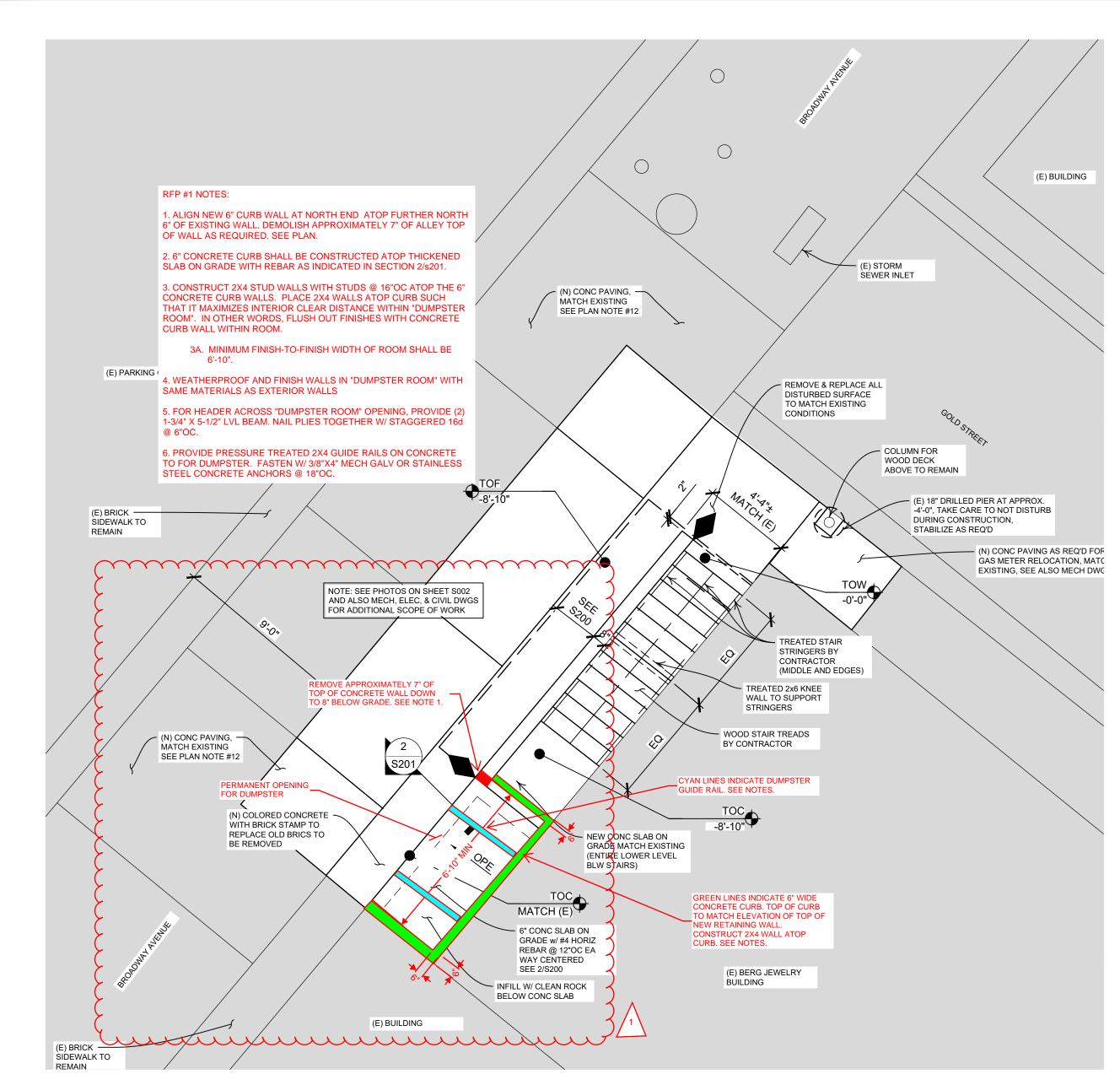

SITE LAYOUT PLAN - FOUNDATION SCALE: 1/4" = 1'-0"

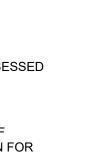

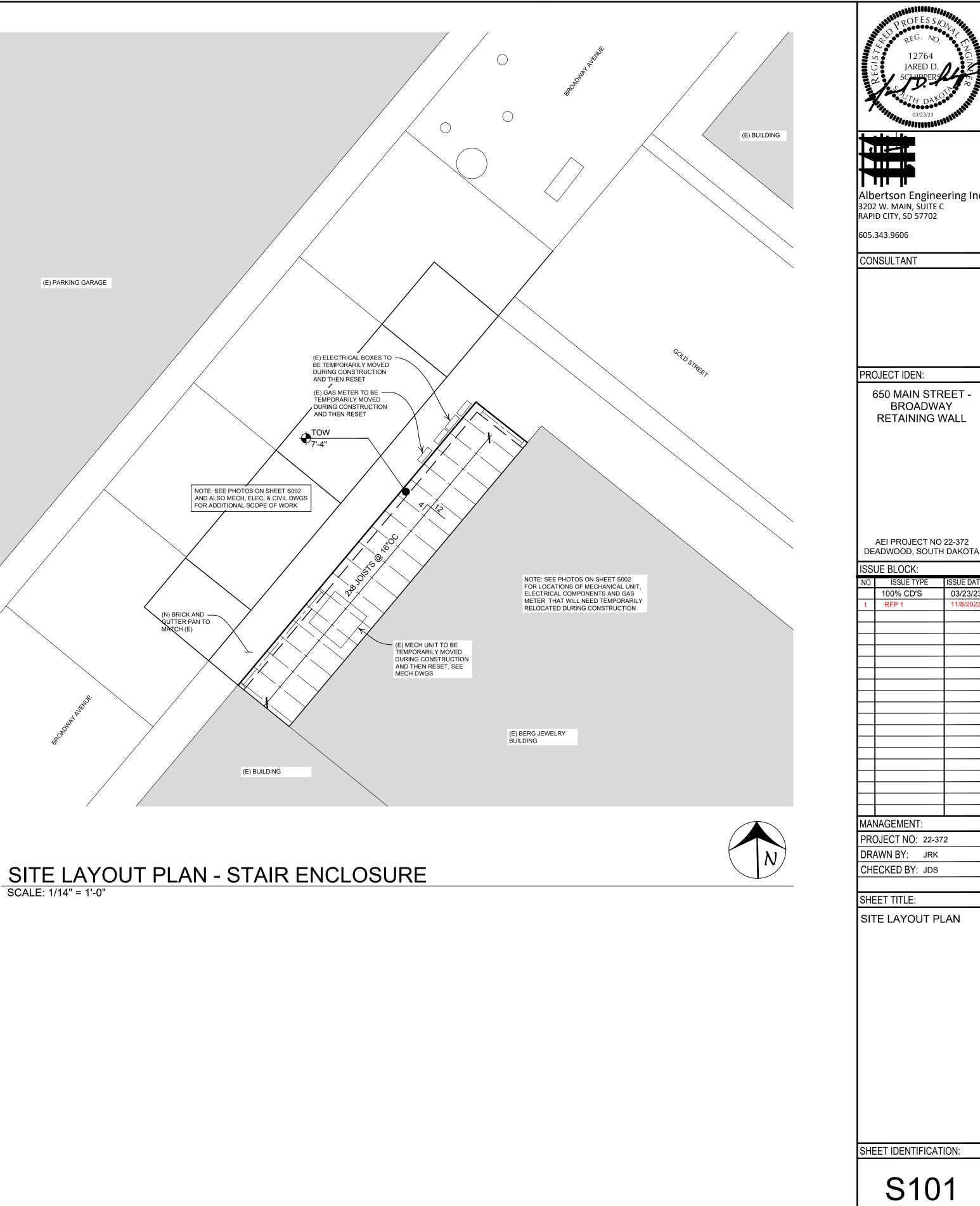
