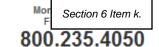

ANIMAL SHELTER AGREEMENT

The Cities of Lead and Deadwood, South Dakota acknowledge that they have been sharing costs and expenses incurred in connection with the animal shelter that is in the City of Lead. The cities further acknowledge that the City of Lead owns the animal shelter and has entered into an agreement with the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" to manage and operate the animal shelter.

The Cities of Lead and Deadwood agree to continue to be equally responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the operation and maintenance of the animal shelter located in Lead, including liability insurance for the animal shelter. The Cities further agree that the City of Deadwood shall not have any further responsibility or liability in connection with the animal shelter other than as set forth above. The Cities agree that the City of Lead shall provide for all the basic needs of any animal brought to the animal shelter by the City of Deadwood. The City of Deadwood agrees to notify the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" when an animal owner has made arrangements to redeem any animal. In cases where no animal owner could be identified, allow the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" to rehome any animal by adoption, placement or any other disposition deemed by the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" to be in the best interest of the animal. The City of Deadwood agrees that any animals placed in the animal shelter will be taken care of as mentioned above at any time after 72 hours. This would be in effect unless other arrangements have been made with the animal owner or designee or unless directed otherwise by a Deadwood Police Department designee and agreed upon by a representative of the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter."

Further, the City of Lead shall be authorized to continue the agreement with the "Friends of the Twin City Animal Shelter" or make such other agreements or arrangements as deemed appropriate and necessary by the City of Lead for operation of the animal shelter.

The parties agree that the City of Deadwood will be billed annually for its' share of animal shelter expenses.

LOBBYIST AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, is made this _____ day of _____, 2023, between Deadwood Historic Preservation (hereinafter referred to as "Client") and Roger Tellinghuisen, 102 Port Na Haven, Fort Pierre, South Dakota 57532 (hereinafter referred to as "Lobbyist").

- Purpose of Employment. Client employs Roger Tellinghuisen to represent
 Client as its Lobbyist to lobby on Client's behalf in the 2023 session of the South Dakota
 Legislature.
- 2. <u>Lobbyist Fees</u>. Client shall pay to Lobbyist as Lobbyist fees for such representation the following sums:
- (A) <u>Contract Lobbyist</u> \$20,000.00, plus expenses for sales tax of \$1,300.00 (if Client is not exempt from South Dakota sales/use tax) and Lobbyist registration fee of \$40.00. The fees for lobbying shall be paid within 10 days of the date of the commencement of the 2023 Legislative Session.
- 3. Conflict of Interest. Client recognizes that Lobbyist is engaged in the business of lobbying for a number of clients. From time to time a particular bill pending before the Legislature or issue of legislative concern may affect more than one of Lobbyist's clients. Client and Lobbyist recognize that the legislative interests of Client and other clients of Lobbyist may not always be compatible. Any conflict of interest which arises with respect to any legislative issue will be brought to the attention of all affected clients by Lobbyist and will be resolved in the following manner: (1) An effort will be made to resolve or compromise the conflict between clients. Such a compromise must be agreed to by all affected clients; (2) If a client elects to withdraw the conflicting

issue from its legislative program, the conflict of interest will be considered resolved; (3) If a conflict is not resolved by a client's withdrawal of the issue or mutual compromise (i.e. waiver of conflict) of the conflicting points of view, Lobbyist shall continue to represent, on the conflicting issue, only the legislative interests of the client which has retained Roger Tellinghuisen as a registered lobbyist for the longest period of time. In this circumstance, Client agrees that it will not object in any manner to this continued representation of other clients. For purposes of this article, client includes any parent, subsidiary or affiliated entity of such client.

4. Terms of this Agreement. This Agreement shall be effective until the conclusion of the 2023 Legislative Session of the South Dakota Legislature. This Agreement may continue from time to time on such terms as are agreed upon by the parties.

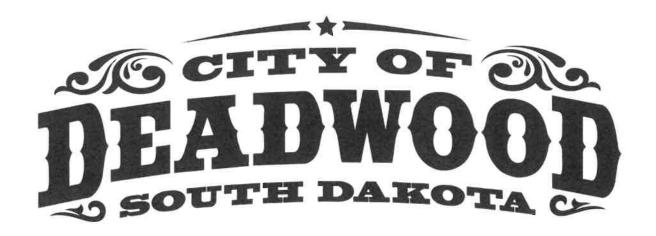

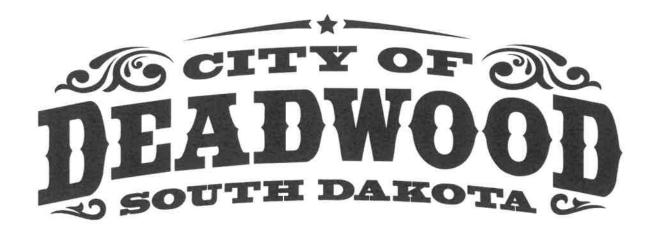

There will also be marketing signage in the area during this time from HD, as well as potentially inflatables from GEICO (a gecko) and Law Tigers (a tiger). The inflatables will be set and secured near the Welcome Center and will not impede traffic.
