City Manager's Report.

CITY MANAGER REPORT

July 16, 2024

1. <u>MDOT Projects</u> – Met with MDOT representative today and received an update on the project. The currently closed ramp was more difficult to remove than anticipated. They have completed the

- demo of the ramp and have started on the roadbed. MDOT has had several meetings with the contractor about the Delisle exit staying open to always allow for at least one lane of traffic.
- 2. <u>Diamondhead Signs</u> TL Wallace has informed me that the Diamondhead sign must be removed due to the roundabout project. Ty and I have had discussions with the original builder regarding moving the sign. It has been determined that the sign's construction will not allow it to be moved. The city will determine if space is available to build a replacement sign once the project is complete.
- 3. <u>Park Ten Road</u> –The contract is for 403 Calendar Days with a current end date of October 12th. The contractor has started paving the new road and will continue once the utility poles have been removed from the roadway.
- 4. <u>Beaux Vue 2</u> The notice to proceed was issued on July 8th. The contract is for 60 Calendar Days with a current end date of September 5th.
- 5. <u>Kaleki Way</u> The contract is for 120 days with an end date of August 6th. The project is nearing completion. The contractor will begin sodding and hydroseeding as well as final cleanup.
- 6. <u>Bayou Drive</u> –The project is complete, and the road is open. Final closeout documents will be on the next agenda.
- 7. Noma Drive Phase 1b – The notice to proceed was issued on July 8th. The contract is for 180 Calendar Days with a current end date of January 7th.
- 8. <u>Gex Drive Lighting</u> –The contractor has installed the light fixtures. They will be completing the wiring this week.
- 9. Drainage Projects All ARPA bids are on the agenda tonight for approval.
- 10. <u>Canal Dredging</u> MDEQ is working on the grant agreement for this project and will be sending it within the next week. The construction schedule is set to start in March/April of 2025 pending funding approval.
- 11. Noma Drive Boardwalk The project is starting the permitting and design phase. This will take three to six months to complete.
- 12. <u>Coon Branch</u> Met with the engineer last week to discuss the modeling of the area. Engineer is working on several options for design.
- 13. <u>CRS</u> We have our onsite meeting scheduled for July 17th.
- 14. <u>Warning Siren Project</u> MEMA has informed the city that the previously FEMA approved Hazard Mitigation project will not be able to continue forward. They have miscalculated and over spent funds from the declared disaster. MEMA is not saying nor implying that this project is completely over, but it will be saved in their files for available funding for non-impacted areas. When MEMA has more funds available, they will continue with the siren project.
- 15. <u>Noma Drive Dredging</u> The engineer is waiting for the permits needed before the project can be finalized and bid.
- 16. <u>Dog Park</u> –The county needed a final review of the survey and add signature lines to the document. They plan on having it on the BOS's August meeting wherein approval to submit the subdivision application to the City of Diamondhead will be obtained. The subdivision application and supporting documentation will then come to the City for the various approvals.
- 17. <u>Montjoy Creek</u> No updated information this meeting. The engineer is waiting on the final permits to allow for the project to go out for bid.

- 18. <u>Detention Ponds</u> No updated information this meeting. Engineer has completed design on this project and will provide them to public works to complete the dredging.
- 19. <u>Kome Drive</u> No updated information this meeting. This will be to address driveway and landscape culverts on Kome Drive.
- 20. <u>Kalipekona Pond</u> -- No updated information this meeting. This project will dredge the south end of the pond to remove sediment.
- 21. <u>Pelican Cove Drainage Project</u> <u>No updated information this meeting</u>. Engineer has been provided with the work assignment and will begin the surveying on this project.
- 22. <u>Noma Drive Nature Trail</u> No updated information this meeting. The engineer presented the project to the council tonight.

 Drive East are hanging over the road and need to be trimmed. <u>Public works have trimmed the
 trees in this area.</u>

- 3. <u>79326 Diamondhead Drive East</u> Councilmember asked for public works to clean and reshape major drainage ditch next to this residence. A work order was created.
- 4. <u>Living Memorial Trees</u> Councilmember asked about the Memorial Magnola trees that were removed due to MDOT construction. I have included funds in the FY25 budget to purchase new trees to replace the ones removed due to the MDOT project.
- 5. <u>7854 Maui Place</u> Councilmember contacted me about a sink hole forming and the ditch needing to be cleaned out to allow proper waterflow. A work order has been issued.
- 6. <u>85542 DH Drive West</u> Councilmember asked for a compliance review on this address. Code enforcement has already contacted the property owner. If they do not comply, a citation will be issued.
