<u>SUMMARY</u>: Eight code cases will be presented by the Code Enforcement Officer of the Town of Eatonville. The officer will present the elements of proof of a violation and proof of due process of law to the Code Enforcement Board. The Code Enforcement Board has the authority to use their judgement with an emphasis on all respondents coming into compliance with the town's code of ordinances and policies.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Code Enforcement Board hear code cases listed on the docket of open code violations within the Town of Eatonville.

Exposed to public view means any premises, or building or any part thereof, which may be lawfully viewed by the public from a sidewalk, street, alleyway, or from any adjoining or neighboring premises. Exterior of premises means those portions of a building which are exposed to public view and the open space outside any building erected thereon. Minor violation means a condition which is below the minimum standards set out by this Land Development Code but which is not serious enough to be considered a major violation. Nuisance/public nuisance means any one or combination of the following: (2) Any attractive nuisance which may prove detrimental to the health or safety of children and others, whether in a building, on the premises of a building or upon an unoccupied lot. but not limited to excessive growth of grass or weeds, dead trees, trash, garbage, etc., all without notice. This requirement includes proper maintenance, by the owner, of that portion of the adjoining public right-of-way between the owner's property and the street. **Sec. 50-35. – Maintenance of exterior of premises (b)**., The exterior of the premises and of all structures thereon shall be kept free of all nuisances and any hazards to the safety of occupants, customers, pedestrians, and other persons utilizing the premises and free of unsanitary conditions, and any of the foregoing shall be promptly removed and abated by the owner or operator. It shall be the duty of the owner or operator to keep the premises free of hazards which include, but are not limited to the following: **(1)**. Brush, weeds, broken glass, stumps, roots, obnoxious growths, and accumulations of filth, garbage, trash, refuse, debris and inoperative machinery.

Please be advised that if the violation is not cured by **[04/14/2025]** this case will be scheduled for a hearing before the Code Enforcement Board or Special Magistrate and a fine of up to \$250.00 per day may be imposed each day the property remains in non-compliance.
