RESOLUTION 2025-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEADWOOD FIRE CHIEF TO IMPLEMENT TEMPORARY BURN BANS WHEN CONDITIONS WARRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Deadwood recognizes the importance of protecting life, property, and natural resources from the threat of fire; and

WHEREAS, periods of elevated fire danger, including high temperatures, low humidity, dry vegetation, and strong winds, can significantly increase the risk of wildfires within and around the City of Deadwood; and

WHEREAS, the timely enactment of burn bans is critical in mitigating these risks and preventing uncontrolled fires; and

WHEREAS, the Deadwood Fire Chief, in coordination with other public safety officials and agencies, is best equipped to monitor local fire conditions and make informed decisions regarding public safety and fire risk;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Deadwood City Commission that:

- 1. **Authority Granted**: The Deadwood Fire Chief is hereby authorized to implement temporary burn bans within the jurisdiction of the City of Deadwood when, in their professional judgment, hazardous fire conditions exist or are likely to develop.
- 2. **Scope of Ban**: The burn ban may restrict or prohibit open burning, recreational fires, campfires, burning of refuse, use of fireworks, use of solid fuel food preparation devices or other fire-related activities, as deemed appropriate by the Fire Chief based on current conditions.
- 3. **Notice and Communication**: Upon enactment of a burn ban, the Fire Chief shall ensure that the public is notified through appropriate channels, including the city website, signage, social media, press releases, and coordination with local emergency services.
- 4. **Duration**: The burn ban shall remain in effect until such time as the Fire Chief determines that hazardous conditions have subsided and it is safe to lift the restrictions.
- 5. **Enforcement**: Violations of the burn ban may be subject to penalties or enforcement action as permitted by City ordinance or state law.

Re: 2025 Independent Contractor, GIS Mapping Project

The Deadwood Historic Preservation Office is requesting permission to enter into a contract with Charles "Mike" Madler of Spearfish, South Dakota for professional services as related to the 150th Anniversary of Deadwood and Trails leading to and from Deadwood, South Dakota.

Under this agreement, Mr. Madler shall create and provide deliverables to include all drawings, reports, sketches, charts, and spreadsheets in electronic file format, including but not limited to map documents, project folders and filing structures, layers, shapefiles, geodatabases and associated metadata as related to historic routes connecting Deadwood. Funding for this project would come from the 2025 HPC Public Education budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

Allow the Historic Preservation Office to enter a contract with Charles "Micke" Madler of Spearfish, South Dakota for professional services as related to the City's GIS and trails research. This contract will not exceed \$3,000.00 and will come from the 2025 HPC Public Education budget.

CONTRACT BETWEEN CITY OF DEADWOOD AND MICHAEL MADLER, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

This Agreement is between the CITY OF DEADWOOD, a municipal corporation with its principal place of business located at 108 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota 57732, on behalf of its Archives department (hereinafter referred to as "CITY") and Charles M. Madler of 23 Tom Ral Drive, Spearfish, South Dakota 57783 (hereinafter referred to as "MADLER").

The purpose of this Contract is to set forth the terms and conditions of the agreement between CITY and MADLER for services related to the creation of GIS map, focusing on subjects related to the history of Deadwood, Lawrence County, South Dakota.

The parties desire to enter into an agreement whereby MADLER agrees to create and provide GIS maps and associated data layers; and

MADLER has the experience and expertise to produce the GIS map and layers.

Based upon the representations and understanding of each party, CITY and MADLER agree as follows:

- 1. The Recitals set forth above are herein incorporated and made part of this Agreement.
- 2. The parties agree it is MADLER'S responsibility to comply with all local and state laws relating to workmen's compensation, register, report, and pay all necessary taxes and insurance including, but not limited to Social Security, FICA, Unemployment Insurance, and comply with the Equal Employment Opportunities Act.
- 3. MADLER shall provide his own office space, equipment and materials to meet the requirements of this agreement.

- 4. MADLER shall create and provide CITY with GIS deliverables to include all drawings, reports, sketches, charts, and spreadsheets in electronic file format, including but not limited to map documents, project folders and filing structures, layers, shapefiles, geodatabases and associated metadata by May 29, 2026.
- 5. Upon completion of GIS deliverables to include all drawings, reports, sketches, charts, and spreadsheets in electronic file format, including but not limited to map documents, project folders and filing structures, layers, shapefiles, geodatabases and associated metadata, MADLER shall provide CITY voucher for completed work.
- 6. CITY shall pay MADLER the sum of Three-Thousand 00/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00), for work completed and this amount cannot be exceeded unless change orders are agreed upon in writing by both parties.
- 7. MADLER shall remain solely responsible for the content and accuracy of GIS deliverables.
- 8. It will be the CITY's responsibility to select the content and provide subjects and content for said project.
- 9. MADLER may not subcontract any portion of this contract or any portion of the work.
- 10. No further changes or additional work will be approved by the CITY, unless approved in writing by both parties.
- 11. Copyright for the GIS deliverables belong to CITY. Copyright for drawings, reports, sketches, charts, and spreadsheets in electronic file format, including but not limited to map documents, project folders and filing structures, layers, geodatabases and associated metadata shall also belong to CITY. MADLER to retain permission to use portions of said data for additional not for profit projects.
- 12. Either party may terminate this agreement upon providing the other party with thirty (30) days' notice in writing and served upon the other party via certified mail; however within one (1) week of such notice, DARR shall provide to CITY all original documents produced at that time.
- 13. MADLER is an independent contractor, and this contract shall not be construed as creating any type of relationship including but not limited to, principal and agent or employer and employee between CITY Page 2 of 4

and MADLER. MADLER does not have the authority to hire any person on behalf of CITY.

- 14. MADLER shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless CITY, its employees and authorized representatives from and against any and all suits, claims, actions, legal and administrative proceedings, demands, damages, liabilities, costs and expense including attorney's fees arising out of or in connection with any conduct or work of MADLER as set forth in this agreement.
- 15. This agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be interpreted, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of South Dakota.
- 16. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties on its subject. There are no other terms, conditions or understandings of any kind expressed or implied.



In accordance with South Dakota law, each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, or a cashier's check or money order in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid.

Sealed bids must be submitted upon the printed bid form and sealed with the items being bid clearly indicated on the outside for each project.

The City of Deadwood reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and/or waive any irregularities therein.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received at the Finance Office of City Hall, 108 Sherman Street, Deadwood South Dakota 57732 until 2:00 p.m. local time on the 14th day of August 2025.

Copies of the proposed contract and bidding documents are available at the City of Deadwood Finance Office, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, and are available upon request.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid, or a cashier's check or money order in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid.

Sealed Bids. Each bid shall be legibly written or printed in ink on the form provided. No alterations in bids or in the printed forms by erasures, interpolations, or otherwise will be acceptable unless each such alteration is signed or initialed by the bidder. No alteration in any bid, or in the form in which it is submitted, shall be made after the bid as been submitted. All addenda to the contract documents, properly signed by the bidder, shall accompany the bid when submitted. Each bid shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope or wrapping, addressed to the City of Deadwood, South Dakota, identified on the outside with the words "Bid for Streets Department Metal Roof Replacement" and filed at the Finance Office. No Bidder may submit more than one bid. Multiple bids under different names will not be accepted from one firm or association.

If a Bidder uses a substitute Bid Form, the formatting and required information must be the same as the form provided. The City of Deadwood may reject any bid that does not conform to these instructions and the Specifications.

Each bidder shall sign the Bid Form using their usual signature and giving their full business address. Bids by partnerships shall be signed with the partnership name followed by the signature and designation of one of the partners or other authorized representatives. Bids by corporations shall bear the corporate seal and shall be signed with the name of the corporation followed by the signature and designation of the president, secretary, or other person authorized to bind the corporation. Bids by joint ventures shall be signed by each participant in the joint venture or by an authorized agent of each participant and each shall indicate whether the participant is doing business as an individual, partnership or corporation. The names of all persons signing shall also be typed or printed below the signature. A bid by a person who affixes to their signature the word "president", "secretary", "agent", or other designation without disclosing their principal may be held to be the bid of the individual signing. When requested by the City of Deadwood, evidence of the authority signing shall be furnished.

<u>Withdrawal of Bid.</u> No bidder may withdraw their bid for thirty (30) days after the date and hour set for the opening. A bidder may withdraw their bid any time prior to expiration of the period during which bids may be submitted by a written request signed in the same manner and by the same person who signed the Bid Form.

Acceptance and Rejection of Bids. The City of Deadwood reserves the right to accept the bid which, in its judgement, is the lowest and best bid, to reject any or all bids, and to waive irregularities in any bid. Bids received after the specified time of closing will be returned unopened.

Qualifications of a Responsible and Responsive Bidder. The City of Deadwood may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder and all subcontractors to perform the work. The bidder shall furnish the City of Deadwood all such information and data for this purpose as the City of Deadwood may request. The City of Deadwood reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such bidder fails to satisfy the City of Deadwood that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work.

<u>Submittal of References.</u> The roofing system shall be applied only by a licensed roofing company. The Contractor shall provide a submittal of three (3) professional references showing prior experience in completing similar work along with the bid. Bids will not be accepted without review and approval of references.

Interpretation of Contract Documents. If any person who contemplates submitting a bid is in doubts to the true meaning of any part of the specification, or other proposed contract documents, they may submit to the Public Works Department a written request for an interpretation thereof. The person submitting the request shall be responsible for its prompt delivery. Interpretation of the proposed contract documents will be made only by addendum, and a copy of each addendum will be provided to others who obtain the bid documents. The City of Deadwood will not be responsible for any other explanations or interpretations of the proposed contract documents.

Local Conditions Affecting Work. Each bidder shall visit the site of the work and shall completely inform themselves relative to hazards and procedure, labor, and all other conditions and factors, local and otherwise, which would affect performance and completion of the work and its cost. All such factors shall be properly investigated and considered in the preparation of the bid. There will be no subsequent financial adjustment for lack of such prior information.

<u>Performance Bond and Payment Bond.</u> A performance bond and payment bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the contract will be required and must be made

out to the City of Deadwood. Such bonds must be valid until the project is complete and accepted by the City of Deadwood.

Warranty Process.

Contractor shall provide a Manufacture's 30-year warranty on paint finish of metal roof, and a 10-year installation warranty.

<u>Preliminary Site Inspection.</u> The Public Works Director will be available to accompany any prospective bidder to the work site to point out the proposed areas of construction and to answer questions which the prospective bidder may have concerning the project.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

<u>Materials and Equipment.</u> The Contractor shall provide all materials and equipment unless otherwise specified in these documents.

<u>Contractor's License.</u> All contractors and subcontractors must obtain a city contractor's license from the City of Deadwood prior to beginning work. This license can be obtained at the South Wing of City Hall located at 108 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota.

Insurance. The Contractor shall secure and maintain throughout the duration of this contract insurance of such types in such amounts as may be necessary to protect themselves and the interests of the City of Deadwood against all hazards or risks of loss as hereinafter specified. The form and limits of such insurance, together with the underwriter thereof in each case, shall be acceptable to the City of Deadwood. Regardless of such acceptance, it shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to maintain adequate insurance coverage at all times. Failure of the Contractor to maintain adequate coverage shall not relieve them of any contractual responsibility or obligation. Satisfactory certificates of insurance shall be filed with their submittal of contract documents for execution by the City of Deadwood. The certificates shall state that thirty (30) days written notice will be given to the City of Deadwood before any policy covered thereby is changed or canceled.

Defense of Suits. In case any action in court is brought against the City of Deadwood, or any officer or agent of the City of Deadwood, for the failure, omission, or neglect of the Contractor to perform any of the covenants, acts, matters or things by this contract undertaken; or for injury or damage caused by the Contractor or their agents or their subcontractors or their agents, or in connection with any claim based on lawful demands of subcontractors, workmen, material men, or suppliers; the Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Deadwoood and its officer and agents from all losses, damages, costs, expenses, judgments, or decrees arising out of such action.

Worker's Compensation and Employer Liability. This insurance shall protect the Contractor against all claims under applicable state worker's compensation laws. The Contractor shall also be protected against claims for injury, disease, or death of employees which, for any reason, may not fall within the provisions of a worker's compensation law, including claims insured by usual personal injury liability coverage. This policy shall include an "all state" endorsement. The liability limits shall not be less than:

Employer's Liability \$1,000,000 each person

<u>Comprehensive Automobile Liability.</u> This insurance shall be written in comprehensive form and shall protect the Contractor against all claims for injuries to members of the public and damage to property of others arising from the use of motor vehicles and shall cover operation on or off the site of all motor vehicles licensed for highway use whether they are owned, nonowned, or hired. The liability limits shall not be less than:

Bodily Injury \$1,000,000 each occurrence

\$2,000,000 aggregate

Property Damage \$1,000,000 each occurrence \$2,000,000 aggregate

Comprehensive General Liability. This insurance shall be written in comprehensive form and shall protect the Contractor against all claims arising from injuries to persons other than his employees or damage to property of the owner or others arising out of any act or omission of the Contractor or his agents, employees, or subcontractors. Compliance Provision. Contractor will comply with all federal, state, and local laws, regulations, ordinances, guidelines, permits, and requirements applicable to providing services pursuant to this Contract, and will be solely responsible for obtaining current information on such requirements.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

SC-1 TEMPORARY BUILDINGS

The Contractor shall, at his expense, furnish all temporary buildings during the construction period.

- (a) Temporary Toilet:
- 1. The Contractor may provide and maintain a sanitary, commercially manufactured, self-contained, temporary toilet, which shall comply with the South Dakota DENR. The location of the temporary toilet shall be approved by the Owner.
- 2. The temporary toilets shall be enclosed and weatherproofed and kept in a sanitary condition at all times.
- (b) Storage Buildings: The Contractor may construct or bring on the site, such trailers or storage buildings as necessary to protect materials, tools or equipment for use on the project. Such buildings shall meet with the approval of the Owner and shall be removed from the site upon completion of the work of the respective contractors.







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

ORDINANCE #1426

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO MONTANA-DAKOTA UTILITIES CO., A DELAWARE CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE FRANCHISE AND RIGHT TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE WITHIN AND UPON, IN AND UNDER THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS OF THE

A GAS TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM FOR TRANSMITTING AND DISTRIBUTING NATURAL OR MANUFACTURED GAS, OR A MIXTURE OF BOTH, FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE USE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY

SECTION 1. For convenience, herein, said municipal corporation is designated and referred to as "Municipality" and Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. is designated and referred to as "Grantee." Any reference to either includes their respective successors and assigns.

SECTION II. There is hereby granted to Montana-Dakota Utilities Co, a Delaware corporation, its successors and assigns, subject to the limitations herein stated, the right and franchise to occupy and use the streets, alleys and public grounds of the municipality as now, or hereafter constituted, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating, within, upon, in and under the same, a gas distribution system for transmitting and distributing natural or manufactured gas, or a mixture of both, for public and private use.

SECTION III. Grantee shall maintain an efficient distribution system for furnishing natural or manufactured gas, or a mixture of both for public and private use at such reasonable rates as may be approved by the Public Utilities Commission of the State of South Dakota and under such orders, rules or regulations as may be issued by a federal or state agency having jurisdiction thereof.

SECTION IV. This franchise shall not be exclusive and shall not be construed to prevent the Municipality from granting to any other party the right to use the streets, alleys, and public grounds of the Municipality for like purposes.

SECTION V. The Municipality reserves any right it may have, under its police power, or otherwise, to control or regulate the use of said streets, alleys, and public grounds by Grantee. This section shall not affect the right of Grantee to receive compensation for the expense of changing, removing or relocating its facilities located in private right of way. Further, if at any time said Municipality shall vacate any street, alley or public grounds in which Grantee's facilities are located, an alternate route or private property easement shall be provided to Grantee. Grantee shall not be required to relocate facilities when any street, alley or public grounds in which they are located is vacated for the convenience of abutting property owners or another private party and not as an incident to the public improvement, unless the reasonable cost of such relocation and the loss and expenses resulting therefrom is first paid to Grantee.

SECTION VI. Grantee shall indemnify and save and hold the Municipality harmless from any loss or damage due to the construction, installation, and maintenance of its distribution system, and its use of the streets, alleys, and public grounds of the Municipality; however, Grantee shall not be required to indemnify and save or hold the Municipality harmless from loss or damage to the extent such loss or damage is caused by the acts, omissions, or negligence of the Municipality, its employees, assigns, agents, contractors, or other persons under its direction or control.

SECTION VII. Grantee shall have the right to assign this franchise to any party, or corporation, but all obligations hereunder shall be binding upon its successors and assigns.

SECTION VIII. Within thirty (30) days after Grantee is notified of passage and final approval of this Ordinance, Grantee shall file with the clerk or auditor of the Municipality its written acceptance of this franchise.

SECTION IX. This franchise shall continue and remain in full force and effect for a period of twenty (20) years from the date upon which this ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

CITY OF DEADWOOD **ORDINANCE 1428**

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Deadwood, in the State of South Dakota, as follows:

SECTION 1: AMENDMENT "5.48.020 Definitions" of the Deadwood Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

5.48.020 Definitions

As used in this chapter:

"City license plate" is a three (3) inch by six (6) inch decal or sticker that indicates the year of license as well as a taxicab identification number. Provided by the city of Deadwood.

"Intra-city service" means service provided solely within one (1) city. Example: A fare picked up in Deadwood and dropped off in Deadwood.

"Inter-city service" means service provided from city to city. Example: A fare picked up in Deadwood and dropped off in Lead.

"Taxicab" means a public transportation device used to convey passengers to and from destinations of their choice; such as, but not limited to, vehicles, limousines, rickshaws, and velotaxis (pedi cabs), exluding transportation network company driver devices.

"Taxicab business" means any person, firm, or corporation engaging in the commercial practice of providing public transportation which is not a transportation network company or transportation network company driver to destination(s) of choice of passengers.

"Transportation network company" means a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, or other entity that uses a digital network to connect transportation network company riders to transportation network company drivers who provide prearranged rides and that does not control, direct, or manage the personal vehicles or transportation network company drivers that connect to its digital network, except where agreed to by written contract.

"Transportation network company driver" means a person who receives connections to potential riders and related services from a transportation network company in exchange for payment of a fee to the transportation network company and who uses a personal vehicle to provide a prearranged ride to riders upon connection through a digital network controlled by a transportation network company in return for compensation or payment of a fee.

"Transportation network company rider" means a person who uses a transportation network company's digital network to connect with a transportation network driver who provides a prearranged ride to the person in the driver's personal vehicle between points chosen by the person.

(Ord. 1162 (part), 2011)

SECTION 2: <u>AMENDMENT</u> "5.48.010 License Required" of the Deadwood Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

5.48.010 License Required

- A. No person, firm or corporation shall operate a taxicab business and provide intra-city service within the city of Deadwood, other than a transportation network company, without first having obtained from the city commission a license therefore and without having complied with all provisions of this chapter.
- B. Any person, firm or corporation desiring a license for a taxicab or taxicabs shall make a written application therefore to the city commission upon blank applications to be furnished by the chief of police. Said application shall contain the full name and address of the owner, the make, model and year of manufacture of the vehicle(s), the South Dakota license number and the vehicle identification number of the same.
- C. Transportation network companies are not required to obtain a license from the city commission.
