3. Lisa Myers; Myers Legacy Estates Subdivision Preliminary Renewal

Action: Discussion/Consideration for approval

Lisa Myers appeared before the Planning and Zoning Commission to seek approval for the renewal of the preliminary plat of the Myers Legacy Estates Subdivision. The Public Works Department has no concerns.

5. Hansen Planning: Subdivision Ordinance Revision review

Action: Discussion/Consideration for approval

The Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed the subdivision ordinance revision presented by Hansen Planning. There have been no major issues; the questions were resolved at the last meeting.

Attorney Anderson would like to change the addition of historical ordinance record numbers in the code.

Roads will need to be classified as thoroughfares. Neighborhoods will have different road requirements. Council Liaison Killpack mentioned that the road will be 32 feet wide, but there will be a 60-foot right-of-way. A plan will need to be made for collector roads.

A public hearing will be set for 6:45 p.m. on December 11th.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Public Works Director Kirkland mentioned that the Public Works Department laid millings on 20 mid-block streets, starting with the most populated streets. Next summer, they will single-chip-seal the roads with millings and double-chip-seal the roads without millings.

Commission Member Stewart asked Attorney Anderson about the status of the pioneering agreement. Attorney Anderson remarked that it was on his to-do list.
