1. CALL TO ORDER

The library had a booth at the Fall Fest. Vinyl Flooring was installed, and air conditioning repairs were made at the library. Currently soliciting bids for building repairs. Read to win goes to public schools and daycares and completes 37000 readings a year. The library has received some artwork and is looking for a way to display it.
