STAFF ANALYSIS: The Public Hearing will be advertised in accordance with the Florida

Statutes regarding the method of fixing tax millage. This Public Hearing is the second of two required Public Hearings with the first

taking place on September 10, 2025, at 6:30pm.

Revenues from ad-valorem taxes for FY 25 - 26 are estimated at \$423,776,398 and are based upon the proposed millage rate of 7.9000, which is greater than the "rolled-back" rate of 7.542 mills

by 4.7%.

Tentative Millage Rate Calculation

 $423,776,398 \times 0.0079000 = 33,347,834 (95\% = 33,180,442.00)$ 

"Rolled-back" Rate Calculation

\$423,776,398 X 0.007542 = \$3,196,122 (95%=\$3,036,316.00)

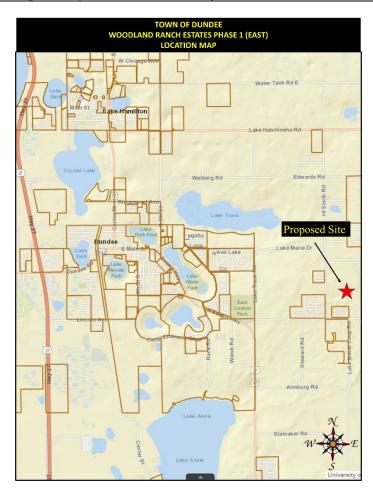

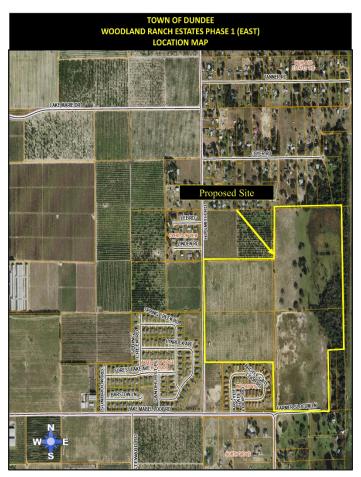

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Applicant, Kenneth Thompson, PLS with Platinum Surveying & Mapping, LLC is requesting approval of the Final Plat for Woodland Ranch Estates Phase 1 (East) Subdivision a 116.03 +/-acres of land located east of Highway 17, east side of H.L. Smith Rd., south of Coyer Rd., and north of Farmer Slocum Ln. in the Town of Dundee, further described as parcels: 272826-000000-021020,272825-000000-043010,272825-000000-043020,272826-000000-022010,272825-000000-044020, and 272825-000000-044010 . The parcels have a Future Land Use of Medium Density Residential and Zoning of Moderate-Density Single Family Residential (RSF-3) and consist of 308 Single Family dwelling units.

#### **FINAL PLAT**

Per Section 7.01.08 of the Land Development Code, the intent of the Final Plat is to establish a legal record of the plat. Whenever the provisions of this Code have been complied with and while the approval of the certified subdivision plan is in effect, the applicant shall submit the final plat for approval and recording. The final plat shall conform substantially to the approved CSP and, at the option of the subdivider, may constitute only that portion or phase of the approved CSP which is proposed to be recorded at that time. Upon approval of the final plat, the applicant may proceed with obtaining building permits within the subdivision and the plat shall be forwarded by the town clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Polk County for review and approval in accordance with county procedures. The original plat shall then be submitted to the clerk of the circuit court for recording within the public records of Polk County.

Per Section 7.01.13 of the Land Development Code, approval of the final plat shall not constitute acceptance of any area or facilities offered by said plat for dedication to the Town of Dundee. The Town Commission shall not accept dedication of required improvements nor release nor reduce a performance bond until the town is satisfied that all required improvements have been properly completed and until the engineer or subdivider has certified, through submission of a detailed "as-built" survey plat of the subdivision indicating location dimensions, materials, and other information required by the Town, that the layout of the line and grade of all public improvements is in accordance with construction plans for the subdivision and that a title insurance policy has been furnished to and approved by the Town attorney indicating that the improvements shall have been completed, are ready for dedication to the Town and are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances. Upon such approval and recommendation, the Town Commission shall thereafter accept the improvements for dedication in accordance with the established procedure.

#### **FINAL PLAT COMMENTS**

As required, the Final Plat is substantially similar to the Certified Subdivision Plan (CSP). The applicant submitted all required materials, which were reviewed by the Town staff. The applicant is requesting to bond the outstanding site development improvements.

Consistent with Section 7.01.08 of the LDC, the applicant is requesting the Town Commission's approval of the Final Plat for Shores at Lake Dell Subdivision with the conditions as outlined in Resolution 24-27.

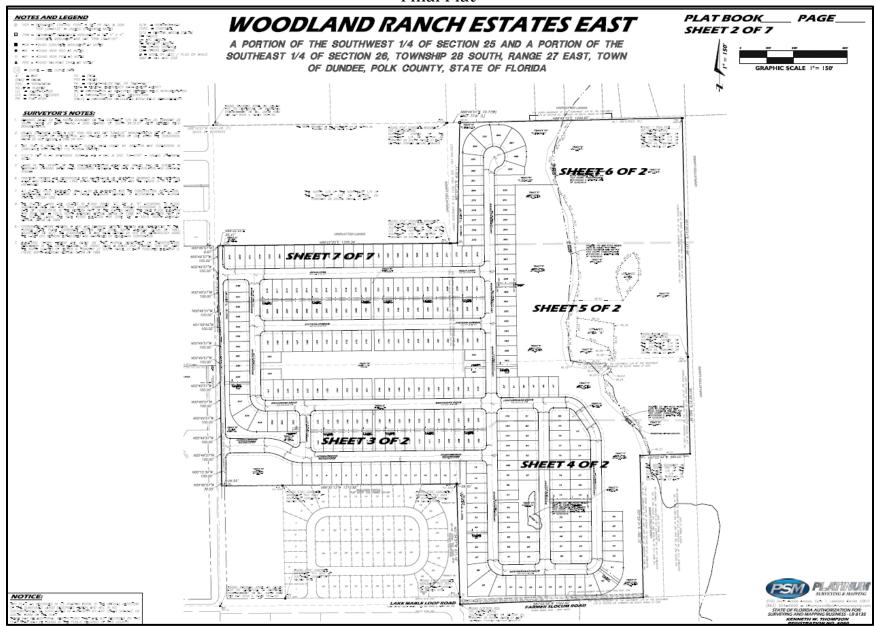

AND DEDICATIONS IN FAVOR OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND TOWN OF DUNDEE, FLORIDA, AS NOTATED ON THAT CERTAIN **PLAT ENTITLED** "WOODLAND RANCH ESTATES PHASE ONE" ACCEPTING A MAINTENANCE BOND FOR CERTAIN ITEMS OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE WOODLAND RANCH ESTATES PHASE ONE SUBDIVISION: PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION: PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE **ADMINISTRATIVE** CORRECTION OF **SCRIVERNER'S ERRORS: PROVIDING FOR RECORDATION**; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Dundee (the "Town") is a Florida municipal corporation vested with home rule authority pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Powers Act (F.S. Chapter 166) and Article VIII, §2 of the Florida Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2(b), Article VIII of the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the Town is vested with governmental, corporate and proprietary powers to enable it to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, including the general exercise of any power for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 14, 2023, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission of the Town of Dundee (the "Town Commission") passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Resolution No. 22-51* (the "Resolution") approving with conditions the Certified Subdivision Plan (the "CSP") for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases I and II Subdivision (the "Subdivision"); and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the Resolution is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and made a part hereof by reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Resolution (see Exhibit "A"), the Town Commission conditionally approved the CSP for construction of utility systems and other required infrastructure in accordance with Section 7.01.07 of the Town of Dundee Land Development Code (the "LDC") and the conditions set forth in the Resolution which included, but was not limited to, the condition that, prior to the issuance of a building permit for *any* structure located on or within the Subdivision, all required infrastructure systems and improvements required by the LDC, the Town of Dundee Code of Ordinances, the Resolution (see Exhibit "A"), and applicable Florida law are fully operational and accepted by the Town and/or entity with jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-10* (the "Moratorium") establishing a moratorium on and/or for the acceptance and processing of applications for annexations, rezonings, building permits, planned developments, master planned communities, development order(s), and development permit(s); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the terms and conditions of *Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-10*, pending a satisfactory concurrency evaluation, the Subdivision was specifically and conditionally exempt from the Moratorium; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 2, 2024, the owner/applicant (the "Owner"), Woodland Ranch Estates, LLC, submitted the *Town of Dundee Development Services* – *Hardship Application* (the "Application"); and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission *conditionally approved* the Application and entered HARDSHIP ORDER NO. 01-24 (hereafter the "Order") which provided the Owner with an exception to the moratorium; and

- **WHEREAS**, a copy of the Order is attached hereto as **Exhibit** "B" and made a part hereof by reference; and
- **WHEREAS**, on June 26, 2025, pursuant to the Code, the LDC and applicable agreements, the Owner submitted a request to the Town for an *adequacy determination* related to potable water concurrency for the development Woodland Ranch Estates Subdivision (the "Development"); and
- **WHEREAS**, on June 27, 2025, the Owner and Town executed the *Town of Dundee, Florida Concurrency Certification Potable Water Capacity* (the "Certification") for the Development; and
- **WHEREAS**, a copy of the Certification is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"** and made a part hereof by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the Owner, Woodland Ranch Estates, LLC, an active Florida limited liability company authorized to transact business in the State of Florida, of the below-described lands submitted that certain plat entitled Woodland Ranch Estates Phase One (the "Plat") for approval for filing by the Town Commission in accordance Chapter 177 of the Florida Statutes, Section 7.01.00 of the LDC, and the Resolution (see Exhibit "A"); and
- WHEREAS, the Subdivision is to occur on approximately 116.03 +/- acres of land which are located East of Highway 17, East side of H.L. The Town Commission of the Town of Dundee having reviewed the CSP and having been otherwise fully advised in the premises hereby conditionally approves the CSP for construction of utility systems and other required infrastructure in accordance with Section 7.01.07 of the Town of Dundee Land Development Code and the conditions set forth in this Resolution, as follows:
  - a. No building permits for any structures will be issued until all required infrastructure systems and improvements required by the Town of Dundee Land Development Code, Code of Ordinances, this Resolution, and applicable Florida law are fully operational and have been accepted by the Town and/or appropriate entity with jurisdiction.
  - b. Pursuant to Section 54-9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee (the "Code") and Section 6.01.07.03 of the LDC, a developer's agreement is required as a condition of approval for the CSP in order to provide, at a minimum, as follows: (1) detail the Town's inability to currently provide allocable water capacity for the Subdivision; (2) detail the necessary expansion of the Town's water treatment facilities to serve the Subdivision; and (3) detail the terms and conditions under which the Town will provide potable water utility service for the Subdivision.

- c. Pursuant to Section 7.01.07 of the LDC and applicable provisions of the Code and LDC, the technical review comments which include but are not limited to, the comments included whereas composite Exhibit C (the "Comments") provided by the Town's consultants related to the CSP and Subdivision shall be satisfied and accepted by the Town and/or Town's consultants.
- d. Unless the Town has performed a satisfactory concurrency evaluation related to the Town's ability to provide allocable potable water capacity for the Subdivision, the CSP shall not be considered complete for the purpose of providing a basis upon which a final plat may be considered for approval by the Town Commission of the Town of Dundee.
- 5. In the event the Town has performed a satisfactory concurrency evaluation related to the Town's ability to provide allocable potable water capacity for the Subdivision, the construction of the required infrastructure systems and/or improvements for the Subdivision shall also be complete and accepted by the Town prior to Final Subdivision Plat approval.
- 6. In the event the construction of the required infrastructure systems and/or improvements for the Subdivision are not complete and accepted by the Town, Final Subdivision Plat approval for the Subdivision shall be conditioned upon the following: (a) a developer's agreement or development agreement shall be approved by the Town Commission, executed by the parties, and recorded in the public records in and for Polk County, Florida; and (b) when approved by the Town, the applicant shall provide the Town with adequate performance security and adequate defect security pursuant to the terms and provisions of a developer's agreement or development agreement.

For purposes of this Resolution, "adequate performance security" and "adequate defect security" shall mean, at a minimum, as follows:

(a) Adequate performance security shall be satisfactory in form to the Town Attorney and the Town Engineer and the Town's planning staff and be in an amount equal to one hundred and twenty-five (125%) percent of the developer's contract for the work that remains uncompleted and not accepted at the time of final plat or final site development plan approval, as certified in writing by the engineer of record, subject to the approval by the Town's planning staff and the Town Engineer. No more than fifty percent (50%) of the value of the total required improvements for each phase of the

Development shall be considered for bonding and/or letter of credit given hereunder. Subject to the terms of the applicable agreement, the performance security shall be released by the Town when all private improvements are installed, inspected and approved and when all public improvements are installed, inspected and accepted. When providing a bond for performance security, the bonding company shall have a B+ or better rating in accordance with "Best Bond Book." In the case of a letter of credit, provisions for drawdowns from the letter of credit as improvements are completed and accepted shall accompany the surety. The letter of credit shall have a duration of twenty-four (24) months; and

- (b) Adequate defect security shall warrant and guarantee the materials and workmanship of all infrastructure and infrastructure improvements within the Subdivision that are dedicated to the public, including streets, curb and gutter, sidewalks, potable water distribution system, sanitary sewer collection and transmission system, reclaimed water system and stormwater management system. This guarantee shall be for an amount equal to ten (10) percent (%) of the actual construction costs of improvements and/or other adequate written assurances which are set forth in an applicable developer's agreement or development agreement for the purpose of correcting any construction, design or material defects or failures within public rights-of-way or easements in the development or required off-site improvements. The form and manner of execution of such securities shall be subject to the approval of the Town Attorney. The effective period for such security shall be one (1) year and thirty (30) days following the Town's acceptance of the installed improvements. Upon default, the Town may exercise its rights under the security instrument, upon ten (10) days' written notice by certified mail to the parties to the instrument or as otherwise set forth in an applicable agreement.
- 7. The Town Commission of the Town of Dundee authorizes the Town Manager to take all necessary further actions related to entering into a Developer's Agreement with the Applicant and/or Applicant's authorized designee with regard to the terms and conditions set forth by this Resolution and the Town's conditional approval of the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases I and II Certified Subdivision Plan.
- 8. The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any word, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this Resolution for any reason is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions or portions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

- 9. The correction of typographical and/or scrivener's errors in this Resolution which do not affect the intent of this Resolution may be authorized by the Town Manager or her/his designee, without need of consideration by the Town Commission, by filing a corrected or recodified copy of same with the Town Clerk.

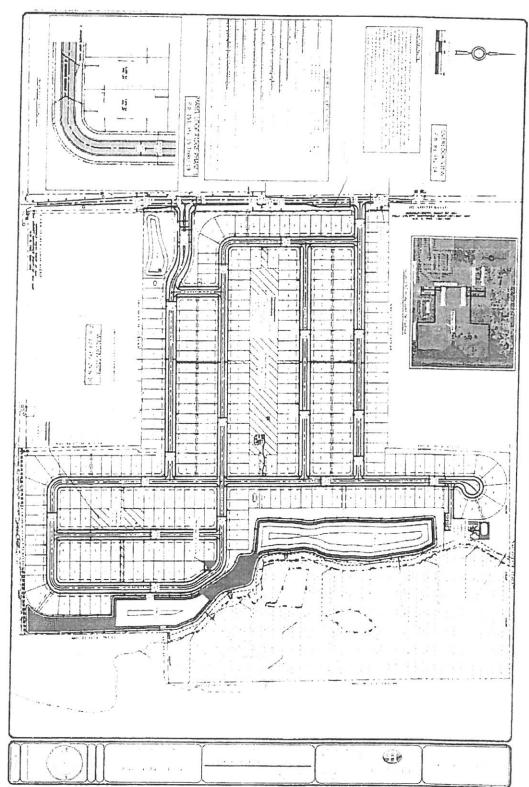
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## RESOLUTION 22-51 EXHIBIT A LOCATION MAP

**REQUEST:** Pursuant to Section 5(i) of the Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-09, Woodland Ranch Estates, LLC and Woodland Ranch Estates 3, LLC (the "Applicant") requested an exception to the moratorium imposed by Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-09 for the Woodland Ranch Estates development arising out of extraordinary hardship(s).

#### ORDER GRANTING HARDSHIP APPLICATION WITH CONDITION(S)

The Town of Dundee (the "Town") is a Florida municipal corporation vested with home rule authority pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Powers Act (F.S. Chapter 166) and Article VIII, §2 of the Florida Constitution.

Section(s) 163.3161 through 163.3215, Florida Statutes (2024), the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, empowers and mandates That the Town plan for future development and growth.

The Town has experienced significant and unprecedented residential growth in a short time resulting in new residential annexations, land use modifications, rezonings, major Planned Unit Development (PUD) amendments, master planned communities, and phased residential development(s) resulting in significant increased demand for Town-provided utility services which includes, but shall not be limited to, potable water utility service(s); and, as a direct result of the unprecedented number of proposed and/or approved new residential development projects within the corporate limits of the Town, the Town is at and/or has exceeded its maximum allocable daily potable water capacity permitted under the Town's current consumptive water use permits (WUPs) issued by the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD).

Pursuant to Section 54-9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee (the "Code") and Section 6.01.07.03 of the Town of Dundee Land Development Code (the

"LDC"), a Concurrency Developer's Agreement has been required as a condition of approval for any Town of Dundee Certified Subdivision Plan ("CSP") in order to provide, at a minimum, as follows: (1) detail the Town's inability to currently provide allocable potable water capacity; (2) detail the necessary expansion of the Town's potable water treatment facilities in order to serve the proposed development; and (3) detail the terms and conditions under which the Town will provide potable water utility service(s) to and/or for the proposed project which is the subject of the CSP.

The Concurrency Developer's Agreement(s), which are required as a condition of approval for any CSP, clearly and unequivocally identifies that the Town does not presently have the necessary utility infrastructure, utility facilities, and/or allocable potable water capacity to serve the proposed residential development.

On March 14, 2023, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission of the Town of Dundee (the "Town Commission") passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Resolution No. 22-51* approving the CSP for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases I and II Subdivision<sup>1</sup> with Certain Conditions (the "Phase 1 CSP") which provides, amongst others, that the Town is not able to provide allocable potable water capacity for project.

On September 10, 2023, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Resolution No. 23-26* approving the CSP for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases III Subdivision with Certain Conditions (the "Phase 2 CSP") which provides, amongst other things, that the Town is not able to provide allocable potable water capacity for project.

The Applicant has entered into a *Concurrency Developer's Agreement* for both the Phase 1 CSP and Phase 2 CSP (collectively referred to as the "Agreements") which provide, amongst other things, that the municipal facilities and services needed to support the development(s) are not available and, by entering into the Agreements, the Applicant assumes all risk(s).

Copies of the Phase 1 CSP, Phase 2 CSP, and Agreements are attached hereto as **Composite Exhibit "A"** and incorporated herein by reference.

On September 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-09* (the "Ordinance") establishing a moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for residential annexations, rezonings, building permits, planned developments, master planned communities, development order(s), and development permits, amongst others.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The Woodland Ranch Estates Phase I and II Subdivision shall be submitted by the Applicant and reviewed by the Town of Dundee as either a combined single phase (e.g., Phase 1) or two (2) separate phases.

A copy of the Ordinance is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** and incorporated herein by reference.

On or about December 2, 2024, pursuant to Section 5(i) of the Ordinance, the Applicant submitted the Town of Dundee Development Services – Hardship Application and all required and relevant documentation (collectively referred to as the "Application") to the Town in order to request certain exception(s) from the moratorium.

A copy of the Application is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"** and incorporated herein by reference.

On December 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Request and Application were presented to and considered by the Town Commission at a public hearing with a quorum present and voting; and, based on the competent substantial evidence and testimony presented by Applicant's representative, George Lindsey, the Town Commission unanimously voted to enter this ORDER GRANTING HARDSHIP APPLICATION WITH CONDITION(S) ("Order").

The meeting minutes (the "Minutes") for the public hearing of the Town Commission on and/or for the Application, which was held on December 10, 2024, are attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"** and incorporated herein by reference.

A quorum of the Town Commission present and voting, at a duly noticed public meeting, as required by *Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-09* and applicable law, and a vote by the majority in favor of entering this **ORDER GRANTING HARDSHIP APPLICATION WITH CONDITION(S)**, the Town Commission hereby orders that the Applicant shall receive a hardship exception consistent with the terms and condition(s) set forth herein, as follows:

- The Applicant waives any and all statutory development review timelines for development orders and development permits<sup>2</sup> which are applicable in accordance with Florida law, as amended<sup>3</sup>.
- 2. The Town Commission authorizes Town staff to proceed with reviewing the applicable plans and submittals for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phase 1 (i.e., the Phase 1 CSP).

- 3. Unless and until the Town of Dundee, Florida, receives a credit to its Water Use Permit (WUP) from SWFWMD arising out of the Applicant's transfer<sup>4</sup> of certain agricultural wells, no *development order*, *development permit*, and/or vested development entitlement(s) shall be approved for any residential development on and/or for the real property which is the subject of the Phase 1 CSP, Phase 2 CSP, and Woodland Ranch Estates Subdivision (see **Composite Exhibit "A"**).
- 4. For purposes of determining whether this Order creates any vested right(s) and/or development entitlement(s), this Order and the Town's review of any plan(s) and/or documents shall not be interpreted to create any vested right and/or entitlement to develop the subject real property in accordance with any plan(s) and/or documents submitted to the Town for review; and, in the event the Applicant submits any plan(s) and/or documents for review, the Applicant acknowledges, accepts, and assumes any and all risk(s).
- The terms, condition(s), and covenants set forth in the Concurrency Developer's Agreements (see Composite Exhibit "A") for the Phase 1 CSP and Phase 2 CSP shall remain in full-force and effect.
- 6. This Order shall not constitute a waiver or variance from applicable law and/or any applicable development regulation(s) unless specifically noted in this Order and consistent with the *Town of Dundee Land Development Code*, as may be amended.
- 7. This Order shall not grant authority to alter the real property which is the subject of the Phase 1 CSP, Phase 2 CSP, and Woodland Ranch Estates Subdivision, nor does it waive any permits, including building permits, that may be required by Federal, State, or County agencies which may have jurisdiction.
- The effective date of this Order shall be the date on which this Order is approved by the Town Commission, at a duly noticed public meeting, and executed by the Town Manager.

#### General Narrative. I.

The Town of Dundee (the "Town") is a Florida municipal corporation vested with home rule authority pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Powers Act (Ch. 166, Fla. Stat.) and Article VIII, §2 of the Florida Constitution.

Section(s) 163.3161 through 163.3215, Florida Statutes (2024), the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act, empowers and mandates that the Town plan for future development and growth.

Pursuant to Section 6.01.07.04 of the Land Development Code of Dundee (hereafter the "LDC"), the Town is the sole provider of water utility service(s) within its Chapter 180, Florida Statutes, Utility Service Area (the "USA") and all new development is required to connect to the Town's Water System

Pursuant to applicable Florida law, the Development is a master planned community which is located within the corporate limits of the Town and the USA; and, pursuant to Section 7.02.08 of the LDC, the Development is a residential development

On March 14, 2023, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission of the Town of Dundee (the "Town Commission") passed and adopted Town of Dundee

Resolution No. 22-51 approving the Certified Subdivision Plan for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases I and II Subdivision with Conditions (hereafter the "Phase 1 CSP").

On September 10, 2023, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Resolution No. 23-26* approving the Certified Subdivision Plan for the Woodland Ranch Estates Phases III Subdivision with Conditions (hereafter the "Phase 2 CSP").

Pursuant to Sec. 54-9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee, Florida (hereafter the "Code") and Sections 6.01.04, 6.01.07.03, and 6.01.10(C) of the LDC, as a condition of approval of the Phase 1 CSP and Phase 2 CSP (hereafter collectively referred to as the "CSP"), the Town and Applicant negotiated and entered a Concurrency Developer's Agreement in order to identify and address, at a minimum, the following: (i) at that time, the Town did not have the necessary utility infrastructure, utility facilities, and/or allocable potable water capacity to serve the Development; (ii) the CSP, for the purpose of providing a basis upon which a final subdivision plat for the Development may be considered for approval, would not be considered complete until the Town has the ability to provide allocable potable water capacity for the Development; and (iii) by entering into the Concurrency Developer's Agreement, the Applicant acknowledged and agreed to assume all risk(s) associated therewith.

The Applicant did in fact negotiate and enter into a *Concurrency Developer's Agreement* and *Water Supply Allocation Agreement* for the Development (hereafter collectively the "Agreements") with the Town. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreements, any credit or increase to the Town of Dundee Public Supply Water Use Permit, Permit No. 20005893.014 (hereafter the "Town WUP"), by virtue of any transferred agricultural well(s) shall be allocated to the Development.

Pursuant to applicable law which includes, but shall not be limited to, *Section 6.01.04 of the LDC*, where concurrency deficiencies are identified, agreement(s) entered into in order to provide the needed service(s) shall be a condition of development approval of and/or for any development plan(s).

On **June 26, 2025**, pursuant to the Code, the LDC, and applicable provision(s) of the Agreements, the Applicant submitted a request to the Town for an *adequacy determination* related to potable water concurrency for the Development.

Based on the aforementioned, this *adequacy determination* shall **not** modify the terms and conditions of the Agreements; and, in the event of any conflict(s) between the findings set forth in this *adequacy determination* and the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreements, this Agreements shall be the governing document(s) and take precedence.

#### II. Moratorium.

On September 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission passed and adopted *Town of Dundee Ordinance No. 24-09* (the "Ordinance") establishing a moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for residential annexations, rezonings, building permits, planned developments, master planned communities, development order(s), and development permits, amongst others.

The purpose of the Ordinance was to place a temporary moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for residential *development orders* and *development permits* for real property consisting of more than one (1) acre located within the corporate limits of the Town of Dundee, Florida, in order for the Town to address, amongst other things, potable water capacity and applicable level(s) of service in the Town's water utility system.

A copy of the Ordinance is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and incorporated herein by reference.

Pursuant to Section 5 and Section 6 of the Ordinance (see **Exhibit "A"**), the Ordinance provided for certain exception(s) to the moratorium imposed which include, but are not limited to, the following: (i) any credit/increase received to the Town's Public Supply Water Use Permit (hereafter the "Town WUP") arising out of the transfer of agricultural wells pursuant to and/or in accordance with the Agreements; and (ii) any individual exceptions authorized by the Town Commission for those developers with extraordinary hardship(s) or vested development rights.

On **December 2, 2024**, the Applicant submitted the *Town of Dundee Development Services – Hardship Application* (hereafter the "Application"); and, on **December 10, 2024**, at a duly noticed public meeting, the Town Commission *conditionally approved* the Application and entered **HARDSHIP ORDER NO. 01-24** (hereafter the "Order") which provided the Applicant with an exception to the moratorium.

A copy of the Order is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** and incorporated herein by reference.

This adequacy determination shall modify the terms and conditions of the Order (see Exhibit "B"); and, in the event of any conflict(s) between the findings set forth in this adequacy determination and the terms and conditions set forth in the Order, this adequacy determination shall be the governing document and take precedence.

# III. Public Supply Water Use Permit, Permit No. 20005893.014.

On May 20, 2025, the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) held a Governing Board Meeting (hereafter the "SWFWMD Meeting"); and, at that time, SWFWMD conditionally approved Consent Agenda Item No. 2.5 which consisted of the Town's application for the renewal of the Town WUP (hereafter the "WUP Renewal").

The conditions of approval for the WUP Renewal are memorialized and made a part of the WUP Renewal which was issued on May 20, 2025. The WUP Renewal authorizes an annual average quantity increase from 917,500 gallons per day (GPD) to 1.702.700 GPD.

A copy of the WUP Renewal is attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"** and incorporated herein by reference.

Pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the WUP Renewal, the approved increase in withdrawals from the Upper Floridian Aquifer (UFA) above the 2025 demand is supported by *impact offsets* associated with the pending retirement of eighteen (18) existing water use permits related to the land use transition(s) of and/or for the agricultural wells which are the subject of the Agreements.

As a direct result of the WUP Renewal, on **June 24, 2025**, at a duly notice public meeting, the Town Commission approved *Town of Dundee Resolution No. 25-21* (hereafter the "Resolution") supporting certain amendments to the *Town of Dundee 2030 Comprehensive Plan*, the Code, and the LDC in order to amend the Town's level of service requirements for an *Equivalent Residential Connection* (ERC) from 360 GPD to 250 GPD for a standard single-family dwelling unit.

# IV. Adequacy Determination and Certification.

Unless specifically provided for in this *Certification of Sufficient Potable Water* Capacity (hereafter the "Certification"), this Certification shall not constitute a waiver or variance from applicable law which includes, but shall not to be limited to, the *Code of Ordinances of the Town of Dundee*, *Florida*; the *Land Development Code of Dundee*; and/or applicable provision(s) and conditions set forth in any agreement(s), *development order(s)* and/or *development permit(s)*<sup>1</sup> entered into or issued for the Development.

Pursuant to Sec. 54-2 of the Code, land development within the corporate limits of the Town of Dundee, Florida, and/or Town of Dundee utility service area shall be permitted only where adequate water facilities exist.

Pursuant to Section 6.01.01 of the LDC, no development shall be approved unless public facilities are or will be available to serve a proposed development, such that the adopted levels of service (LOS) are maintained, concurrent with the impacts of the proposed development; and, in accordance with Section 54-9 of the Code and Article 6 of the LDC, the Agreements shall be a condition of development approval of and/or for any development plan(s) arising out of and/or related to the Development.

For purposes of the Development and pursuant to applicable law which includes, but shall not to be limited to, the Code, the LDC, and/or applicable provision(s) and conditions set forth in the Agreements, the Town has determined and certifies, as follows:

- 1. The terms, condition(s), and covenants set forth in the Agreements for the Phase 1 CSP and Phase 2 CSP shall remain in full-force and effect.
- This Certification shall allocate potable water capacity for purposes of determining whether adequate potable water capacity is available and allocable to and/or for the Development.

- 3. This Certification shall not create any vested right(s) and/or development entitlement(s); and therefore, this Certification shall not be interpreted to create any vested right and/or entitlement to develop the Property in accordance with any development plan(s) and/or documents submitted to the Town for the Development.
- 4. Beginning on its effective date, this Certification shall constitute an adequacy determination and notice of concurrency certification under the Code and LDC of available potable water service capacity to serve the Development within the Town's municipal water system for a period not to exceed five (5) calendar years (the "Term"), subject to the terms, conditions, and provisions herein. This Certification is specific to the Development, limited to capacity only, and is non-transferrable. Upon approval by resolution of the Town Commission or otherwise of the final subdivision plat for the Development or final subdivision plat for a phase of the Development, the Term provided for herein shall terminate; and, pursuant to Section 6.01.05(A) of the LDC; the Development shall receive an allocation of potable water service capacity for the applicable term beginning on the effective date of the subject resolution and/or subdivision plat approval.
- 5. The Town shall not vest potable water capacity in and/or for the Development unless and until the Applicant has paid the applicable connection fee(s) as provided and specifically set forth in Chapter 54 of the Code.
- The effective date of this Certification shall be the date on which this Certification is duly executed by the Town and Applicant.
- This Certification shall not be executed in counterparts.
- 8. Pursuant to the Agreements and WUP Renewal, it has been found and determined that, for purposes of the Development, an *equivalent residential connection* shall equate to 250 GPD for each new residential connection; and pursuant to the WUP Renewal and Resolution, the Development shall be allocated potable water capacity for <u>344</u> *equivalent residential connections* in and/or for the Development for the term set forth in Paragraph 4 (see above).



# Town of Dundee, Florida Concurrency Certification Potable Water Capacity

- 9. This Certification is related only to the allocation of potable water service capacity and shall not grant authority to alter the Property.
- 10. This Certification shall not waive any permitting requirements, including building permits, that may be required by Federal, State, or County agencies which may have jurisdiction.

By executing this Certification, the Town and Applicant acknowledge, agree, and affirm that the Town has fully-satisfied and/or performed the obligations and requirements set forth in the Agreements; and the Applicant and its successors and assigns agree to indemnify and hold the Town, its elected and appointed officials, employees and agents harmless of and from any and all costs, expenses, damages, liability and claims (including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs) related to and/or arising out of this Certification, the Agreements, and the Applicant's transfer of the agricultural wells to the Town.
