**CITY OF DEADWOOD
PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE**

May 23, 2024

1. ROLL CALL:

The City of Deadwood Parking and Transportation Committee met Thursday, May 23, 2024, in the Century Room in City Hall. Justin Lux called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Present were Justin Lux, Cory Shafer, Dory Hanson, Trent Mohr, Tom Riley, Lornie Stalder, Jim Lee, John Rystrom, Misty Trehwella and Andy Goodwin. Commissioner Mike Johnson was present.

Absent was Kevin Kuchenbecker.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: May 2, 2024.

Minutes for the meeting on Thursday, May 2, 2024, were approved unanimously by a motion from Mr. Riley and a second by Ms. Trehwella.

3. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS ON AGENDA

- a. **WWC FEMA Update:** They are buttoning up the Sherman Street lot currently; moving on to the site up at the Comfort Inn. Had the neighborhood meeting with the residents. There was no real contention. Complete Concrete is going to start up behind City Hall soon. Mr. Mohr indicated the fire department was brought in because of the limited access to residences across the creek.
- b. **Deadwood Hill Parking Lot Update:** Mr. Lux indicated there wasn't anything new to report at this time.
- c. **2024 Tour Conveyance Schedule:** The schedule was sent to all the companies. It's the same as it has been for the last three years. There have already been a few issues but hopefully that will get ironed out.

4. NOTICE TO CONTEST PARKING TICKETS:

- a. **Isaac Adams: Reimbursement request for tow bill from the Kyle Petty Charity Ride:** Motion to reimburse Isaac Adams for the tow bill in the amount of \$437.54 by Chief Shafer, second by Mr. Mohr; motion carried.
- b. **1155582:** Motion to change the ticket to a warning by Mr. Shafer, second by Mr. Riley; motion carried.

5. NEW BUSINESS:

- a. **Permission to close Gold Street for the 2024 Season from Memorial Day to Native American Day:** This is the 4th or 5th year doing this. Motion to recommend to City Commission the approval to close Gold Street for the season by Mr. Mohr, second by Ms. Trehwella; motion carried.

- b. **Use of the Welcome Center Parking Lot August 1-August 10, 2024:** Motion to strike from Agenda by Mr. Mohr, second by Ms. Trehwella; motion carried.
- c. **Stage Run Sign Request: Children At Play:** There was a request to put a “Children at Play” sign up at the top of Mystery Wagon.
- d. **Alkali Ike Mechanical Issues: Requested lenience until the second week of June:** Rory Maynard is requesting leniency until the end of June. By ordinance any license not active in the cemetery for any given 10-day period in June, July and August will be deemed abandoned. He is experiencing mechanical issues and requests time to fix those problems. Mayor Ruth and Commissioner Joseph indicated they would work with him but it needed to come before the P&T Committee. He is paid up. Motion to approve by Mr. Stalder, second by Mr. Mohr; motion carried.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

- a. **Da Bus and Taxi Parking:** Chief Shafer indicated he requested Fire Chief Alex Hamann be present to answer any questions, if needed. The cabs want to stage Da Bus in the fire lane next to the elementary school. Fire Chief Hamann indicated the fire department prefers not to have them stage there because of emergency vehicle access. The committee will continue to work with the taxi companies to find an acceptable solution for everyone.

7. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS NOT ON AGENDA:

Commissioner Johnson indicated he had been asked where people can park safely if they are going to go to Edgemont on the Mickelson Trail for an extended amount of time. Mr. Lux indicated that if people would communicate that they will be there then it is fine. It would be noted and their vehicle will be left alone. There is no fee.
