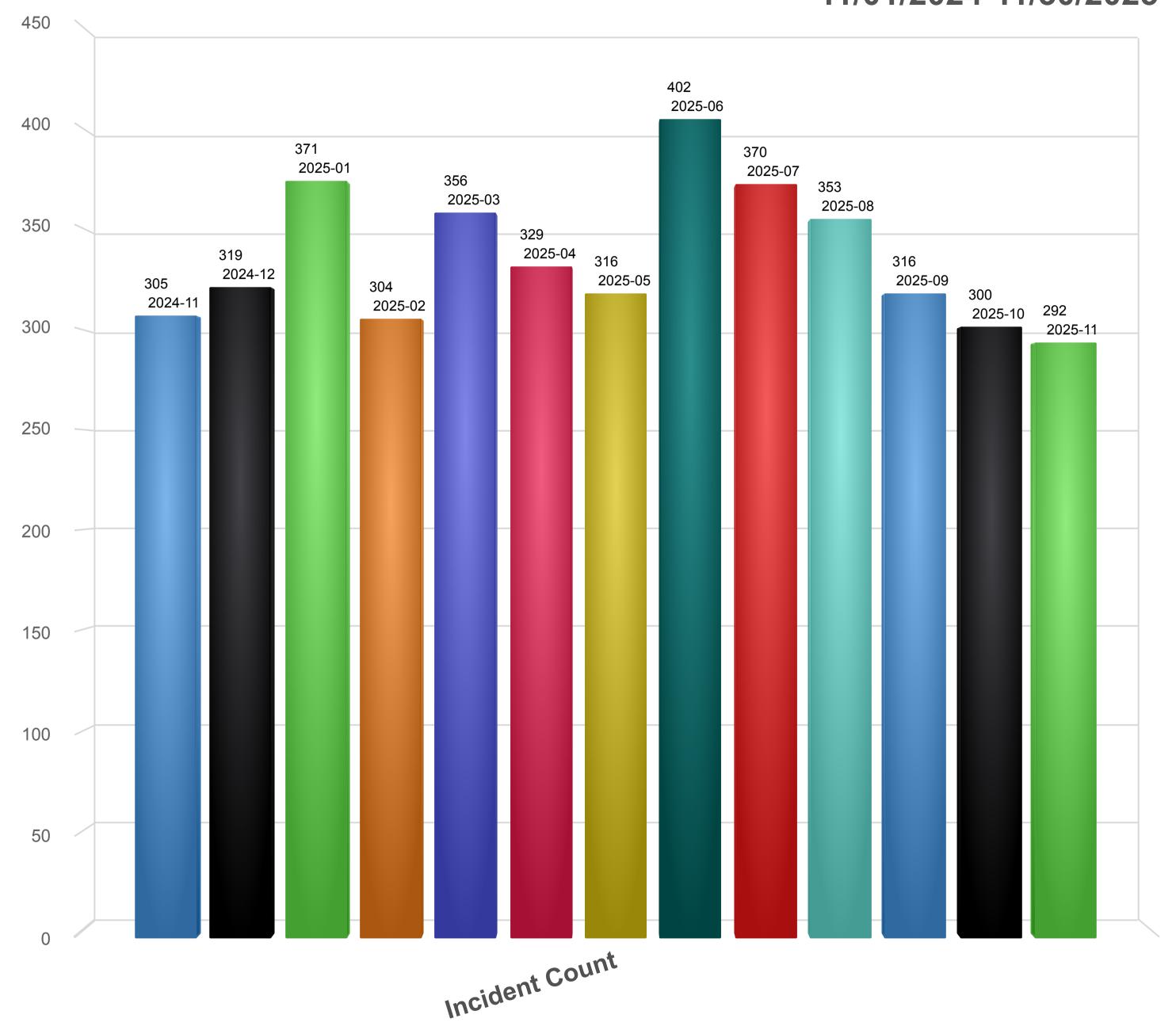

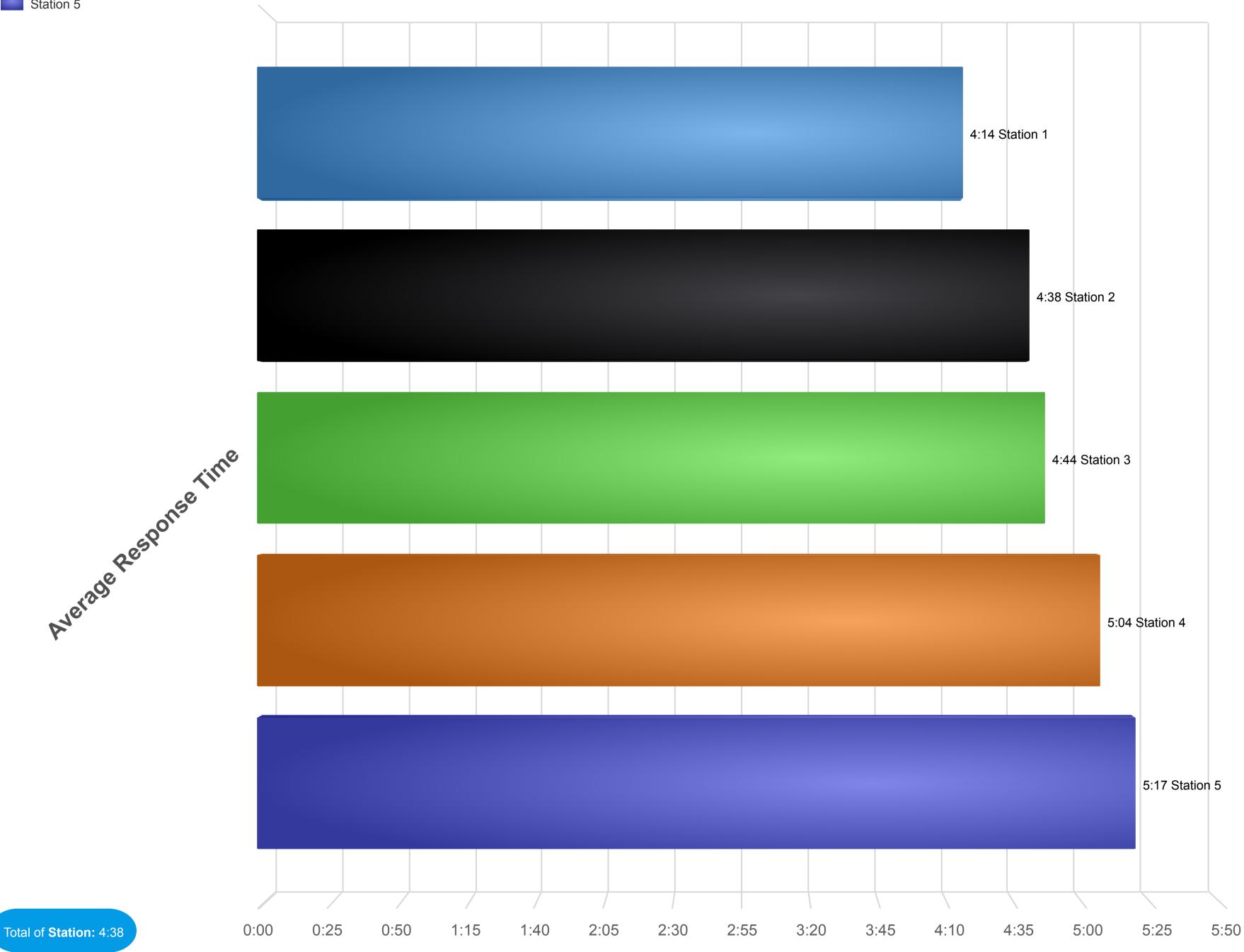
Incidents by Months 11/01/2024-11/30/2025

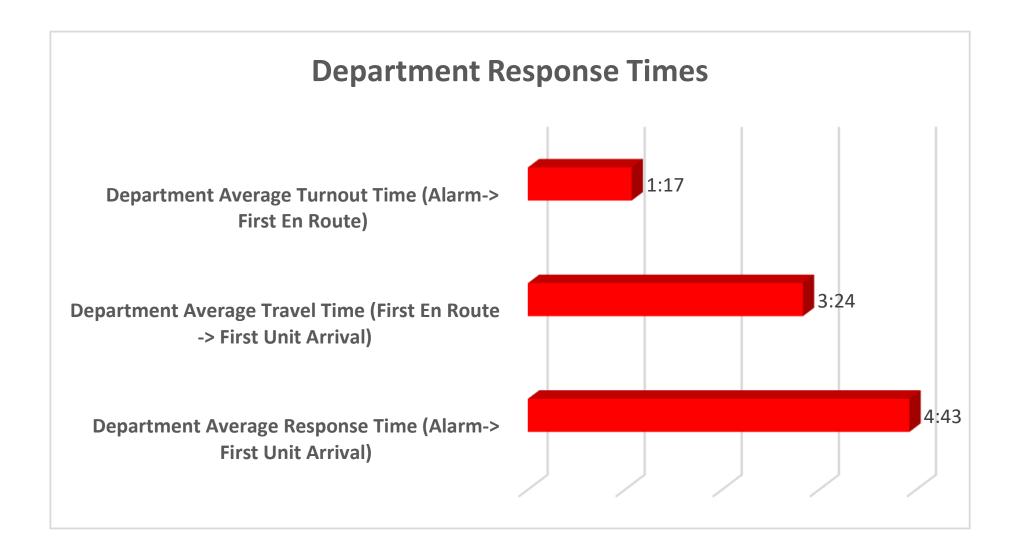




Average Response Time by Station

Training Division Monthly Report November 2025

Overview

Departmental training during the month of November included the following: Eleven personnel attended a Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) course hosted by the North Georgia Health District. A facility walk-through, policy review, and razor-wire training was conducted at the Youth Detention Center on Underwood Road. Driver/Operator training on water supply and master streams was held at Lakeshore Park. Additionally, Department Special Operations and Georgia Search and Rescue personnel attended quarterly training in Catoosa County, with trench rescue as the primary training topic.

Company-level training throughout the month focused on area familiarization, community risk reduction, incident scene operations, driver/operator skills, forcible entry, and technical rescue support. Additional topics were selected by company officers to address specific crew needs and to reinforce operational readiness across the department.

A total of 1,640 training hours were completed during the month.

The Georgia Department of Health Office of Emergency Medical Services conducted an EMS Initial Education Program re-designation visit and program review of the City of Dalton Fire EMS Training Program. The review went well, and our program successfully achieved re-designation.

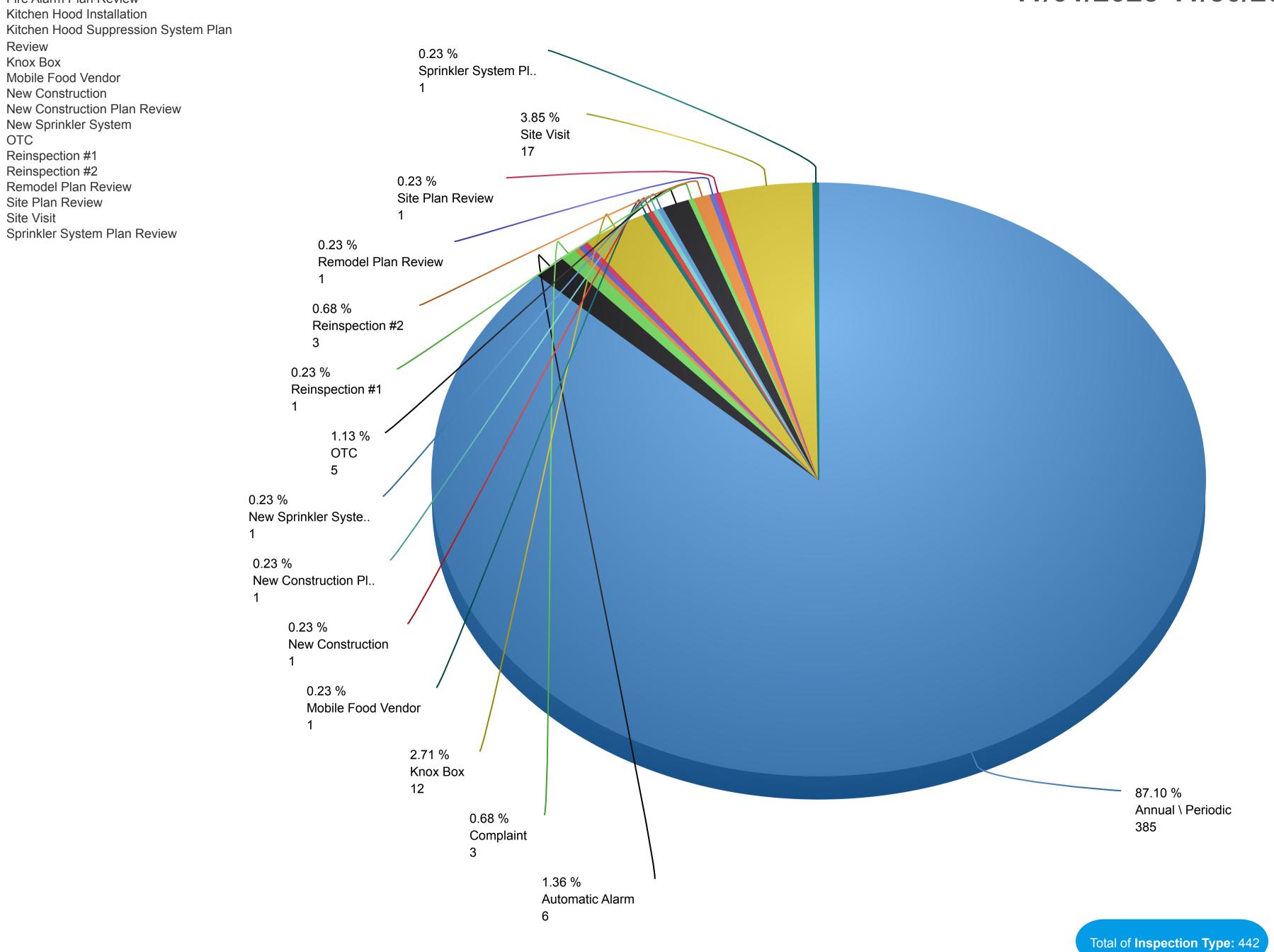
