A stop work order was placed on the property and it has been removed. The Storm Water Ordinance (Section 24-10) also prohibits the placement of fill which alters the flow of surface water across said property in a manner which damages any adjacent property.

You are hereby directed to remove all fill from the property and bring the lot back to original grade. These corrective actions shall be completed by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 28, 2023. Upon completion, will you please notify this office for an inspection?

The determination of the Zoning violation may be appealed to the Planning Commission by filing a written notice of appeal within 10 days of service of notice of violation by filing with the Zoning Administrator a notice of appeal which specify the grounds thereof.






