SUMMARY: As in 2022, The Historic Town of Eatonville wishes to celebrate and observe Juneteenth on Monday, June 19, 2023. Juneteenth is the oldest known celebration marking the end of slavery in the

United States also known as "Freedom Day." On January 1, 1863, the Emancipation Proclamation was issued by the U.S. President Abraham Lincoln granted freedom to "all persons as slaves."

It was not until the day of June 19, 1865, Major General Gordon Granger arrived in Texas more than 155 years ago to inform slaves that slavery had been abolished.

The Freedom Celebration Committee wishes to have a celebration program at the Life Center Church, 63 East Kennedy Blvd, Eatonville, Florida 32751 at 6:00 p.m. This will be an educational and heritage event to the people in the community including families, seniors, and children in the Town of Eatonville and other communities are invited to attend.

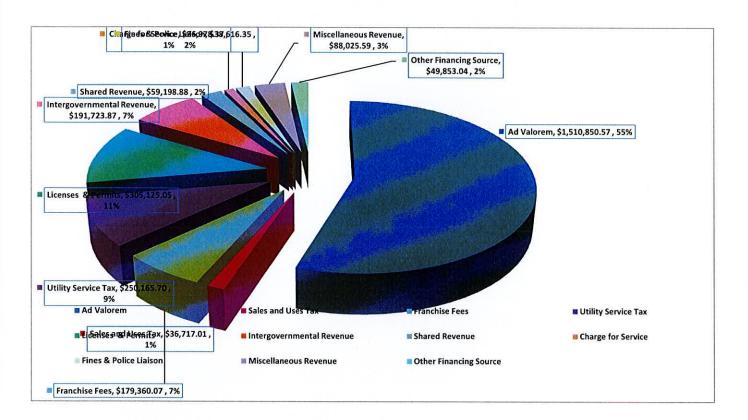

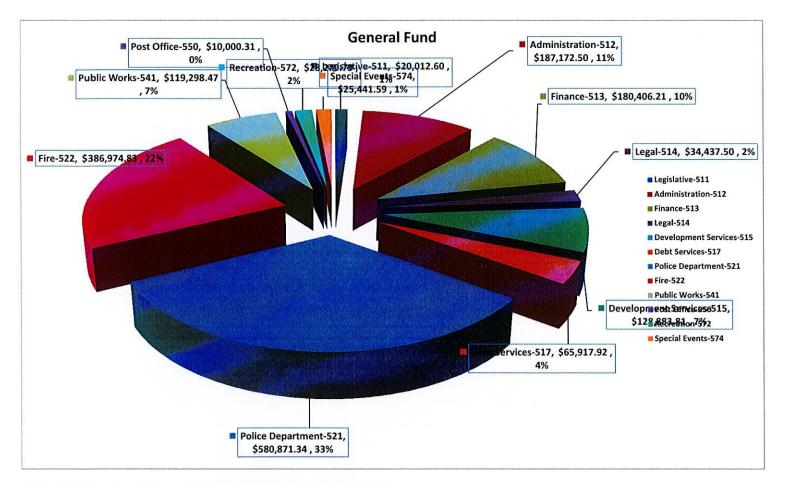
GENERAL FUND REVENUES WHERE THE MONEY COMES FROM?

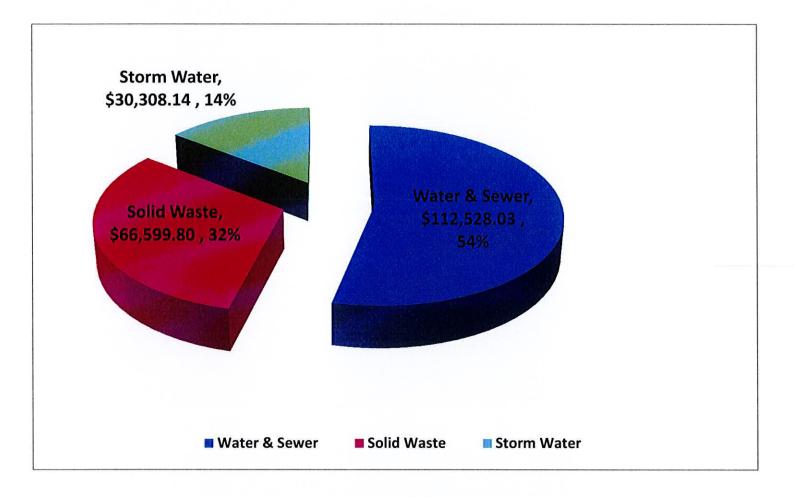
GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES WHERE THE MONEY GOES?

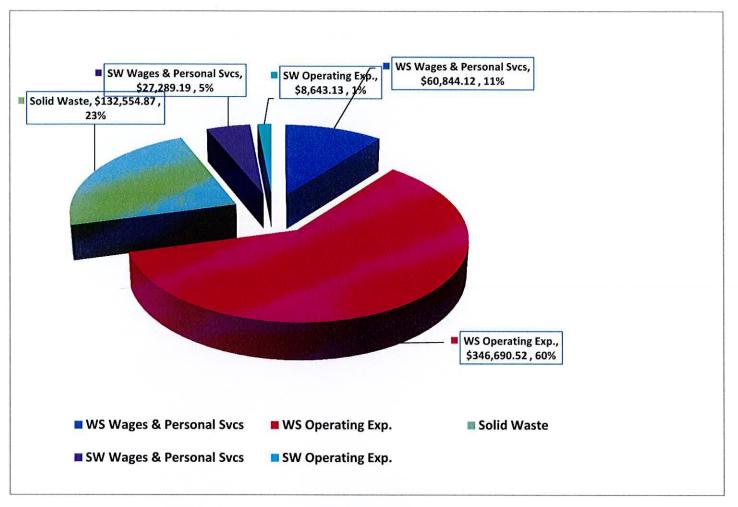
