### 1. Updates from Bend and Redmond HLCs

- The CLG Grant deadline is February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Tanya reviewed list of proposed projects for grant funding including; Sisters building hardening, county historic properties mailer, updating DIAL to a web platform, grant administration, review and compliance administration, Preservation Month, and HLC membership to National Alliance of Preservation Commissions.
