CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

BUSINESS – Any such business as may come before the Council.

1. Mike Gill and Alyssa Wahlin were present from Dominion Energy to discuss and address questions concerning the Dominion Therm H2 Project. Mike Gill gave a report on the project and the changes that had been made since the initial meeting with the city council. He stated that the concerns expressed by the Delta City Fire Department Chief had been addressed and changes have been made to the storage of the hydrogen. There will not be a large tank of hydrogen, it will now be 16 cylinders that will occupy an approximate 3' x 4' space. They will be working toward an electrolysis process that will create the hydrogen rather than storing a large amount of hydrogen on site. They also stated that natural gas consumers will be billed on the gas content which will result in a slightly lower charge. Several questions were posed about the safety and the content of the hydrogen, etc. Representatives explained that other pilot projects are being done in several other areas of the country. There were a few questions about health and safety posed by the citizens in attendance. Representatives assured the citizens that they would research their questions. Dominion has scheduled a public meeting to be held at the RJ Law Center on October 26, 2022, and November 5, 2022. Representatives asked permission to start advertising for these public meetings. Permission was granted by the city council.

ADJOURNMENT


