CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Niles called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. He stated the purpose of the public hearing. Mayor Niles conducted a roll call. Council Members Western, Chase, Carter, and Bogue were present. Council Member Killpack was absent.

BUSINESS – Any such business as may come before the Council.

1. To receive and consider public comment regarding the determination that certain appropriations of public funds are for corporate purposes

Mayor Niles explained that it is considered a corporate purpose to appropriate money for any purpose that, in the judgement of the municipal legislative body provides for safety, health, prosperity, moral well-being, peace, order, comfort or convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality.

Attorney Anderson added that she had been in contact with Recorder Westbrook and that the city already has a budget of \$20,000 set aside for donations. The Council needs to set parameters on who meets the qualifications and when donations are made, including parameters of how much and putting a cap on amount.

Council Member Western asked for clarification on if the City must be getting something back, in kind. Attorney Anderson stated that it just needs to meet the corporate purpose stated by Mayor Niles.

Mayor Niles asked for any public comment. Council Member Carter thanked Attorney Anderson for clarification, stating that this helped answer questions he had.

There were no comments from the public.
