The canvassing board discussed establishing a chair for the canvas board and made a motion to have Veronica King serve as the chair The motion passed unanimously. (3/0)


The canvassing board discussed independent audit and made a motion to have the independent audit over the manual audit. The motion passed unanimously. (3/0)



The board adjourned at 10:21p.m.


