CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Bogue conducted a roll call. Council Members Kelly Carter, Nick Killpack, Brian Huber, Natalie Stefanoff, and Nathan Taylor were present.

1. Minutes Approval: Minutes Approval RCCM 2026-05-20

The minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting held on 05/20/2026 were presented for approval. Council Member Taylor MOVED to approve the Regular City Council Meeting minutes held on 05/20/2026 at 7:00 p.m. Council Member Huber SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any other questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.

3. Council Member Natalie Stefanoff: Delta City Youth Council Introduction & Oath of Office
Action: Discussion/Consideration for Approval

Youth who were selected to be on the Delta Youth City Council introduced themselves to the public in attendance, Mayor Bogue, and Council Members. Delta City Recorder, Sherri Westbrook, gave the Oath of Office to the newly introduced Youth Council Members.

Council Member Taylor MOVED to accept the Delta City Youth Council Members and Oaths of Office. Council Member Killpack SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.

4. Deputy Recorder Angie Dewsnup: Website Update
Action: Discussion/Consideration for Approval

Delta City Deputy Recorder, Angie Dewsnup, addressed the Mayor and City Council. Dewsnup gave a presentation of three website companies that were researched in order to find an updated and more user-friendly website for Delta City. Based on her research, Dewsnup made her recommendation to the Council that Delta City work with Proud City to develop and maintain the city website (www.delta.utah.gov); however, Dewsnup also stated that the City Office Staff wanted to go over any questions or concerns prior to final decision.

Council Member Killpack MOVED to approve contracting with the recommended website company, Proud City, for Delta City's Website. Council Member Stefanoff SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.

5. Mayor Bogue: Proposal to convert Street Lights
Action: Discussion/Consideration for Approval

Mayor Bogue and Public Works Field Supervisor, Stetson Henrie, met with Rocky Mountain Power regarding conversion of all streetlights in Delta City to LED lights. The full conversion will cost about \$35,000, with a savings of around \$10,000 per year. Council Member Carter stated that if ROI is only 3 years, or so, it makes sense to move forward with the conversion.

Council Member Carter MOVED to approve the proposal of converting Delta City streetlights to LEDs. Council Member Taylor SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.

Motion made by Council Member Carter, Seconded by Council Member Taylor.

6. Mayor Bogue: Business License Felony question

Attorney Jessica Anderson shared with the Mayor and Council that it is not required to ask about a felony conviction on a business license application. Delta City Code does have some verbiage about it, but this is not required and could be removed.

Council Member Killpack MOVED to remove the question of asking about a felony conviction from the Delta City Business License Application. Council Member Carter SECONDED the motion. Mayor Bogue asked if there were any questions or comments regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote.

7. Mayor Bogue: July 4th Celebrations

Action: Discussion/Consideration for Approval

Mayor Bogue asked the Council Members for a quick update and discussion on preparations for Delta City's July 4th Celebrations. Council Member Stefanoff and Rebecca Peterson from the Delta City Office shared the plans for each day of the week. There will be activities to enjoy from Sunday thru Saturday the 4th of July. These include a movie in the park, sidewalk chalk art contests, a Night at the Museum, the Kiddie Parade, bounce houses, vendor booths, the traditional Silver Dive, Patriotic Program, and the Parade. There will also be a concert at the Millard County Fairgrounds and the Mayor asked for the Council Members to please help with taking tickets at the gates, per a request made by County Tourism Director, Rachel West.

Council Member Huber discussed Color Guard for the parade and having a military fly-over to begin the parade. Council Member Stefanoff requested ordering new banners for the parade for Grand Marshal, Delta City Mayor & Council, Delta City Youth Council, and Miss Delta. Council Members Stefanoff and Taylor gave details for the Youth Council's Night at the Museum where visitors will receive a punch card and upon visiting 6 destinations to learn about America's Founding Fathers and Delta City and American History, will earn a unique America250/Delta City commemorative coin.

Peterson stated that preparations are going well and Delta City will be ready for the celebration.
