The purpose of the hearing is to consider whether certain dogs engaged in the killing and injuring of chickens and ducks, to-wit:

1. Killing and injuring chickens, and injuring ducks on Deschutes Road in Bend 97701. The three dogs in question are husky mixes and a shepherd mix.
