Crime and Crash Statistics for January 2019

Assistant Chief Chris Crossen presented the Crime and Crash Statistical Reports for the month of January, 2019. Assistant Chief Crossen gave a written and oral summary of the crime and crash statistics. As noted in the written summary, Assistant Chief Crossen reported the rate of Year to Date Part I crimes are down by 7.34% when compared to the same month in 2018. Assistant Chief Crossen further reported crashes and injuries decreased from December 2018.

In February 2019 there were approximately 46.67% less burglaries reported than in 2018. Year to date Part 1 crimes are down 27.31% from 2018.

Analysis

In the year to date 2019 there have been 173 Part 1 crimes reported versus 238 in 2018 which shows an approximate decrease of 27.31%. There have been 2 more reported rapes in 2019 than in 2018. Rape is the only Part 1 crime to show a YTD increase in 2019.

There have been 8 violent crimes reported 2019 YTD compared to 13 reported violent crimes YTD 2018. That is a decrease of approximately 38.26% when compared to 2018. Year to date property crimes have shown a decrease of approximately 26.67% when compared to 2018 YTD statistics.

Based on the statistics from the previous 5 years, property crime numbers are in the normal range and show no significant deviation. Violent crime numbers are lower than the normal range for year-to-date statistics in February based on the past five years.

Summary of Significant Events for February 2019

During the month of February 2019 there no identified crime series in the city. There were two incidents where suspects were identified and arrested after it was discovered they were involved in multiple entering autos. There were five reports of stolen vehicles during the month. There were eight burglaries reported during this time frame. There were three reported aggravated assaults.

19-001391 Agency Assist 1910 Mack St

Detective Simpson was contacted by a Detective from Cherokee County. The reason for the contact was that he had warrants on a subject who was located at this address. The warrants were for attempting to solicit children for sex. The detective also stated that he was currently chatting with the suspect and that the suspect thought he was chatting with a 12 year old girl. The suspect had agreed to pay for the female's cab ride to the house if she came over. Detective Simpson developed an operation's plan and with the help of Detectives Murray and Ensley planned to show up appearing to be a taxi. Once the suspect was identified then he would be taken into custody. When detectives identified themselves the suspect attempted to flee. He resisted arrest and was finally taken into custody.

19-000798 Burglary 2220 Chattanooga Rd, 120 The complainant reported that someone had entered her room through the air-conditioner slot. Missing were

several different electronic devices. She named a suspect. The suspect allowed officers to search his room but nothing stolen was located. The office advised that they did not have access to the camera system.

19-000807 Aggravated Assault 310 Northgate Dr; Burger King

A road rage incident happened and that incident then resulted in a physical altercation at the business. The caller then stated that the male subject that was involved pulled a gun on him. The subject then followed the male with the gun as he left in a vehicle. The incident was investigated and the suspect denied having a weapon. The complainant later decided he did not want to pursue charges.

19-000825 Auto Theft 319 N Hamilton St

The complainant stated that his 2012 Ford F-150 was stolen while parked at Conductors. He stated that he was behind on payments but had worked out a plan with the loan company. The vehicle was entered into GCIC. The case is currently under investigation.

A welfare check was requested by a girlfriend who advised her boyfriend had called her and advised her he took some medication in an attempt to harm himself. Upon arrival the boyfriend was observed through the window laying unresponsive in the bed. Several attempts were made to awake him by banging on the door. Entry was made and it took a sternum rub to wake the male. EMS arrived and he was ordered by the doctor to be transported to Hamilton Medical Center.

19-001103 Entering Auto

The complainant reported her unlocked vehicle was entered overnight. The complainant advised that two wallets and other items were taken during the incident.

19-001109 Entering Auto

1318 Crescent St

430 Cedar St

The complainant advised her unlocked vehicle was entered overnight. Items taken were two wallets, Social Security card, and one credit card. There are no suspects or witnesses.

19-001132 Theft 1011 N Hamilton St

The complainant called to report her shotgun stolen, but had no serial number or make for the gun. While making the report she named a relative as the suspect. While on scene she made contact with the suspect via Facebook messenger. Once he realized the police were on scene he hung up. The complainant then received a call from her mother stating the suspect had made comments to kill the complainant and anyone else that tried to stop him.

19-001142 Burglary

2008 Sheffield Pl

The complainant reported a burglary at 2008 Sheffield Pl. It occurred between the hours of 1430 and 2100 hours. Entry was made through a rear sliding glass door; however, the complainant was unable to determine if anything was stolen from the home. Multiple items of financial value were left untouched.

19-001144 Entering Auto

304 Pinehill Dr

Officers responded to the area of Pinehill Dr in reference to an entering auto in progress. Several units arrived in the area within a couple of minutes and were able to coordinate a search for the suspect. The suspect was located running behind houses and taken into custody. DFCS responded to the Dalton Police Services Center and a safety plan was set in place. The children were removed from both parents' care.

Officer Kapur tried to follow him but the door was locked. Officer Kapur forced entry, but we could not located the subject. We assumed he fled out the back and entered another apartment. Later in the evening a vehicle from that address was located on the roadway by Officer Selby. A traffic stop was conducted and the suspect was located inside. He was arrested along with a female.

19-001317 Dead Body 1302 Underwood St

Officers responded to the Underwood Lodge in reference to a person not breathing. On arrival Officers made contact with a male subject who was deceased. During the investigation it was determined that a female was with him. She had sent a message to family that he was not breathing around noon. She had left in the victim's car. The female had left three hours prior to calling the family to let them know of his condition. Det. Edwards was notified in reference to this and came to the scene. The car was recovered in Walker County occupied by three people, none of which were the suspect. Det. Simpson was then contacted to go to Walker County and meet with the Sheriff Department and the three occupants of the vehicle. Further investigation was turned over to CID.

19-001328 Dead Body 1803 Ryman Ridge Rd



February 2019 Crash Statistics

In February 2019 there were 115 non-private property crashes reported. Injury crashes and injuries increased from January 2019. There were no serious injuries reported in February 2019. Rear end and angle crashes were the most prevalent during February 2019. Following too close was the leading contributing factor in non-injury crashes. Failure to yield was the leading contributing factor for injury crashes. Walnut Ave and Chattanooga Rd were the roadways where the majority of the crashes occurred. In February 2019 approximately 13% of all crashes in the city occurred on Walnut Ave. In February 2019, Chattanooga Rd and Walnut Ave were the roadways with the most injury crashes.

SUMMARY OF THE FINANCIAL STATISTICS FOR FEBRUARY 2019

The police department budget is on track for FY 2019, and at the time of this report we have expended approximately 13.9% of our 2019 budget. We are currently 2.7% under budget for the year.

At this time, we believe sufficient funds are available within our existing budget to cover our operating cost for the remainder of the year.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRANSFER CERTAIN CITY PROPERTY

This is a recommendation to transfer a vehicle as indicated below. The police department has a surplus vehicle which was recently decommissioned for sale at auction because of the ability to purchase new vehicles with SPLOST funds.

Recommendation #1- City of Dalton IT Department 2010 Ford Escape – VIN 1FMCU0DG0AKC03951

The City of Dalton IT Department has requested a transfer of a surplus vehicle for use by the IT staff. The city IT department provides IT support and services at many of the city departments. They routinely travel to the various department locations to address computer and technology issues. The surplus vehicle would allow them to do this without requiring them to use their personal vehicles.

REQUEST TO TRANSFER STATE DRUG SEIZURE FUNDS TO STATE CAPITAL EXPENDATURE ACCOUNT FOR PURCHASE OF NEW DEPARTMENT WEAPONS

The Dalton Police Department would like to request approval from the Public Safety Commission and the Mayor and Council to spend Drug Forfeiture Funds from our State Drug Seizure Account on the purchase of new Glock 9mm handguns for department issue. The funds are available pending a budget amendment approval from the Mayor and Council.

Training Division Monthly Report February 2019

Overview

The Fire Prevention Division delivered a course on Firehouse records management software that dealt specifically with pre-incident surveys and occupancies are modified within the system. The department's EMT instructors delivered a 6-hour EMT refresher on pediatrics to all licensed EMTs and paramedics. Monthly training included territory familiarization, pre-fire training, core competency check-offs, special operations training, and company level drills chosen by company officers. Training hours during the month of February totaled 2,616.

Outside Schools

The department hosted Day 2 of the 16-hour course entitled Modular Emergency Response Radiological Transport Training (MERRTT) delivered by GEMA and the U.S. Department of Energy.

Lieutenant Dustin Martinez from Cobb County Fire & Emergency Services delivered a 4-hour course on advanced search and rescue techniques to all suppression personnel.

Two DFD personnel attended Emergency Resource Deployment Planning – Standards of Cover at the National Fire Academy in Emmitsburg, Maryland. This course teaches students how to analyze demographic, response, and GIS data to assist in writing a Standard of Cover for their department.

Title: Chief on call notification

Scope: Suppression Division

Purpose: To assist the shift commander with procedures for notifying the on call chief of predetermined situations.

PROCEDURE:

The following situations shall prompt the shift commander to notify the chief on call. These situations are not to be considered all inclusive. It shall be the shift commander's discretion to notify the chief on call for any other noteworthy occurrences.

- 1. Any incident requiring deployment of a supply line, whether the line is charged or not.
- 2. Any incident which requires the use of two or more tanks of water from the apparatus.
- 3. Any injury to personnel that requires medical attention beyond care rendered by Dalton Fire Department personnel.
- 4. A fire related civilian injury or fatality.
- 5. Any accident involving Dalton Fire Department property. This would include motor vehicle accidents, or damage to physical property.
- 6. Any arrest or detainment of Dalton Fire Department personnel by law enforcement.
- 7. Any incident that will require enough personnel for an extended period of time to prevent proper response coverage.

All fires meeting the criteria above or noteworthy incidents shall be followed up by a media report at the earliest convenience of the shift commander.

We constantly strive to maintain a high level of service and continue to provide the highest level of safety to our community. We will continue to accomplish this by focusing on the mission and core values of our organization. Our agency will continue to prepare for, not only day-to-day challenges, but the ones on the horizon that we will be faced with in the future.

Department Overview

The City of Dalton Fire Department is an ISO Class 2 emergency service provider consisting of 96 full-time employees. 87 personnel are assigned to the suppression division as firefighters. Additional personnel are assigned to the training division, fire prevention division, and as administrative staff. The department has 39 Emergency Medical Technicians, 4 Paramedics, 53 Emergency Medical Responders, 28 certified Georgia Smoke Divers, and 12 CPR instructors. Training hours accrued during 2018 totaled 27,091.

The department has Special Operations Teams trained in technical rescue and hazardous materials response. These teams are adept at mitigating incidents such as trench rescue, structural collapse, vehicle and machinery entrapment, surface water rescue, high and low angle rope operations, confined space rescue and hazardous materials releases.

Emergency response capabilities are achieved through the use of seven pumping apparatus, one 100-foot tower ladder, one 75-foot straight ladder, one heavy rescue apparatus, one incident command vehicle, and one mobile air & light unit, all of which are fully equipped to comply with NFPA and ISO requirements. Thermal imaging cameras, which allow for enhanced visibility in hostile environments, are carried in all 5 districts so that all the city's inhabitants may benefit from this technology.

The department has 5 stations located to provide rapid response to any part of the city's 22 square miles. Station 2, located on Abutment Road, also serves as a training facility with a water drafting pit, four story drill tower, and a three story, 1,664 sq. ft. burn building designed for the burning of Class A materials in all areas of the structure. This facility is utilized to train new recruits and maintain proficiency among incumbent personnel. All fire stations are equipped with stand-by generators to provide electrical power in the event of an outage. Stations are also equipped with a communications duplication system to ensure that the vital link between fire dispatchers and units operating in the field remains intact should the 911 center be disabled.

The City of Dalton has a total of 1,252 municipal fire hydrants. These hydrants are inspected a minimum of twice annually by suppression personnel. The department works closely with Dalton Utilities in an effort to ensure that hydrants will function properly if needed. In addition, there are over 500 private hydrants located in various parts of our jurisdiction serving a variety of private properties.

The fire prevention division works closely with the building inspector's office and Dalton Utilities in an effort to reduce the loss of life and property by requiring that all construction meets current fire codes.

Location: 1242 North Glenwood Avenue

On Friday, June 1, 2018 at 1:23 am, Dalton Fire Department units were dispatched to a person in the water in the area of 1242 North Glenwood Avenue. Upon arrival, crews heard a man yelling for help but could not locate him due to darkness, weather conditions, and dense foliage. Personnel soon discovered a male patient clinging to a branch in Mill Creek who had been swept away by flash flooding generated by heavy rain in the area. Companies promptly began a coordinated rescue effort that included clearing a path to the patient, establishing a secondary rescue team as a downstream safety, and a water entry to retrieve the victim. As a result of this coordinated effort, the patient was rapidly located and removed from the water and transferred to Hamilton EMS for treatment and transport. These actions reflect great credit upon the individuals involved, their assigned companies, and the City of Dalton Fire Department.

Accomplishments

- 1. Reviewed and revised all standard operating guidelines for the department
- 2. Completed a three year strategic plan 2019-2021
- 3. Filled all applicable ranks through promotions
- 4. Placed in service four new staff vehicles and a station pick-up
- 5. Reviewed and updated all job descriptions within the department
- 6. Began reviewing our practices for certain services such as janitorial supplies
 - a. Conducted bid for janitorial supplies to ensure best competitive pricing
 - b. Purchased bed linens for each employee in order to cut down on cost for cleaning/delivery of rented linens
- 7. Began the process of reviewing and changing our rank system to eliminate rank compression within the department
 - a. Will be deleting two ranks and adjusting pay rates into the remaining ranks
 - b. Instituted acting pay when lower ranked personnel fill driver or officer positions to fill the gaps left by the absence of two ranks
 - c. Promoted the staff assistant position to administrative assistant and deleted the staff assistant position, thus providing more efficiency in administrative tasks such as entering and tracking purchase orders
- 8. Completed hazmat physicals for all hazardous materials technicians
- 9. Worked with Verizon to lower the cost of wireless services provided
- 10. Installed a turnout gear extractor at station two in order to comply with cancer prevention initiative for firefighters
- 11. Completed electrical work at the training center to eliminate hazards that existed due to the way power was being supplied

- 12. Hosted 2018 Georgia Police and Fire Games with assistance from DPD and DPRD
- 13. Hosted 2018 Georgia Fire Service Joint Conference
- 14. Hosted Georgia Smoke Diver Class 55 in the spring and Class 56 in the fall
- 15. Participated in 1st annual Citizens Government Academy
- 16. Restructured the fire inspection process to include inspections on all structures that apply for Occupational Tax Certificates for a more all-inclusive approach for the businesses in our community
- 17. Completed occupancy review of all properties in district 5
- 18. Updated loft/urban dwelling ordinance
- 19. Purchased and implemented mobile inspections for the fire prevention division, thus making our inspection process more efficient as reports are a completed while on-site the day of the inspection
- 20. Purchased Target Solutions CheckIt, a cloud-based fleet maintenance records management platform that also aids in tracking equipment on apparatus through paperless daily checklists
- 21. Completed an audit conducted by Georgia Firefighter Standards and Training Council
- 22. Continued Class 5 program teaching 5th grade students about home fire safety through classes delivered monthly during the school year (approx. 600 participating this year)
- 23. Partnered with Dalton Utilities to include fire safety material with utility bills
- 24. Began discussions with DPD concerning forming a joint tactical team for active shooter incidents
- 25. Partnered with American Red Cross to install smoke detectors in predetermined areas (installed a total of 84 detectors)
- 26. Raised almost \$5,000 during boot drive for MDA

• The City of Dalton Fire Department responded to a total of 3,867 calls during 2018, an increase from the 3,719 calls answered during 2017.


