CITY MANAGER REPORT

May 20, 2025

- 1. <u>Noma Drive Phase 1b</u> The ribbon cutting was a wonderful event. I want to thank everyone that attended. The contractor will be completing any additional punch list items by the end of the month.
- 2. <u>Noma Drive Dredging</u> The contractor is completing the hydro-survey today and will install channel markers by the end of the month.
- 3. <u>Kome Drive & Kalipekona Pond</u> The project is for 120 days with a current end date of June 10th. The change order on the agenda for tonight will reduce the total contract price but is asking to extend the time due to weather delays. The change order will have the contractor install additional anchors to the culverts to prevent them from floating up.
- 4. <u>MDOT Projects</u> The ramp headed East has a current end date of May 23. The bridge deck is currently being installed.
- 5. <u>Dog Park</u> The engineering firm has completed the survey work. Once they are able to process the data, they will let the city know if any additional clearing is needed.
- 6. <u>Paving 2025</u> The pre-construction meeting will be held on Friday. The city is currently waiting on bonds and insurance before a notice to proceed is issued.
- 7. Unit Price
 - a. The Kipapa Way Public Works has placed this project on hold.
 - b. Koko Court Waiting on a work assignment from the contractor.
 - c. Mauna Loa Additional survey work needed from engineer.
 - d. Makiki Drive Public Works has placed this project on hold.
- 8. <u>Coon Branch</u> The notice to proceed has been set for June 16th. Project is 180 days with an expected end date of December 13th.
- 9. <u>Canal Dredging</u> MDEQ has all additional information requested. A meeting is scheduled for Wednesday to discuss the next steps.
- 10. <u>Jourdan River Boardwalk</u> The monthly meeting with MDEQ is scheduled for Wednesday. The final drawings are expected to be completed and sent to MDEQ for review.

- 11. <u>Detention Pond</u> The engineer provided their initial design to the city. The POA did not like the increase in the fairway. The engineer is redesigning the pond to prevent fairway encroachment. Public works will dredge this pond once plans are provided to the city.
- 12. <u>Bank Stabilization</u> No update on this meeting. The engineers are finalizing the analysis on the Phase 1 design. Phase one will cover the area from Diamondhead Drive North to Kalipekona Pond. The rear ditch will require additional easement for access.
- 13. <u>Rotten Bayou Nature Trail</u> No update on this meeting. The engineer has redesigned this project into five phases. The funding is already secured for phase 1. The engineer is working on the phase 1 design.
- 14. <u>Montjoy Creek</u> No update on this meeting. The engineer is working on redesigning the current sediment trap along the waterway. If approved, additional permitting will not be required from USACE. Once approved, the project can be sent out for bid.
- 15. <u>Pelican Cove Drainage Project</u> No update on this meeting. The engineer has additional surveying to complete and will finalize the drawing for this project.

All signs must have the name and contact information for the individual placing the sign. Signs must be a minimum of two (2) feet from the street.

8 ARTICLE 8 - SIGNS

ARTICLE 8 - SIGNS

8.1 Scope, Purpose, and Legal Effect.

The regulations herein set forth shall apply and govern in all zoning districts as hereinafter provided. No sign or outdoor advertising device shall be erected unless it is in compliance with regulations for the district in which it is located as specified in this Article. For the purpose of this Article, the following sign regulations are established to assure the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Diamondhead and to encourage the economy of the city, to protect the public investments in streets and highways to preserve natural beauty, and to protect tax revenues by promoting reasonable, orderly and effective display of outdoor advertising.

8.2 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this Article, the words and terms found herein shall have the meanings respectively ascribed in Article 10. All words used in this Article not specifically defined herein shall be given their meanings in normal customary usage.

8.3 CONFORMITY AND PERMIT REQUIRED.

All signs hereafter erected on any lot in any district of the City shall conform to the provisions of this ordinance. It shall be unlawful for any person, contractor or entity to erect, enlarge, rebuild, or structurally alter any sign without first obtaining a permit therefor and paying the requisite permit fee unless a sign is exempt from this permit requirement.

8.4 Permitted Sign Types Established.

The following table establishes, defines and illustrates the allowed sign types in the City of Diamondhead. Signs are generally classified into the following categories:

- 1. On-Premises Freestanding Signs.
- 2. On-Premises Attached Signs.
- 3. Off-Premises Freestanding Signs.

- 4. Off-Premises Attached Signs.
- 5. Off-Premises Mobile Signs.

8.5 SIGNS PERMITTED BY ZONING DISTRICT.

The permitted location of signs is governed by zoning district. The Table of Permitted Sign Locations sets forth permitted sign location by type. The "\[\bigcup \]" means a sign permit is required. The symbol "\[\bigcup \]" means the sign is permitted but exempt from permit. The letter "C" refers to a conditional use approved by the Planning & Zoning Commission. The Preservation District (PFR) shall NOT be considered a residential district.

8.6 DIMENSIONAL REQUIREMENTS, NUMBER OF SIGNS, AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS.

The dimensional requirements, number of signs permitted and other special conditions are set forth in the Table of Sign Requirements by Sign Type.

8.7 EXEMPT SIGNS.

The following types of signs are exempted from the requirements of the Article; except those particular signs that may be classified by the Planning Commission as obscene, dangerous or hazardous, conflicting aesthetically, or that generally do not meet the basic requirements of other Sections of the Article, such as design, maintenance, etc. No permit is required for exempted signs.

a) Political signs. Any political sign or poster not exceeding three square feet erected on property by the owner thereof or with the property owner's consent pertaining to a candidacy or issued to be voted upon at any election or referendum, provided such sign or poster shall not be erected more than 60 days prior to such election or referendum and shall be removed with seven days after the referendum, or last such election in which the candidate is eligible.
