1. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive and consider public comment regarding the proposed rezoning of the following, more specifically described as 365 E 450 S. Legal description:

ALL OF LOT 4, BLOCK 3, PLAT "A", DELTA TOWNSITE SURVEY, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT THEREOF ON FILE AND OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE MILLARD COUNTY RECORDER, STATE OF UTAH.

Proposed zone change is from Single-Family Residential Medium Density (R-1-B) Zone to Single and Two-Family Residential (R-2) Zone. Colin Christensen, applicant. The Commission will consider input from all interested parties prior to making a recommendation to the Delta City Council on this issue.

Chairman Jones asked if there was any public comment on this proposed rezoning. Scott Nickle appeared before the Planning and Zoning Commission as someone who owns adjoining property and wanted to know many lots this rezoning entailed. Chairman Jones remarked that it would be one parcel owned by Colin Christensen, which is less than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre. Nickle expressed concerns over parking and was informed by the Commission that there would be 3 parking spaces per unit required with one extra space for every two units, thus resulting in seven required parking spaces per duplex.


