PUBLIC HEARING

1. 1805 E HWY 126, REDMOND, OR 97756 - The applicant requests approval of a Comprehensive Plan Amendment to change the designation of a portion the subject property, approximately 228 acres, from Agricultural (AG) to Redmond Urban Growth Area (RUGA) and a corresponding Urban Growth Boundary (UGB) expansion. The applicant also requests a corresponding Zone Change to rezone the subject property from Exclusive Farm Use (EFU) to Urban Holding (UH-10).

The purpose of these applications is to allow for the development of the Central Oregon Ready, Responsive, Resilient (CORE3) facility. The CORE3 facility will address a need for both a centralized public safety training facility and a coordination center for emergency response operations.
