Present were Commissioners Patti Adair (via Zoom), Tony DeBone and Phil Chang (via Zoom). Also present were County Administrator Nick Lelack, Senior Assistant Legal Counsel Kim Riley and BOCC Executive Assistant Brenda Fritsvold.

CITIZEN INPUT:

- Ron Boozell noted that 23 years ago today was the infamous terrorist attack on America and spoke to the importance of giving blood during such times and indeed throughout the year as units are always in short supply. On another subject, Boozell expressed disappointment that the promised conversation with the City of Bend regarding homeless encampments at "Dirt World" did not happen last Thursday.
- Carl Shoemaker commented on the ostracization of Charles Cunningham Boycott who organized the Langley movement in Ireland against England in 1880.
