CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Bogue called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m. He stated that notice of the time, place, and agenda of the meeting had been posted at the Delta City Complex, on the Delta City website, on the Utah Public Notice website, had been provided to the Millard County Chronicle-Progress, LLC and each member of the City Council at least 24 hours before the meeting. Mayor Bogue conducted a roll call. Council Members Carter, Huber, Killpack, Stefanoff, and Taylor were present.

BUSINESS – Any such business as may come before the Council.

1. Present and accept public comments regarding Ordinance 26-329, an ordinance imposing a sales and use tax for transportation in an amount not to exceed 0.30%.

Mayor Bogue explained that this tax would not exceed \$0.30 per every \$100.00. Delta City is one of only a few cities in Utah in which this tax has not already been implemented.

Russell Anderson addressed the Mayor and Council asking about how this would be charged. It was explained that this will automatically be charged at the pump within Delta City Limits beginning in October.

Rendon Hughes asked the Mayor and Council for clarification on whether this tax will also be imposed on bulk fuel purchases. The explanation was that in whatever city that bulk fuel was purchased, it would follow the sales and use taxes implemented at that location.


ADJOURNMENT

Council Member Killpack MOVED to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 p.m. Council Member Carter SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.
