- 9. Trinity Capital Investors presentation- Jeff Wilson, President, provided an overview of firm and the services offered.
- 10. Discussion regarding Kapalama Cove HOA donation of streets for right of way. Resident Nina Day addressed the Council and was provided direction to begin the process; first is to provide the Council with legal description proposed dedication.
- 11. Mayor Depreo thanked Life Scout Thomas Konkel for the 6 bird houses for the dog park as a part of his Diamondhead Boy Scout Troop 210 Eagle Scout Project.
- 12. Matt Mooneyham updated the council regarding the Hurricane Ida debris pick up process.

City Manager's Report.

- 1. <u>Hurricane Ida Debris</u> The contractor has been picking up Hurricane Ida debris for the last two weeks. They are estimating we have 10K cubic yards of debris in the city. They have 2 trucks that will make only one pass on all streets. Residents are asked to separate their debris into 2 piles. One would be only vegetation and the other would be everything else.
- 2. <u>Cruisin the Coast in Diamondhead</u> The blessing of the classics in Diamondhead is schedule for Wednesday, October 6. There will be parade of cars on Diamondhead Drive loop beginning at 3pm. There will be party at city hall following the parade, and there will be music, food, and drinks. We have Giant Burrito and Rouses selling food and the Funkey Monkey selling loaded teas, snowballs, and ice cream.
- 3. <u>Festival and BBQ Competition</u> The festival is scheduled for Saturday, November 13. Anyone interested in being sponsor, vendor, or BBQ team, please visit our website for information. There will be a sponsor party on Friday night. There will also be a prayer service for veterans at 10am on the 13th before the festival opens for music, food, and drinks. All are invited to this free event.
- 4. <u>Rostan Solutions for CRS Certification There is a motion to get Rostan Solutions to help the city become CRS certified with the National Flood Insurance Program. This provides opportunities for discounts on flood insurance policies for property owners in Diamondhead, and it also improves our applications for hazard mitigation grants.</u>
- 5. Zoning Code Re-Write I am recommending that the council hire Orion Planning and Design to rewrite our zoning codes. This was a recommendation from the comprehensive plan. This is a 8-10 month process and will allow Envision Diamondhead 2040 to become reality in the city.
- 6. <u>Tidelands Grant –</u> The city was awarded a \$400K grant from Tidelands by our State Legislature last Spring. This is for the Noma Drive Waterfront project. This agenda item simply accepts the agreement with DMR.
- 7. <u>Dog Park Grant –</u> There is a motion to accept a \$10K donation from the Gulf Coast Community Foundation for the dog park construction project. We are grateful for this grant from one of their funds.
- 8. <u>Appropriations</u> There is a motion to approve the expenditure of funds that were budgeted as allocations for FY22. These are funds sent from the city to these organizations that help our community.

- 9. <u>Financial Audit</u> The administration is recommending to the council that we negotiate with Necaise and Company for the FY21 comprehensive annual financial report. Ty completed his 3-year agreement for this service to the city. This will allow him to do one more year before we advertise for proposals for a new auditing firm. The administration is extremely pleased with the work of Ty and his team.
- 10. <u>Hilo Street Drainage Project –</u> There is a motion to accept the recommendation of the engineer to hire the contractor with the low bid for the Hilo Street Drainage project. This is the failed culvert passing between two homes and under the Hilo Street.
- 11. <u>Hilo Way Drainage Project</u> There is a work assignment with Machado Patano for survey and assessment of an area on Hilo Way where we have been experiencing drainage problems for many years. This will evaluate the area and provide a recommendation to the council to help correct the problem.
- 12. <u>Sub-Basin A and Ieke, Kaleki and Amoka Drainage</u> There is a work assignment with Covington Engineering for the next phase of analysis for Sub-basin A and Ieke, Kaleki and Amoka. Ben from Covington is here to speak towards this work assignment.
- 13. <u>Kolo Ct Drainage Project</u> There is a new work assignment on the agenda for Pickering Engineering for the design phase of the Kolo Ct Drainage Project. The engineering firm submitted their report with several options and their recommendation. The estimated cost of the entire project is \$512K. Previously, DNA Underground submitted a proposal to do a small section of this project for about \$80K, which was consistent with this engineer's recommendation. This is an erosion problem near sewerage lines. It does not impact homes, but it does impact the sewerage lines in this area. My recommendation to the council is to consider doing only a limited area of the project for now that has the immediate concern. Then, as the council works to prioritize major drainage projects, we include the remainder of the project in that list.
- 14. <u>Engineer RFQ</u> I plan to have recommendations to the council for engineering services at the next council meeting. We have many great firms that have submitted qualifications to the city.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL (THE "GOVERNING BODY") OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI (THE CITY), TO VACATE AND/OR ABANDON A 5' DRAINAGE/UTILITY EASEMENT ON EACH SIDE OF THE COMMON PROPERTY LINE BETWEEN LOTS 33 and 34, DEVIL'S ELBOW PHASE 1, HANCOCK COUNTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (the Governing Body) of the City of Diamondhead, Mississippi (the City), acting for and on behalf of the City, hereby finds and determines as follows:

- 1. The City currently has a 5' drainage/utility easement on each side of the common property line between Lots 33 and 34, Devil's Elbow Phase 1 (see attached survey from Duke Levy as Exhibit A).
- 2. David Condon and Amanda Prudhomme are the owner of Lots 33 and 34, Devil's Elbow Phase 1. The parcel number is 068Q-2-41-036.000. The physical street address is 34 Devil's Elbow.
- 3. Further, the City hereby abandons and/or vacates the drainage/utility easements for the full width and length as petitioned except for the front and rear drainage and utility easement. These drainage/utility easements are 5' drainage and utility easements on each side of the common property line between Lots 33 and 34, Devil's Elbow Phase 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Governing Body of the City will hereby abandon the selected drainage/utility easements with respect to Lots 33 and 34 described in bullet #3. The Diamondhead Public Works, Diamondhead Water & Sewer District and CEPA do not have any objections.
