Bid Package has been received for GST and drip field work. City has awarded contract to CCCarlton. Construction has started and will approximately take 3 months There were no reportable violations in the month of March.

#### Update on Reclaimed Water:

Founders Park reclaimed water usage was 348,302 gallons for the month of March with a daily average of 11,235 gallons per day. Sports Park reclaimed water usage was 1,015,768 gallons for the month of March with a daily average of 32,766 gallons per day. Total usage was 1,364,070 gallons with a daily average of 44,002 gallons used per day.
